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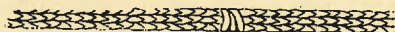

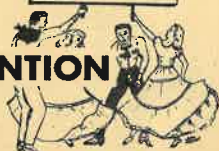

Round of the MONTH



FANTASY

by Ed and Louise Miller, Long Beach, California

RECORD: "Fantasy" (Melinda's Melody) - Sunny Hills AC 133-S
POSITION: Open, inside hands joined, both facing LOD
FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout, Directions for M
INTRO: 4 Meas: Wait 2 meas; Then step L fwd, swing R fwd, -; M steps back on R, touches L to R, -; as W steps L pivoting L-face to face partner and touches R to L as partners assume CLOSED POS, M facing LOD.

MEASURES:

- 1 -- 4 WALTZ FWD; WALTZ FWD; STEP, SWING IN, -; TWIRL L (TO BANJO);
 In closed pos, starting M's L, do 2 fwd waltzes; Assume SEMI-CLOSED POS both facing COH step L, swing R, -; As M does 1 waltz in place RLR, W twirls L-face under her R and M's L to end in BANJO POS M facing LOD.
- 5 -- 8 BANJO AROUND, 2, 3; 4 (TO SIDECAR), 5, 6; TWINKLE OUT; TWINKLE IN;
 Banjo walk around CW in 4 steps 1 full turn, maneuvering to SIDECAR POS (L hips adj) on cts 5 & 6 to end M facing diag fwd twd wall; Twinkle out - M XIF L over R; Twinkle in - crossing R over L (W XIB both times) to end in CLOSED POS, M facing LOD.
- 9 -- 16 REPEAT ACTION OF MEAS 1-8, ending in OPEN POS, both facing LOD, inside hands joined.
- 17 -- 20 WALTZ OUT, 2, CLOSE; WALTZ IN, 2, FACE; CROSS UNDER, 2, 3; TWIRL L, 2, 3;
 With inside hands joined, M's R and W's L, both waltz diag away to arms length; Then waltz diag twd each other to face; Change places by W crossing under joined hands to end facing RLOD in OPEN POS; Then (staying close, M's R hand held high), as W twirls 1/2 L-face (spot twirl), M continues around W CW RLR to end in OPEN POS both facing LOD.
- 21 -- 24 WALTZ OUT, 2, CLOSE; WALTZ IN, 2, FACE; CROSS UNDER, 2, 3, TWIRL L, 2, 3;
 Repeat action of Meas 17-20, ending in OPEN POS, both facing LOD.
- 25 -- 28 STEP, SWING -; ROLL IN, 2, 3; STEP, SWING, -; FACE, TOUCH, -;
 M steps L fwd, swings R ft fwd, -; Roll in twd partner RLR (M turning R-face W, L-face) 1 full turn in place, to end facing LOD inside hands rejoined; Step L fwd, swing R fwd, -; As M steps back on R, touches L to R, and holds ct 3, W steps L pivoting 1/2 L-face to face partner and touches R to L and holds ct 3 as partners assume CLOSED POS, M facing LOD.
- 29 -- 32 BAL BACK; WALTZ R; WALTZ; TWIRL;
 Bal back on L in RLOD; 2 R-face turning waltzes progressing in LOD; W twirls R under her R and M's L to end in CLOSED POS, M facing LOD.

ENTIRE DANCE IS DONE THREE TIMES IN ALL. BOW AND CURTSY.

Get That Chip Off Your Shoulder

They say that the Squeaking Wheel gets the Grease, but this time the shoe is on the other foot. I find, on rereading my articles for the last two years - (we are getting out another volume of Squaredancemanship) - that I have said a lot about Democracy in Square Dancing, and No Set-Up Squares, and Be Nice to Beginners, and Let's Dance with Everybody. I am not taking any of that back -- I still think we are basically a friendly bunch, and that we want to be kind and make everybody feel at home and wanted. And I am still against anything, no matter how unintentional, which causes hurt feelings. BUT I also think the other side has some obligations -- do you have to leave your feelings out there to be stepped on? Why not relax and quit looking for slights?

