Round Dance Of The Month

DO YOU

By Marge and Vince Belgarbo, Skokie, Illinois

RECORD: "Do You Ever Think of Me" - Mercury 71307

POSITION: Varsouvianna, facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout. Directions given for M

MEASURES

- 1 - 4 WALK, 2, 3, TOUCH; LADY UNDER, 2, 3, TOUCH; LADY BACK, 2, 3 TOUCH; WALK, 2, 3, TOUCH;
In Vars pos M starting L walk fwd in LOD L, R, L, touch R; While M steps fwd R, L, R, touch L without releasing hands (W turns 1/2 R-face under M's raised L hand to face partner L hands crossed over R); M steps bwd L, R, L, touch R in RLOD (W makes 1/2 L-face turn under M's L arm back into VARS POS); M moves fwd LOD R, L, R, touch L.
- 5 - 8 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE TOUCH (LADY TURNS R); ROLL IN, 2, 3, TOUCH; TWO-STEP, TURN, TWO-STEP, TURN; TWIRL, 2, 3, 4;
Releasing L hands, step fwd L (grapevine) pivoting 1/4 R-face to face partner and wall, step R XIB of L, L to side, touch R to L (W steps out R, L, R, touch L making 3/4 R-face turn to face partner); Release hands and roll in individually in RLOD 1 full R turn R, L, R, touch L; In CLOSED POS do 2 quick turning two-steps; while M walks fwd L, R, L, R, (W twirls R, L, R, L) to end in VARS POS facing LOD.
- 9 - 16 REPEAT MEAS 1-8. End FACING PARTNER, BOTH HANDS JOINED, M's BACK TO COH.
- 17 - 20 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE (PIVOT), BRUSH; (BK-TO-BK) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE BRUSH; TWO-STEP, TWO-STEP, TWO-STEP, TWO-STEP;
(Grapevine) Step L to side along LOD, step R XIB of L, step L to side, and releasing M's L and W's R hands pivot slightly back-to-back and away from partner, brush R; Step R along LOD, step L XIB of R, step R to side (M facing COH), brush L; Releasing hands, make a solo L-face circle in 4 quick two-steps (W R-face) to end facing partner and wall, Joining hands.
- 21 - 24 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, TOUCH; ROLL IN, 2, 3, TOUCH; TWO-STEP, TURN, TWO-STEP, TURN; TWIRL 2, 3, 4;
(Grapevine) Step L to side along LOD, step R XIB of L, step L to side, touch R to L; Releasing hands roll individually twd RLOD 1 full R turn (W L-face) R, L, R, touch L; In CLOSED POS to 2 quick turning two-steps; M walks fwd 4 steps L, R, L, R (W twirls R, L, R, L) to end facing partner and rejoining hands, M's back COH.
- 25 - 32 REPEAT MEAS 17-24, ending in VARSOUVIANA POS to repeat dance.

THE TROUBLE WITH CALLERS

Don't get me wrong -- I love callers. I am continually surprised that there are so many good square dancers who willingly give up dancing -- and whose wives let them do it -- just to get up there and tell the rest of us what to do. I know how much work it takes to be prepared to put on that show every night, and I know how many have fallen by the wayside trying to do it. Callers are getting better and better all the time, too, and most of them are so competent and smooth and have such good technique that we take all that for granted. We never hear a 'poor' caller any more (well, hardly ever). But that does not mean that our callers are above criticism. They may have overcome most of the old faults that we used to complain about, but it is my contention that they are developing a complete new set of them, and I would like to raise a warning voice about a few trends I have noticed and don't like.

We used to have a lot of trouble hearing and understanding callers. The sound was fuzzy, even in small halls, because most callers did not really understand how to set up or use their equipment. Sometimes they sounded like tobacco auctioneers and sometimes they muttered. Mostly you had to guess a lot of what was being said, so you tried to learn a few cue phrases that would identify a whole figure for you. Remember 'Back you blunder'? If you heard that, you could just about finish the square yourself. 'Pop that line and feel their heft' took you right into the Harlem Rosette, and you could relax and dance. But what happens now? Now you can hear every word the caller says -- and what's more, you have to hear every word. The old figures that took a full 32 counts are never done any more, and most of the present commands don't even take a full 4 counts. 'Pass thru, face your own, box the gnat, half square thru --' where can you draw a full breath on a call like that? Sure, one or two squares like that are fun during the evening, to give you something to shoot at, but when every single patter call is made up of two-count commands, in no sort of order or pattern, the total effect is like taking your whole dinner and running it thru the blender -- same ingredients, but no variety or contrast.

Right here I can just see the reader sneering, 'She's a fine one to talk! Where do the callers get all that stuff? Right out of the Workshop Notes she's so proud of!' My answer to that is, so some of us run a salami factory. We make good salami, and we like to see you buy and eat it. But not just salami! Not for breakfast, lunch and dinner! Please, let's vary the menu.

