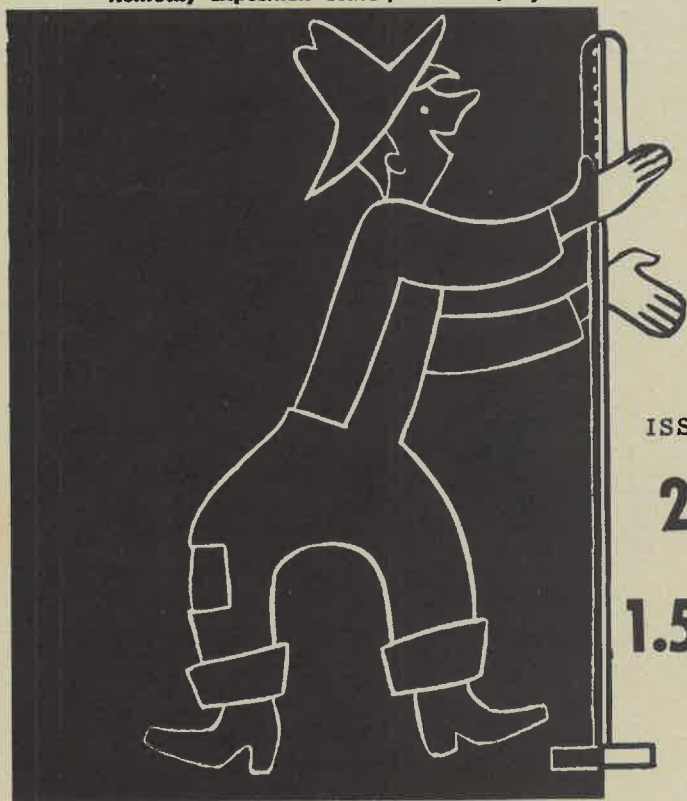

RECORD: "Yes Tonight Josephine" - Columbia 40893
POSITION: Facing, both hands joined, M's back to COH
FOOTWORK: Opposite. Directions are given for the M
INTRO: 4 meas. WAIT (Dance starts with vocal)

MEASURES

PART I

- 1 - 4 FACE-TO-FACE, BRUSH/LIFT; BACK-TO-BACK, BRUSH-LIFT;
FACE-TO-FACE, BRUSH/LIFT; and on AROUND, BRUSH-LIFT;
Step L to side along LOD, close R to L, step L to side, then
while M does brush R/lift fwd (W opp) partners drop lead hands
and pivot to a back-to-back pos (M's R & W's L hands still
joined); in back-to-back pos starting M's R repeat side, close,
side, brush/lift in LOD and pivot in to face partner again (M
turns R; W, L); join both hands and step L to side along LOD,
close R to L, step L to side, brush R/lift twd RLOD; release
M's R & W's L hands and continue momentum of turn (M to R,
W to L) away from partner and on around with a step, close,
step, brush/lift to face partner again. End in FACING POS,
both hands joined, M's bk to COH.
- 5 - 8 SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, BRUSH; CROSS OVER, 2, 3, BRUSH;
BACK AWAY, 2, 3, BRUSH; TOGETHER, 2, 3, BRUSH;
Step L to side along LOD, close R, step L to side (or slightly
bkwd), brush; drop lead hands (M's L & W's R) & change sides
by W crossing under her L & M's R hands making 1/2 L-face
turn with a step, close, step, brush and M walking CW to out-
side with a step, close, step, brush turning to face COH; drop
hands and back away from partner with a back, close, back,
brush; move twd partner with a fwd, close, fwd, brush. End in
FACING POS, both hands joined, M's back to wall.
- 9 - 12 REPEAT ACTION OF MEAS 5-8, M on outside of circle, stepping
L along RLOD (W crossing under M's R as before). End in CLOSED
POS.
- 13 - 16 TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWIRL, -, 2, -, 3, -, 4, -;
Two slow turning two-steps making 1 turn prog LOD; W twirls R
-face twice (or once if preferred) in 4 slow steps under her R &
M's L arm while M walks fwd 4 slow steps. End in FACING
POS, both hands joined, M's bk to COH.

PART II

- 17 - 20 SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; TURN AWAY,
2, 3, BRUSH; TOG, 2, 3, BRUSH;
Step L to side along LOD, close R to L, cross L over R twd
RLOD (both cross in); Repeat side, close, cross starting M's R;
turn away from partner (M to L, W to R) and on around to face
partner with a step, close, step, brush; step, close, step, brush.
- 21 - 24 REPEAT MEAS 17-20, ENDING IN R-HAND STAR POS.
- 25 - 28 STAR, 2, 3, BRUSH; STAR, 2, 3, BRUSH; BACK UNDER, 2, 3, BRUSH;
TOGETHER, 2, 3, BRUSH;
In R-hand star pos star around CW just half-way with a step,
close, step, brush; step, close, step, brush (take small steps - M
now on outside facing RLOD, W on inside facing LOD); keep-
ing R hands joined, W makes 1/4 L-face turn to face COH
momentarily and then backs under joined hands, while M walks
around her still moving CW with a step, close, step, brush to end
W on outside, M on inside slightly apart, hands still joined;
step, close, step, brush together. Release R hands and take
CLOSED POSITION.
- 29-32 TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWIRL, -, 2, -, 3, -, 4, -;
Repeat Meas 13-16. End in FACING POS, M's back to COH,
to repeat dance.
- DANCE ROUTINE A TOTAL OF THREE TIMES PLUS ENDING;
ENDING: Repeat Meas 1-3; then while M takes 2 quick steps FWD, W
twirls R under M's L and her R. Both bow.

