I REMEMBER OSGOOD...

'Sets In Order', the National Square Dance Magazine, is ten years old this month, I would like to say 'Happy Birthday and Many Happy Returns!' For Dan's and my personal interest in Square Dancing all over the country is just about ten years old too, and we can look back and see that most of the credit for awakening that interest goes directly to 'Sets In Order' and to the man behind it, BOB OSGOOD.

We had been square dancing several years, in a sporadic and purely local fashion, when the first issue of 'Sets' appeared. One of the Callers had one, and as soon as we saw it we subscribed. I can still see that cold winter night in the old Fairfax Pavillion, when CHARLIE REINDOLLAR asked some of us to stay a few moments after class and help him work out a fancy new figure out of a magazine - 'Forward Six and Back you Blunder'. That was the first time I ever saw a square in print, or realized that people were still inventing them. It was an exciting moment.

Reading 'Sets' every month, after that, opened our eyes to the fact that Square Dancing was going on all over, and especially in Southern California, which was just entering a great boom. The first issue mentions that there were more than thirty Callers in the Los Angeles area (1), and almost 75 Clubs. (At that time, all the Square Dancers in the Bay Area had to go to the same dance every Saturday night to fill a hall.) But a year later, 'Sets' numbered 200 Callers, and enough Clubs to form a second Association. Things were picking up fast.

It was in 1950 that we first met Bob. By that time, we had read so much about the 'Sets In Order' Record Square that the first time we went to Los Angeles we dropped in to see it. What a reception we got! Thousands of Square Dancers before and since must have felt the way we did that day, when we found out that we were important to the staff of 'Sets' just because we were Square Dancers. We were greeted by Bob, shown around, offered records and booklets, and were invited to visit several Clubs in the area. I think we were even taken to dinner. We got a wonderful impression of Bob and the Orem's that day, that has stayed with us all these years.

It was in 'Sets' that we read about what was to be the Biggest Square Dance in the world -- the Diamond Jubilee at Santa Monica. We had never travelled farther than San Jose to a Square Dance, but once we had read about the plans they were making, we couldn't resist. We took our first step toward being truly National Square Dancers when we flew down there just for the dance. It really was the biggest, too - they said there were over 15,000 dancers dancing to the same Caller, for blocks and blocks along Wilshire Boulevard and Ocean Front. After that, we were sold.

We really got acquainted with Bob that same summer, when we went to Stockton Folk Dance Camp. That was the Square Dance year there, with a feud on between Texas and California, as represented by Herb Greggerson, then King of the Travelling Callers, and Bob Osgood, the young upstart challenging the Champ. It was good fun, and there were enough Square Dancers there that year to make it worth going, but even then Bob was dreaming of a Camp just for Square Dancers - not for leaders, like Pappy Shaw's famous one, but for everyone who loved to square dance. By the next year it was a reality.

We did not have to read in 'Sets' about Asilomar, because we were in on that from the beginning. Dan was writing Northern California News for the magazine by then, and handling local business for Bob, so when Jay Orem came up to look around, he and Dan drove to Asilomar and cased the joint. Since that time, there have been 17 Asilomar sessions, and we have not missed one.

It is hard to say what makes Bob Osgood the force he is in Square Dancing. He is a fine Caller, but not the world's best. He is obviously an organizer, with terrific energy and imagination. One of his greatest gifts is in the field of public relations -- he gets thru to people, whether they are beginners just stepping onto a dance floor or opinionated leaders who have been in the activity for years. Not that we always agree with everything he says -- far from it -- but we listen and we respect his opinions. Maybe the keynote is sincerity -- Bob is so obviously doing everything in his power for the good of Square Dancing that he seems to inspire you to do the same. Instead of thinking of Square Dancing as a casual hobby, you come away from a conversation with Bob feeling that by helping spread Square Dancing you are helping the human race.

It is this quality of inspiration that most people carry away with them from Asilomar. We all love the Squares and the Rounds, the wonderful setting and the fine people who come, and the discussions and new ideas and After Parties. But what really makes Asilomar for me, and for a lot of other people, is Bob Osgood at nine o'clock in the morning, teaching us to be better dancers, and then at the Fireside meetings, just talking. When he has with him Chuck Jones, that other fabulous High Priest of Square Dancing, to share or grab the mike, what more could anyone want?

We have danced with Bob in his own Club, as well as in Tucson, in Oklahoma City, in Banff, in San Diego, and in halls big and small up and down California. Now, by the time you read this, we will have embarked on the junket to end all junkets -- we will be on our way to Hawaii with Bob and his lovely Becky, and Chuck and Dotty Jones, and over thirty other couples from Bob's 'Rip 'n Snort' Club, for two weeks 'out of this world.' This is really the Top -- and where would it all be without 'Sets In Order'? Once again, Happy Birthday and Many Happy Returns!
