RECORD: "Rose Marie" Sunny Hills AC 3144 SO

POSITION: Closed, M facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout. Directions are given for the M

INTRO: 4 measures. Wait 2 meas; Balance apart, 2; Together, 4;

MEASURES

1 - 4 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; TWIRL, 2;3,4;

Starting M's L do 2 fwd two-steps progressing LOD; M walks fwd 4 steps (L,R;L,R;) while W does 2 RF twirls in 4 steps under M's L & W's R joined hands, ending in SEMI-CLOSED POS facing COH.

5 - 8 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; TURN AWAY, 2;3,4;

Starting M's L do 2 fwd two-steps twd COH; M turns LF (W, RF turn) with 4 walking steps (L,R;L,R;) describing arc returning to original circle, ending M facing LOD (W facing RLOD) ready to assume R forearm grip.

9 - 12 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; WAGON WHEEL, 2;3,4;

In R forearm grip pos do 2 two-steps, making a half-circle, M ending on outside facing RLOD; Do a regular wagon wheel (W, RF spot turn in 4 steps), M does 1/2 RF turn in 4 steps (L,R;L,R;) to end facing LOD, ready to assume L forearm grip.

13 - 16 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; REVERSE WAGON WHEEL, 2; 3,4;

In L forearm grip pos, do 2 two-steps, making a half-circle, M ending on inside facing RLOD; Do a reverse wagon wheel (W LF spot turn in 4 steps), M does 1/4 LF turn to face partner in 4 steps (L,R;L,R;) ending with both hands joined M's back to COH.

17 - 20 SIDE, BEHIND; PIVOT, SIDE; BEHIND, PIVOT; SIDE, BEHIND;

Starting M's L step L to side, step R behind L (1/2 grapevine); Step L to side pivoting back-to-back, drop leading hands, keeping trailing hands joined (M's R - W's L), step R to side LOD; Step L behind R, step R to side pivoting face-to-face, both hands joined; Step L to side, step R behind L (1/2 grapevine), ending in CLOSED POS, M's Back to COH.

21 - 24 TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN;

Do 4 RF turning two-steps progressing in LOD

25 - 32 REPEAT ACTION OF MEAS 17-24.

ENTIRE DANCE IS DONE THREE TIMES IN ALL.

ENDING: On the 3rd or last time thru - Meas 29-32 - instead of doing 4 turning two-steps, do 2 turning two-steps; Then, W does RF twirl under M's L & W's R hands, change hands and bow.

REPORT ON A 'FAMOUS FIRST'

"How was your trip to Hawaii? Did you have fun? Did you find the Islands much changed?" I have answered those questions hundreds of times in the last month, knowing all the time that most people who ask don't really want to know--any more than the people who ask you "How are you?" really want to know all your symptoms. Lots of people go to the Islands on a two-weeks' vacation, and they all bring back about the same pictures and souvenirs, so who cares?

The point is, no one but another Square Dancer would realize why this trip was different from every other trip anyone ever took to Hawaii. Did you ever stop for a hamburger on a long drive, and find out that the group in the next booth were Square Dancers too? Have you ever looked over the cars parked in front of a Motel and wondered how many of them belonged to other Square Dancers? Then imagine a trip, not especially for Square Dancing, but where fifty other people were your kind of people! Imagine waking up early in the morning on the ship and going on deck, and finding a corner of that deck already claimed by a gay, informal group, of whom you already knew several, and knew you would soon know the rest. We were the guests, remember -- the others were all members of the same Club, so they took it upon themselves to get acquainted with us as quickly as possible. And no matter what we did during those two weeks--bus rides, taxi rides, fancy dinners, cocktails, swims, shopping tours -- the people who sat or walked or loafed beside us were always Square Dancers. Who ever had a break like that before?

As I said, this was not a Square Dancing trip. We danced once on the ship, by request, because everyone on board was so much interested in us, and so curious. (We had special permission of the Commodore to come to dinner in our dancing clothes -- no coats for men -- and our poor Room Stewards were worried to death about us.) We had one big dance in Honolulu, where we entertained all the Island Clubs, and were in turn invited to a big dance where they entertained us. But that was all. The rest of the time, we were Tourists, in every sense of the word. We wore Aloha shirts and Muu-Muus, and carried loads of camera equipment, and bought beads and postcards, and dressed up and dined and danced at the Royal Hawaiian, and took surfboard lessons, and took all the Tours, and had a grand and glorious time. And thru it all, everywhere you turned, there was a Square Dancer.

We all discussed this phenomenon, and we finally came to the conclusion that there must be something in it -- that Square Dancers must really be a very special 'type'. We know they come in all sizes and ages, and have all sorts of jobs and home life. But we decided that there really is a sort of common attitude toward life shared by the majority of real Square Dancers -- a willingness to enjoy themselves wholeheartedly, an open mind toward new experiences, a habit of going more than half-way to make friends -- that makes it more fun to do anything if you can do it with a Square Dancer. And that was what made our "Rip 'n Snort Holiday" the very special event that it was -- and that is why we still can't seem to explain our trip to people who aren't Square Dancers. Obviously, they never would understand.

Judging by the enthusiasm shown for our group, and the cooperation we got from the Matson Company and the staffs of the 'Lurline' and the 'Princess Kaiulani', this trip may be only the first of many. If one Club can swing it, maybe others can. But even if you never get to Hawaii with your Square Dance friends, you'll surely find yourself doing other things with them besides dancing. The next time you sit down to dinner somewhere, between sessions at the State Convention, or at a Workshop Pot-Luck, just look around you and think how lucky you are to be associating with these particular people. Aren't you glad you are a Square Dancer?

The following classes of membership are available to you:

1. **Caller:** An active callers, calling to one or more classes or groups regularly for more than one year. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
2. **Teacher:** Teaches one or more folk or square dance group and is actively interested in improving square dance teaching. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
3. **Subscriber:** Either a caller or teacher as defined above but resides outside of the Northern California area. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
4. **Associate:** Does not qualify as a caller or teacher as defined above. Prospective or beginning callers or square dance teachers qualify as associates. Has no vote. Membership fee \$2.00 per year.
