MINORITY REPORT

by MADELINE ALLEN

Every time I make some strong statement as to what I like or don't like in Square Dancing as it is today, someone tells me that I am not a 'typical' Square Dancer. They say I have been dancing too long, and have done too much analyzing and arguing about Square Dances, and have too long a memory, to be typical. So maybe they are right, and maybe there aren't many of us. But I still think maybe I represent some Square Dancers -- maybe just a small group who have been dancing fairly steadily for ten years or more, who like to read and talk about Square Dancing and pick Squares to pieces, and who dance enough to be familiar with the new stuff as well as remembering the old. Speaking for Us, I'd like to mention a few things that I like or don't like, after all these years.

For instance, I find I am a lot more particular, now, about the condition of the floor than I am about the sound. Of course I'd like to hear easily, but if the sound is difficult I can get along by hearing a word here and there and guessing at the rest. Bad sound no longer spoils a dance for me. But a sticky floor means that I can't really dance -- I have to lift my feet and march or hop, and I have to give up even the few twirls I ordinarily do. I'd rather have the floor too slick - it may be dangerous, but it isn't nearly as tiring.

Then there is the question of the Rounds -- are there too many? As far as I am concerned, there are too many simple ones, all too much alike, that are danced one or two months and then dropped. The Rounds I really like to dance are the ones that took some work, not on remembering sequences, but on executing movements and going from one step to another smoothly. I realize that to learn Rounds of that type, under our present system, you would either have to attend a Round Dance class or some of the Institutes, because you don't have time in a Square Dance club to teach dances like that. But I have a suggestion. Why not take one simple two-step routine that will fit any Round-of-the-Month-type record, and just change the record each month. Then you could use your teaching time to teach one Round-of-the-Year, a little at a time. The Round Dancers could learn all the new ones as they came out, and at the end of the year the best one would be picked for everyone to learn during the following year. For 1957 I would nominate 'Think', or maybe 'Seventh Heaven', and for 1958 I think I like 'Summer Saunter'. That way, we could go on dancing the best ones for years.

In singing calls, I like a tune you can recognize, and I like a figure you have to remember a little. Whenever a caller gets all the way thru to the tag line before I know what I am dancing, it always turns out to be either 'The Banjo-Pickers' Ball' or 'Cotton Candy', both of which have easily forgettable tunes and figures. I liked the original figures in 'Poor Boy' and 'Linda Sue', which were fun to do once you really understood them. And I love 'John Henry', the tough version, which our Club has finally mastered. Once you know a singing call, you don't have to wait until the tune brings the right words around, but you can go ahead and dance to the music. For this reason, I am against hashing singing calls, and I particularly dislike stumbling blocks like 'Head ladies chain'-----the right hand lady! You can't catch me on that one any more -- I just stand and wait -- but it isn't much fun.

In patter calls, on the other hand, I don't want to know what is coming next. I don't care whether the call is old or new, but I would like to have it just a little different each time it is called, to keep you listening. The 'challenge' I like is made up of tricky changes, or calls that are really directional but make you think fast, or even Oldies to see if you remember them. The 'challenge' I don't like is when a call is made harder by calling it faster, or when a caller tries to throw the floor by piling commands one on top of the other so fast that you get three or four behind. I think 'Whirlwind' is one of the finest figures to come out lately, but if you have to scurry to get there it loses all appeal for me.

Speaking again as a minority group, compared to Square Dancers as a whole, I like Contras. (Did I hear a Boo?) I only like to dance them with good Contra dancers, however, who don't have to learn the fundamentals every time before they can start. The rules for Contras are different from the rules for Squares, and I don't think the two should be expected to

mix, necessarily. If a Club wanted to do a few Contras during the evening, instead of a few of the regular Rounds, I think it would be fine -- but I think they ought to learn them somewhere else, and only those who knew how, get up to dance. Maybe this would encourage others to want to know how -- or maybe it wouldn't. I know I wouldn't want to try to promote Contras in Square Dance Clubs. I'll do them once or twice a year, at Institutes where they really do them well, and forget about them in between.

One thing I have never liked is the cute Play Party type of square -- 'First lady out to the right, and pat him on the head' -- 'You did it so well, now do it again'! But I do like Mixers -- I like the idea of stirring up the floor every once in a while, with 'Scoot and Scat', or a 'Scatter Promenade.' I love doing four-couple figures with two couples, and I enjoy all forms of Cutting-in and changing sets, when they are done skillfully. To me, having 'Fun' at a Square Dance may be noisy and full of goofs, but it should not mean that people are not trying to do everything that is called, as well as the extra stuff they put in themselves. It is fun to dance seven couples in a set, if you can get thru at least the breaks right, and make a stab at the figure. It adds spice to have the men and women change places, if they can really do each others' parts. But let's learn to walk before we try to run -- make sure you can really follow the call before you try to be fancy about it.

One thing more -- the longer I dance, the less I feel that mere crowds mean success. If you can have enough dancers to pay your caller and your rent, and a little left over for stamps, and still have room to dance, I consider that you have it made. For that reason, I think, more and more Clubs are limiting attendance by advance ticket sales -- not with the idea of keeping anyone out, but in order to have some sort of control over the number of people who might suddenly decide to come that night. If you have a good caller and a good floor, and are all set for a fine evening, it's a little disconcerting to find that you can't squeeze onto the floor to dance, or move when you get out there. I guess that is just one more thing us minority dancers would really like to have -- room to dance without black-and-blue spots.

1959 is here at last, and to Sacramento area square dancers, that means only one thing--the big Sixth Annual Convention to be staged in California's capital city, March 20, 21 and 22. Featuring California callers and round dance instructors, a surprise luncheon for the ladies and Chuck's lunch for the men, discussion groups, exhibitions and an after party, The convention is well underway, and an Advisory Committee meeting was held recently at which many more details were discussed.

Approximately 4500 dancers are expected to be in Sacramento for the convention, and dancing will get underway at the Memorial Auditorium, Governor's Hall, Elk's Temple, and Masonic Temple. A special feature will be "curb-service registration" for the dancing in front of the auditorium. There, parking facilities will be set up along the street.

A list of the city's fine restaurants will be given each dancer for his convenience. And in the auditorium square dance exhibits will be featured with items to be sold there at the stands.

Governor Pat Brown has been asked to lead the grand march at the convention.

Lunch with CHUCK JONES of "Bugs Bunny" fame will be featured on Saturday, March 21, from 12 noon to 1:30 p.m. at the Elks Temple. And a special lunch featuring ideas, trends and fashions will be held with MARY ELSEL, emceeing. And BOB VAN ANTWERP will emcee a big after party to be held at the fabulous El Dorado Motel on Saturday, March 21st.

Sunday, March 22, being Palm Sunday, non-denominational church services will be held in the Little Theatre in Sacramento. Persons attending may do so in square dance attire. And, of course, there are many additional area churches which dancers may visit if they prefer.