I know the defense the callers put up, when they are charged with monotony. They say that no one knows the old pattern dances any more, but everyone can do the new things, so they are safer to call. I'll admit that -- so why not just agree that no one is supposed to know anything more than a year old, and when you want to call an old one, teach it as if it were new. Changing the old commands to conform with modern standards might help some of the old ones, but the charm of a lot of them is that once you get a certain pattern thru your head you really do know where you are going and you are free to relax and go there, knowing that you won't be tripped up until the end of the figure itself. With modern squares nothing is sacred, although there is a sort of gentlemen's agreement that if you say 'Grand right and left' you won't stop people until they have met their partners across the set. Any other command is subject to change without notice.

Nowadays, we are very tolerant toward callers who read their calls. We realize that modern calls are all so much alike that no one could memorize them all, so we are willing for the caller to use a crutch. But I think we are being a little too broad-minded in some cases. I don't object to a caller reviewing his notes before he starts a call, or even glancing at them from time to time. But I do get really annoyed when he reads a call word for word and never takes a look at the floor to see whether or not he is still calling for anyone. A caller who does not watch the floor and vary his timing and command according to what he sees is happening out there, is simply asking to be replaced, cheaper, by a record with calls by a good caller.

Here's another mild gripe. How many of you remember a campaign some of us lady

dancers were waging, years ago, against callers who made the same two ladies do all the work? They would call a figure for the Heads, finish up by having everyone promenade his corner lady, and then call the same figure for the Sides -- same ladies! If they called Heads and Sides again, it worked the same ladies four times. Well, finally the callers got the point, and learned to call everything twice for the Heads and twice for the Sides, which solved the problem. Now, most of the calls do not have you change partners -- the present trend is to work up to a dramatic moment when you hear - 'There's your corner, left allemande!' and promenade your own partner. But some callers still work the Heads thru a long figure, promenade back home, and then work the Heads again before they give the Sides a chance. Overcompensation, that's what it is.

One more complaint, and then I'll quit. I used to be thankful that we had gotten rid of most of what we called the 'Chiropractic' movements - 'Dive for the Oyster', 'Double Dish-Rag Turn', 'Oxbow Loop', and so on. We have thrown out 'Flap Those Girls' as being a real menace to adult backs, and we have ruled out the men going under in a 'Box the Gnat'. But we did not go farther and rule out 'Box the Gnat' and 'Box the Flea' entirely, and now see what happens! Callers are going hog-wild over those two arm-jerkers, and are using them in places where a simple arm turn would do just as well, to say nothing of that ultimate insult, 'Box the Gnat and box it back'. (I don't mind 'Double the Gnat' - you know you are going right back where you were, and you can beat it by just standing still.) But square dancers are not as flexible as they were -- at least, the same ones aren't -- and if you begin telling them to get involved in a lot of fancy gyrations that they don't like, you'll begin losing them. Whatever happened to our motto - 'If you can walk, you can Square Dance'?

highlights of the fresno barn

For a long time dancers in and around the Fresno area have dreamed of the time when they could boast of a real, authentic 1890 vintage square dance barn. Many clubs were forced to accept cramped quarters with poor acoustics. Good halls with nominal rental fees were hard to find.

BOB ANDERSON of FRESNO, who is a member of three square dance clubs, not only put in some thought on the matter, but decided to do something about it. The opportunity came along when the Old Wolters School was vacated. A friend of Bob's bought the school, and without hesitation Bob took it under lease. Of the many buildings acquired, one large hall has already undergone renovation. Here, amid all of the trimmings which make a barn, dancers are now meeting every night of the week.

Through the cooperative ability of the entire membership of the HIX 'N CHIX, PAIRS OF FOUR, and many other clubs, the social hall and cafeteria were completely remodeled into a Square Dance Barn. One lumber company in Clovis donated enough lumber for thirty benches and twelve large tables. The Chuck Room will seat 216 persons. The Main Hall and Chuck Room was rewired by electricians who donated their services. The plumbing was checked and serviced by six plumbers who also are dancers. Wagon wheel lamps were installed in the Main Hall. An old 1890 top buggy was restored to its original condition by members of the City Fire Department. It was then placed on the stage. Coat hangers were fashioned out of horseshoes. A huge western painting was donated by a member of the Western Artists' Assn. Its value has been placed at \$450.00. Old time cap and ball pistols, shotguns, rifles, saddle bags, pack saddles, coffee grinders, wagon wheels, deer horns, old time wall telephones and clocks were also donated. The Chief of Police donated a beautiful set of mounted Texas long horns. The dance floor was replaced with new maple flooring on each side of the hall, and then the floor was sanded to a nice smooth finish. The barn has just been painted "Barn red" and trimmed in white. The surface was so dry that 54 gallons of paint were used. A huge sign, 20 feet long, done in 1890 "Frontier Lettering" was just completed by BOB BERNER, a member of the HIX 'N CHIX.

It just shows you what people can do if they will put their combined efforts together. We are justly proud, here in the Fresno Vicinity, to have our own Barn. Come and visit with us and then maybe somewhere in your own area there may be an old school, packing shed, warehouse, etc. that could be made into your own Barn.

The location of the Barn, here in Fresno, is at First Street and Shaw Avenue (which is Highway 168). The phone number is Baldwin 2-9920. Fresno's Hospitality is always yours so you are always welcome to come and dance with us.
