SENTIMENTAL TOUCH

By Nonie and Mary Moglia, Castro Valley, Calif.

RECORD: "Sentimental Touch" — Knapp #K-210X

POSITION: Semi-closed, facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout. Directions given for M

MEASURES:

- 1 - 4 WALK, -, 2, -; POINT, -, BACK. CLOSE: WALK, -2, -; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, DRAW:
In semi-closed pos facing LOD walk fwd 2 slow steps L, -, R, -; Point L fwd, -, step L bwd, close R to L; Repeat Meas. 1 turning to face partner M's back to COH on last count; Grapevine along LOD: step L to side, step R behind L, step L to side, draw R to L retaining weight on L and turning to face RLOD
- 5 - 8 WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; TURN TWO-STEP: TURN TWO-STEP
Starting M's R walk fwd in RLOD R, -, L, -; Turning to face partner in loose closed pos step R to side along RLOD, close L to R, cross R in front of L (W-XIF also), -; In closed pos do 2 turning two-steps progressing in LOD, to end in open pos facing LOD.
- 9 - 12 STEP, CLOSE, STEP, BRUSH; CROSS OVER, 2, 3, BRUSH: LH STAR, 2, 3, BRUSH; ON AROUND, 2, 3, BRUSH;
In open pos progress slightly away from partner stepping L, close, L, brush R; Partners change sides W crossing under joined M's R & her L hands (Calif. Twirl) stepping R, close, R, brush L to end in LH star pos, M on outside of circle; Star around turning CCW (L, close, L, brush R; R, close, R, brush L) to end in loose-closed pos, M's back to COH.
- 13 - 16 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, TOUCH; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE TOUCH; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;
Starting M's L grapevine along LOD; step L to side, step R behind L, step L to side, and touch R beside L; Repeat grapevine and touch along RLOD; In closed pos do 2 turning two-steps progressing in LOD. End in semi-closed pos.
- 17 - 24 REPEAT MEAS 1-8, ending in open pos facing LOD.
- 25 - 28 WALK, 2, 3, BRUSH; CHANGE SIDES, 2, 3, BRUSH; CHANGE SIDES, 2, 3, BRUSH; TOGETHER, 2, 3, BRUSH;
In open pos progress fwd LOD L, R, L, brush R; Dropping handholds partners change sides with M crossing behind W twd wall (stepping R, L, R, brush L) while W crosses in front of M twd COH to end both facing LOD and about 1 1/2 ft. apart (M on outside); Then M moves diagonally fwd twd COH (Stepping L, R, L, brush R) in front of W as W moves diag bwd twd wall; Then M moves bwd R, L, R, brush L to meet W as W comes fwd to end in closed pos M's back to COH.
- 29 - 32 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, DRAW; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, DRAW; TWIRL, 2, 3, TOUCH; REV/TWIRL, 2, 3, TOUCH;
Starting M's L grapevine along LOD; step L to side, step R behind L, step L to side, and draw R to L (retain wt on L); Starting M's repeat along RLOD; Then M repeats the grapevine along LOD while W does a R-face twirl and touch under M's L and her R hands; Starting M's R repeat the grapevine along RLOD while W does a L-face twirl and touch under the same joined hands to end in semi-closed pos to repeat dance.

What Do You Mean, Ethics?

The subject for this month was supposed to be, 'Ethics for Square Dance Clubs.' However, on reading over a letter I received requesting that subject, I found a sentence that think may contain, unintentionally, the key to the whole question. The sentence is, 'We have attempted to get the Association to put out an article on Ethics but they do not feel that it is within their sphere.'

The point here is, just whose sphere is the subject of Ethics within? I am flattered to be asked to discuss it, but I certainly don't feel that I should pose as any sort of authority. The fact is, Ethics is a very broad subject, and means various things in various areas. An one can say 'Square Dance Clubs should try to be fair to each other and should not do any thing that would hurt Square Dancing as a whole', but that is about like a Politician coming out against Sin. It may be what you mean, but it does not help very much.

I do feel that I have an answer, of sorts, to the question of who is to define who Ethics that should apply in a particular area. I think the answer is the small local Association which includes only those Clubs which are in direct competition with each other. I feel that the Northern California Association is far too big, and covers too many areas, too different in population and activity, to be able to answer questions for any special area. For instance in the East Bay there are so many dances every night in the week that no one could possibly be accused of intentionally competing with any one dance, whereas in a small country area there may be only two Saturday Night Hoedowns a month, and it would obviously be ridiculous to schedule them both on the same night. It is in these smaller areas, rather remote from the big centers of dancing, where the number of Clubs and dancers is limited, that the small informal Association has its place.

Even in a small Association, however, I doubt if rigid rules for Ethics can be laid down. The old familiar rule, the Golden one, still holds good -- but it is a lot easier to find out what things might hurt other Clubs if someone from each Club in the area sits down together once a month and discusses the problem. It is easy to list the dances scheduled for each Saturday in the month and find out which Saturdays are overcrowded and which are rather vacant. If a new Club wishes to schedule a Hoedown, the representative can propose his Club's plan, and he can see at once what the Club will be up against. If a big name Caller is available, it might be that several Clubs could get together and sponsor him jointly -- perhaps giving complimentary tickets to the Club callers who might have lost a chance to call. And if any Club thinks it has a grievance against any other Club, this is the place to air it, and it will not be hard to see which one has public opinion behind it. A Club that finds that no one in the area approves of its policies would do well to consider a change.

