ROUND DANCE FOR SEPTEMBER

TAMMY

By Manning & Nita Smith, College Station, Texas

RECORD: "Tammy" - SIO X3105A

POSITION: Closed, M's back to COH

FOOTWORK: Opposite, directions for M

MEASURES

- 1 - 4 BAL BWD; MANUV WALTZ; WALTZ; WALTZ;
Bal bwd on L, touch R beside L, hold 1 ct; Starting fwd on R maneuver in 3 steps (1 waltz meas) to end with M's back to LOD; Starting bwd on L do 2 R-face turning waltzes making 3/4 CW turn to end with M's back to COH in CLOSED POS.
- 5 - 8 BAL BWD; MANUV WALTZ; WALTZ; WALTZ;
Repeat action of Meas 1-4 ending in OPEN POS (no twirl).
- 9 - 12 WALTZ FWD (BK TO BK); WALTZ (FACE TO FACE); SOLO TURN, 2, CLOSE; ON AROUND, 2, CLOSE;
In open pos and starting L do 1 waltz fwd (step, step, close) in LOD swinging joined hands fwd and turning slightly back-to-back; Continue fwd in LOD on R and do 1 waltz as you turn face-to-face; Swinging joined hands fwd and releasing them do a solo turn in 2 meas -- starting L and turning away from partner to L (W starts R and turns R) waltz fwd to a bk-to-bk pos on 1st meas (meas 11); Continuing turn, step bwd in LOD on R and finish solo turn to end facing partner M's back to COH.
- 13 - 16 WALTZ FWD (BK-TO-BK); WALTZ (FACE-TO-FACE); SOLO TURN, 2, CLOSE; ON AROUND, 2, close;
Repeat action of Meas 9-12, ending in CLOSED POS M'S back to COH.
- 17 - 20 BAL BWD; MANUV WALTZ; WALTZ; TWIRL TO OPEN;
Bal bwd on L, touch R beside L, hold 1 ct; Starting fwd on R maneuver in 3 steps (1 waltz meas) to end with M's bk to LOD; Starting bwd on L do 1 R-face turning waltz; W does R-face twirl under M's L and her R hands in 3 steps as M waltzes fwd to OPEN POS facing LOD.
- 21 - 24 STEP, SWING -; REVERSE TWIRL; TWINKLE; TWINKLE;
With inside hands joined step fwd on L, swing R fwd, hold 1 ct; W does L-face twirl under joined hands (M's R, W's L) as she steps LRL traveling in RLOD at same time M steps almost in place with RLR adjusting to W as she twirls, change hands to M's L and W's R (both crossing in front) step on L XIF of R, step R to R side in RLOD; close L to R taking wt on L; (again both crossing in front) step on R XIF of L as you momentarily take semi-closed pos step L to side in LOD, close R to L taking wt on R and assuming CLOSED POS M's back to COH.
- 25 - 32 Repeat action of Meas 17-24 ending in closed pos, M's back twd COH, ready repeat dance from the beginning.
- ENDING: Take closed pos after last twinkle of 3rd time thru and dip back on M's L (W dips fwd on R), hold.

WHY DRESS UP?

For some reason, the question this month seems to be, 'How can I get my dancers to wear Square Dance clothes?' I must be lucky -- the dancers I dance with all seem to dress for it as a matter of course, and vary their clothes with the occasion, whether it is a Workshop, a Club night, or a big Party Dance. But this is the season of travelling callers and dancers, and I have been talking to a lot of people from other parts of the country, and also to local callers who have beginner groups, and there really does seem to be a problem. New dancers have to be told how and why we dress up, and a lot of old dancers have to be urged to keep on doing it.