Thesqueaking wheels continue to squeak. I get complaints all the time, that certain people 'won't dance with us,' or 'won't let you into a square with them,' or that they 'line up in the Rounds and then square up before anyone else can get there.' I am still hearing about 'cliques' and about some Clubs being cold to new members. But I think it is about time to ask those other wheels, that don't do any squeaking, what they think.

Well, the answers I get are varied and interesting. I have talked to people from other parts of the country who always run their dances that way, and see nothing wrong with it. You just don't go to a dance unless you have arranged ahead of time to have a full square to dance with, because you know that the other squares are all arranged too. And there are other groups of people nearer home who realize that they are being exclusive, and are rather on the defensive about it, but still feel that they have a right to be that way if they like. But there is another big group -- and I think it includes most of us -- who know that they have occasionally been criticized, and are trying hard to avoid even the appearance of cliquishness, and who make a special effort to get around and dance with everyone, and who are just now beginning to feel that they may have some rights, too. Maybe they don't have the right to set up squares and cold-shoulder anyone, but some of us are getting pretty tired of feeling guilty every time we stop after a Round, right where we are, and hold up our hands for more couples, and find that the ones who come are all old friends. Should we push some of them away, and wait for new people? Should we never join a square where we especially like everyone? Must we spend all our time looking for and dancing with the thin-skinned people who will accuse us of snobbishness if we don't? I don't think so.

JEANNIE YORK tells me that away back, when she and JIM used to go to Pappy Shaw's Institute, one of the things he told them was that, even though Square Dancing was one of the most democratic of activities, with the banker and the plumber dancing together and no one asking what you did for a living, nevertheless they must not be surprised to find that over a period of time congenial groups of people would drift together, just as they do anywhere else, and Clubs would become more and more homogeneous. Pappy seemed to feel that this development was natural and inevitable, and was not necessarily a bad thing. Certainly we have noticed a trend that way in the Bay Area. In the beginning, when there was only one Club in any given area, all the dancers in that area had to belong to that Club. But now that there are so many Clubs, more and more dancers are shopping around and joining the Club where the members seem the most congenial. And within the Clubs themselves, smaller groups have formed, not by any intent to include or exclude, but just because people do form friendships, in square dancing as in any other activity. And why not?

Also -- and here I know I am getting onto thin ice -- in square dancing as in everything else, there are Social Climbers. Human nature being what it is, there will always be people who are just aching to be a part of a group which they consider, rightly or wrongly, to be 'tops'. Usually they boast that they 'dance just as well as anybody', and cannot understand why they are not accepted. Maybe they are the sort of dancers who only dance well when everyone else in the square is better than they are. Maybe there is really nothing at all the matter with them, but there is nothing especially interesting about them either -- nothing

to make people notice them. Maybe they try too hard -- nobody likes a pusher. Maybe they just don't belong in that particular club or clique or 'gang', for reasons which no one could possibly explain. The point is, if they don't seem to want you, stop worrying and try someone else -- if you are just another Charlie Brown, no amount of prodding from me is going to make you popular, at least with that particular group. Relax -- dance with the ones who do want you, and be grateful. (Of course, if nobody wants you, maybe you'd better see a psychiatrist.)

Don't think I am going back on all I have said, before. I still would rather dance with lots of different groups at Round-Ups, and I still make a point of avoiding all our local friends at Ailomar and trying to make new ones. I am still in favor of courtsey and kindness at all times, and especially to new dancers. But I am tired of hearing about people who won't dance with other people, and I would like to feel free to dance with anyone I happened to get into a square with -- even if they just happened to be my best friends.

- 1. Caller:** An active callers, calling to one or more classes or groups regularly for more than one year. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
- 2. Teacher:** Teaches one or more folk or square dance group and is actively interested in improving square dance teaching. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
- 3. Subscriber:** Either a caller or teacher as defined above but resides outside of the Northern California area. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
- 4. Associate:** Does not qualify as a caller or teacher as defined above. Prospective or beginning callers or square dance teachers qualify as associates. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