For what it is worth, I do have a few ideas of my own, about Ethics. I am certainly against any intentional attempt to injure any other Club, or to profit at any other Club's expense. I am also (personally) against door prizes, lavish food, phony feuds, or any other gimmick to get more dancers - I prefer to have Clubs concentrate on the essentials, like good callers, good sound, and a good floor, and, of course, a good program of Beginner classes, so as to keep new Square Dancers coming on. All these things help. BUT - I do find that whenever a Club, or a Caller either, begins to complain about unethical practices on the part of the competition, my first reaction is to wonder just what is wrong with that Club or that Caller. A large, successful Club is always going to outdraw a small, unsuccessful one -- but what does it have that made it that way to begin with? Are the dancers better? Is the Caller better -- or a better teacher? Are the people more friendly, more enthusiastic, more energetic about planning good parties? What could the smaller Club do to equalize things? Or can it? Might it better change its dance to another night, when the competition was less tough? Or, if the factor that makes the Club less successful than the other is that the dancers are a little less 'high level', would the Club be smart to stress a 'Fun Level' dance, and

try to attract other dancers who are happier in a more relaxed atmosphere? There are dancers who care more about having friendly faces around them than they do about the reputation of the Caller. Anyhow, I'd say to that Club, try any other ideas you can think of, but don't start yelling 'Unfair!' just because you are outclassed.

Sacramento State Convention Highlites...

1)...SQUARE DANCING AROUND THE WORLD

BOB OSGOOD will present this session using his experiences gained in his travels around the globe. Probably movies will be a part of this session.

2)...SQUARE DANCING AROUND THE U.S.A.

ED GILMORE will present the picture of square dancing in our own United States, covering different phases of the hobby as seen in the different areas.

3)...SQUARE DANCE COMMUNICATIONS

The representatives of Magazines, Dancer Organizations, and Caller Organizations will get together to discuss the magazines, and other methods of getting the news of our hobby to all concerned. BOB BARTHOL of Northern Association will be the moderator of this session.

4)...CLUB PROBLEMS

BOB VAN ANTWERP and BOB COPPES will moderate this session during which two principle topics will be explored: The re-vitalizing of clubs that are dropping out and the saving of the older or experienced dancer. No doubt many other problems confronting clubs will also be explored.

5)...SOUND

JIM HILTON will conduct a clinic on the use of the modern sound equipment available to callers. This will include the better methods of setting up for dances in the average hall, the defeating of some of the ever present sound difficulties found in the halls we use for dancing and many other phases of the square dance sound picture.

6)...ROUND DANCE LEADERS

This will be a session for the Round Dance Leaders and instructors and will cover the teaching of basics, intermediates, etc. This will be conducted by the HAMILTONS, CROSBYS, and RICHARDS.

7)...STANDARDIZATION

BRUCE JOHNSON will conduct this discussion on the old problem of standardizing the square dance figures and movements in the different areas. With his extensive experience and traveling this should be a real good session.

8)...VOICE TECHNIQUES

A professor in voice will be called upon to conduct this new type of session for the caller. The professor will be from Sacramento State College and will have a knowledge of the requirements on our caller's voice requirements so some real valuable assistance to the caller should come from this.

9)...RECORDS

This will be a session on the selection of records for callers and dancers. It will cover the methods of preparing and presenting singing call material to the record companies. The leader of this session hasn't been definitely confirmed at this time but it will be someone connected with the record production field.

EXHIBITIONS....

The BOB-O-LINKS are a group of teenagers ranging in ages 15 to 19 who have been doing exhibition dancing for the past four years under the direction of BOB & NITA PAGE. They come from various parts of the Bay Area and are sponsored by the Hayward Area Recreation District. For the past three years they have been featured at the Golden State Roundup in Oakland and were at the Squar-Rama in Fresno and the State Fair Dance in Sacramento last year. They will also appear at the Roundup in May 1959. They have made numerous appearances in the Bay Area at various dances, benefits, lodges, etc., and have appeared on television both live and on film.

The SPINNERS were formed three and a half years ago, and have appeared at the Golden State Roundup two years, different lodges, and have been on television several times.

The PROMENETTES are made up of 20 youngsters ages 13 & 14 years from Los Angeles. They have been together over three years. LARRY WARD is 22 and director of the group. They have worked for Walt Disney, did a big show at the Shrine Auditorium for the Shriners, put on three shows at the Los Angeles County Fair and won the second largest trophy given for entertainment, represented Southern California at the National Convention in Louisville, Ky. In 1958 and were at that time asked to go to Brussels for the World Fair but didn't go because of many problems. The group is going to Phoenix in February for the Sun Valley Festival. The type of exhibition dancing done is silent hashes stressing styling and precision, rounds stressing waltzes and complicated footwork, square dancing in jazz style (jitterbug).