I know why I dress up for dancing -- I love Square Dance clothes. To me, they are the prettiest, gayest, most comfortable and most becoming clothes I have ever worn. No matter how tired I may be, or how near we came to deciding to stay home just this once, the moment I get into those full skirts and fluffy petticoats and soft slippers, I am ready to go. No matter how far from perfect your figure may be, there is a Square Dance style that will make you look attractive. Men, too -- you all look taller and slimmer and more glamorous in those Frontier pants and fitted shirts, all fresh and colorful, just like the hero in a Western. There is a feeling of lightness and bounce and gayety in a room full of dancers in costume that you would never get in a thousand years if you all wore the same clothes you do at home -- even without tight skirts and high heels. I don't think anyone will deny that.

The big question seems to be, which comes first, the spirit or the costume? Do you feel like dancing because you are dressed up, or did you dress up because you felt like dancing? Do some people, who have been dancing long enough to know better, come to dances in the same full skirts and blouses they wore marketing because they don't care very much about dancing anyhow, or do they dance rather sloppily just because they didn't bother to change? Would they be more enthusiastic if they could be persuaded to try it our way? What could you do to make dressing up more attractive to them?

In my opinion, the responsibility for dancers dressing or not dressing can usually be laid squarely at the feet of their first Caller and his wife. Obviously, since 'imitation is the sincerest form of flattery', dancers who love and admire their leaders will try to do as they do. But some Callers' wives still seem to fear that wearing special Square Dance dresses when their dancers do not, might be misunderstood as showing off. They certainly have a point, if they wear elaborate, intricate, too-dressy clothes. The idea should be to start with Workshop-type dresses, the sort of thing that makes each woman feel 'Now I could make something like that, too!' and encourage the beginning dancers to ask how to go about it. Then, when the dancers are ready for their first big affair, the Caller's wife might start a discussion of what to wear, and even offer help in planning something a little more elaborate. This might be the time to suggest investing in a real Square Dance dress from a shop or catalogue, or adding more petticoats for a fancier effect. The idea is to bring the dancers along slowly, from simple workshop dresses to a variety of types, as they progress.

With the men, things are easier. Most men are all too anxious to buy their first pair of boots, and Western shirts are fairly easy to find, these days. But I think that after the first plunge, many men need the cooperation of their wives, to see to it that there is always a clean, fresh Western shirt ready, and to make them feel welcome to wear it, instead of saving it for Saturday night. I notice, however, that most dancers either dress or don't dress as a couple -- so I guess that she sees to it that he goes along with her.

Three years ago, JEANNE YORK and I ran a Panel discussion on making dresses, at Fresno, and we wrote up a sort of syllabus of all our ideas, for women to take home with them. Along with a lot of practical dressmaking ideas, we listed what we considered the minimum requirements for a Square Dance dress. They were:

1. It should be comfortable-- not too tight anywhere, not too hot, no loose ends in the wrong places.
2. It should be becoming to you.
3. It should look well on the floor, both in color and movement.
4. It should be practical -- washable, not too much ironing.
5. It should be gayer and more frivolous than your usual clothes-- after all, it is a costume.

We also stated that the skirt should be at least full enough to lie flat on the floor in a circle, and that there ought to be some sort of sleeve or shoulder covering. Our choice of length was, and is, somewhere around mid-calf, or ballerina length.

Bearing all these requirements in mind, you may be lucky enough to find a dress on a rack somewhere in an ordinary store that you could use for dancing. Unfortunately, most commercial Squaw-type dresses are not full enough, most sun-dresses are too sleeveless, and a lot of cotton house-dresses are too pale and washed-out to look well. Most women give up and make them. But the thing that saves the not-so-skillful home dressmaker is the fact that Square Dance dresses are costumes, and can be made quickly and not finished very well, and will still last until you are tired of them. Almost anyone can sew well enough to make them, and far from being an expense, they will save your regular clothes.

Still not convinced? Well, maybe you don't really need my advice at all. Maybe you should ask yourself if you could be unconsciously fighting against the whole idea of Square Dancing. Maybe you'd rather play bridge, or watch T.V. But why not give Square Dancing a chance? Why not try it whole heartedly for a while, clothes and all? Then, if you still can't see it, forget it. We can't please everybody.