WHY STANDARDIZE?

ASKS MADELINE ALLEN

Remember that question you have been asking me all year? I mean the one about the two people passing on the outside of the set, and who goes where? Well, you can relax -- the answer is, you pass right shoulders, just like in a Pass Thru, no matter who you are.

I bring up this simple little question just to prove a point, namely, that it does not matter so much which way you do a thing, as it does that everyone should agree on which way. Some people thought the lady should always pass on the inside, and some people (including me) thought that you should Keep to the Right, as in traffic. But the majority of the callers and teachers in the Dancers' Association Workshop thought you should pass right shoulders in everything, so that's the way it's going to be. And that is really why the Workshop was started.

The Workshop has been accused of turning out so many new calls that the poor beginner hasn't a chance. Actually, all the Workshop does is to take the calls people continue to write, and try them out, and try to agree on what should be understood from a certain term, and then all agree to teach it that way. The original idea of the Workshop was to make it so that all dancers in the association Clubs could dance to all the callers, and understand them all. We have tried to recommend new calls that were directional and reasonable and were fun to do, and to discourage the ones that were so vague that they had to be explained each time they were done. We have approved several totally new terms, like Dixie Chain and Square Thru, that did not mean anything unless they were taught. But we have also refused to approve a whole lot of other aspiring terms, that seemed to us to fill no need, or maybe to be just another term for something we already had. Without the policing of the Workshop and other similar groups over the country, the number of new terms to be learned would be infinitely greater.

A good example of this clarification of terms is the question of 'Face'. Until recently, about the only time 'Face' was used was when two people were swinging, and they were told to stop in a certain position -- for instance, 'Swing your opposite, face the sides.' This was easy for two reasons -- when the call came, you were not facing anyone, and you faced the desired direction as a couple, with the lady on the right. Then came the 'Little Red Hen', with the call 'Box the gnat, face the middle'. At first, it stopped the floor -- after you had boxed the gnat, you were facing the middle. But the lady was on the left, and as the next call was 'Right and left thru', it was pretty obvious that you would have to face the middle the other way in order to get a lady on your right for the next command. Then later in the same call, 'Box the gnat and face the sides' created no problem -- in fact, people all over are still facing the sides from that particular move, even when it is not called. But the word 'Face' still changed you from a half-sashayed position to a normal position, when it gave you the other lady for a partner, and it seemed sensible to the dancers, because it straightened them out.

Then, inevitably, some joker reversed things. By starting with a half sashay, he got to the point where you 'Box the gnat and face the middle' and you were already facing a middle with a girl on your right. Horrors! If you turned now, you would be wrong instead of right. There was a lot of dithering around, until we all agreed that 'Face the middle' meant to turn a quarter, no matter where you were. Then came 'Face your own', and sometimes your own was a new partner you had just met. Then, in quick succession, 'Face your corner,' 'Face your opposite', and 'Face those two.' Sometimes you had a hard time telling your partner from your corner, after a few quick pass-thrus, and people were spinning like totems. So something had to be done.

Here is where cooperation counts. The Workshop took up the question, and the answer became obvious. The rule is, simply, that whenever you hear the word 'Face', you make a quarter turn -- not a half turn, because that would be called 'turn back' -- and the call will

tell you which way to turn. When you are working with another couple, you don't have to worry about who is your partner or your corner -- if you are already facing one person, make a quarter turn and face the other. On the call 'Face the middle', turn and face the other middle. If you are in a line of four, facing out, and the call says 'Face the middle', don't turn all the way around and face in -- that is not a quarter turn. Instead, turn one quarter toward the center of the square, and you will find yourselves in four couples, ready for a double pass thru. See? Very simple.

There is still one little catch, however. In the old days, before things got so complicated, callers used to use a lot of words very loosely, just as patter, and now they are going to have to watch themselves. They can't say 'Right and left thru and face the middle' any more, when all that they really mean is a regular right and left thru, with a reminder to turn the girl around. (That's another story -- it is my opinion that more squares are ruined by people who don't turn around in a right and left thru than by any other single mistake.) Nor can they say 'Box the gnat and face right back' -- if you box the gnat correctly you do face back the way you came, and another command to 'Face' would only gum the works. Once we have agreed that a certain word will mean a certain thing, let's stick to it -- give the poor dancers a break.

Actually, 'Face' is just one example. Please, callers, remember that the Workshop standardizations are meant only to make it possible for you to call equally successfully wherever you go, and please go along with them even if you don't always agree a hundred percent. The dancers will thank you for it.

- 2. Teacher:** Teaches one or more folk or square dance group and is actively interested in improving square dance teaching. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
- 3. Subscriber:** Either a caller or teacher as defined above but resides outside of the Northern California area. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
- 4. Associate:** Does not qualify as a caller or teacher as defined above. Prospective or beginning callers or square dance teachers qualify as associates. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
