Lovers' Two-Step

By Ruth and Vern Smith -- Dearborn, Michigan

RECORD: "Lovers' Two-Step" ("Just Couldn't Say Goodby")
POSITION: Semi Closed, facing LOD MacGregor 820 - B
FOOTWORK: Opposite, directions for M
MEASURES

1 - 4 RUN, 2,3, BRUSH; RUN, 2,3, BRUSH; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;

Semi-closed pos starting M's L take 3 running steps in LOD, brush R; Repeat starting M's R; Maneuvering M's back slightly twd LOD and assuming CLOSED POS do 2 R-face turning two-steps, ending in SEMI-CLOSED pos facing LOD.

5 - 8 WALK,-,2,-; OUT,2,3,4; GRAPEVINE AWAY; GRAPEVINE TOGETHER (W ROLL L);

Step fwd 2 slow walking steps; Out L over R, and L over R; drop semi-closed pos and grapevine away from each other with a side behind, side, touch; M does a grapevine back to his partner as W rolls back to partner with a L-face turn, LRL-tch, to end facing LOD in semi-closed pos to repeat meas 1 - 8.

9 - 16 REPEAT MEAS 1-8. End facing LOD in semi-closed pos.

17 - 20 WALK, -,2,-; TWIRL,-,2,-; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;

Step fwd 2 slow walking steps; W twirls R-face in 2 steps as M takes 2 more walking steps; Assume closed pos for 2 R-face turning two-steps; end semi-closed pos facing LOD.

21 - 24 WALK,-,2,-; TWIRL,-,2,-; BOX TWO-STEP; BOX TWO-STEP;

Step fwd 2 slow walking steps; W twirls R-face in 2 slow steps as M takes 2 more slow walking steps ending closed pos with M's BACK TO COH; Do 2 box two-steps: side, close, fwd,-; side, close, back,-; ending in CLOSED POS, M's BACK TO COH.

25 - 28 (BWD) IN, 2,3, DIP; OUT, 2,3, TOUCH; TURN (R) TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;

In 3 quick steps LRL M backs into COH ending with a quick dip on 4th ct (bend L knee slightly, lift R ft slightly, keeping R ft pointed and knee stiff); Couple now moves twd wall by M going fwd 3 quick steps RLR-tch L (Do not maneuver); Do 2 R-face turning two-steps (1/4 turns) starting 1st two-step slightly twd LOD, ending with M's BACK TO WALL.

29 - 32 (FWD) IN, 2,3, DIP; OUT, 2,3, TOUCH; TURN (L) TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;

In 3 quick steps M goes fwd twd COH, LRL, and as W dips with L ft extended on 4th ct, M bends R knee slightly; M moves bwd twd wall in 3 quick steps RLR, tch L; 2 L-face turning two-steps starting 1st two-step slightly in RLOD to make 3/4 turn ending facing LOD, semi-closed pos.

DANCE IS DONE THREE TIMES IN ALL.

ENDING: WALK, -,2,-; TWIRL, -, BOW, -.

LET'S NOT BE KNUCKLEHEADS..

I guess I just thought that the whole idea of Knuckleheading was so stupid that it would blow over with no help from me. In fact, I hated to draw attention to it by blasting it. But it seems to be gaining ground instead, and I have had so many people ask me please to say what I think, that here it is.

The Knothead fad was screwy but harmless. The idea that anyone was crazy enough to drive a hundred miles just to go to a Square Dance made a lot of people laugh, and made other people want to prove that they were that crazy, too. My only objection was that in their eagerness to qualify for the badges, a lot of people lost sight of the real point. There is nothing essentially crazy about a whole Club hiring a bus and visiting another Club a hundred miles away -- actually, it is a fine idea -- but it means that everyone gets Knothead badges, even the sheep who just go along with the crowd. And the really Far-Out dancers, the ones who live over a hundred miles from the nearest good dance and drive that far all the time, are barred because the rules say they must have a whole square with them! As I say, though, no one gets hurt, and lots of people seem to get a kick out of wearing the badges.

The Knuckleheads are something else again. I have heard that the idea of Knuckleheads got started as a joke. That I can understand -- it might have been funny, just once. But to make a National Movement out of it, and encourage dancers to make every effort to get on the Bandwagon and make real Nuisances of themselves, not only to the Callers but to their neighbors who are not dancers, and maybe don't like dancers anyhow -- well, words almost fail me!

Actually, I don't know too much about the rules of either the Knuckleheads or the Idiots, a similar organization. My impression is that the main difference is that while Idiots are encouraged to wake up their own Caller, Knuckleheads have to wake up some other Caller. To me, the latter idea is much worse -- any Caller who has allowed his own dancers to get the idea that such an enterprise would add to their glory as Square Dancers, deserves what he gets. But the poor victim of a Knucklehead group has nothing to do with it at all, and is still expected to be a 'good guy', even if he only gets about five hours of sleep a night anyhow and has to get up at six, knows his neighbors think the whole crowd must be drunk, and would just love to turn the hose on all of them. He can't even beg them to pipe down -- half the 'fun' of a gag like this is in being raucous about it, and really whooping it up. Even if he tells himself that he is really being complimented -- the dancers must like him or they wouldn't have come -- it doesn't help much. Like most practical jokes, the victim has to be really victimized, or the joke is a flop.

If loss of sleep for a few Callers were the whole problem, however, they would just grit their teeth and let the whole silly fad run its course. But very seriously, there is more to it than that. One of the main selling points of Square Dancing as we know it, is the fact that it is such a clean form of entertainment. We shout and holler and have a good time, and our music sometimes stirs up a few people who live near halls, but we are known all over the country as one of the few big groups who never need policing, who never cause trouble when they congregate, and who don't mix drinking with their dancing. Churches like to sponsor Square Dancing, schools let us use their buildings, and cities welcome our Conventions, because we are a well-behaved, self-regulating, adult group of people, enjoying ourselves and not bothering anyone. And now here comes a bunch of adult delinquents, dressed in night clothes but obviously Square Dancers, waking up the whole neighborhood, and, even if they have honestly not had a drink, acting as if they have. What are people to think? Are we to allow a few uninhibited jokers to give our whole activity a bad name. The Callers think not.

At the last meeting of the Callers' Workshop of the Dancers' Association, a Resolution was passed disapproving of the whole idea of Knuckleheading, and a letter was sent to the Board of the Dancers' Association asking their cooperation in stopping it. It was the opinion of the Callers that if the dancers once realized what sort of impression they were giving, to people outside of Square Dancing, they would willingly give up this particular form of letting off high spirits, and think up something else. How about it?
