SQUARE DANCE ~ WHERE?

8TH ANNUAL NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION IN DENVER MAY 28-29-30 - 1959

This year the Council of Square Dance Associations is actively sponsoring a three point program to stimulate greater California attendance at the National Convention in Denver, Colorado, May 28, 29, 30 and to assist in providing for a little more fun and good fellowship for those California square dancers attending the convention.

The Cosmopolitan Hotel has been established as California Headquarters. A total of 300 rooms have been set aside for California reservations and will be held as such until April 15th. Housing in Denver for the Convention already gives indications of becoming critical so send in your registrations and reservations early. George Nichols, general chairman, reports that over 2000 registrations from 38 states are already in, with the tempo increasing daily. For those who desire motel reservations, arrangements have been made, through the convention housing committee, to channel all California motel reservations into Mosko's Holiday Manor Motel. When the capacity of this motel is reached, subsequent reservations will be placed by Mr. Mosko in nearby approved motels. Thus all California square dancers staying in motels will be close together, and on the west side of town, close to the mountain resort area and to Lakewood, where the midnight rodeo after-party will be held.

The California Special Fun Train arrangements have been made and reservations are already rolling in. Both pullman and chair car accommodations are available and this promises to be one of the highlights of the convention trip for California Square dancers. Reservation blanks are being circulated by all the associations, with complete information thereon. Typical round trip rates, per couple, are \$194.76 pullman, or \$121.55, chair car. Reduced rates for meals enroute will also be available. Carl Anderson, general chairman of the 1st National Convention in Riverside and member of the convention executive committee, has designated as Train Director, and all reservations or request for further information should be forwarded to him at 330 West Cypress Ave., Redlands, phone Pyramid 2-1693. Various fun activities are being planned for the trip, including an empty baggage car for square dancing. Reservations must be in prior to April 15, and must be accompanied by a minimum of 25% of the total fare, with any balance due by May 1st.

how about after parties ?

Now there's a good controversial subject -- After Parties! Are you for them or against them? And what kind are you talking about? Is your mental picture of an After Party a mob of about fifty people in a tract-house living room, sitting on the floor and trying to out-shout each other while the hostess starts the coffee from scratch? Or is it more like standing in line for an hour in the same gym where you danced all evening, trying to decide whether to keep your place and hope you'll get to the buffet table eventually, or give up and dance the next p and hope the line will be shorter by then? Do you think of an After Party as a chance to sit and talk, or as a chance to dance more than you already have, to different and faster callers, or as a Show put on for your entertainment? Or would you just as soon go out somewhere and eat?

Under 'After Parties I Have Known', I could list all sorts, with good and bad examples for each. I have been to dancers' homes where the party seemed to prepare itself, and we could sit down in quiet surroundings, with our coffee at our side, and listen to the Guest caller talk. I have been to elegant buffets in Hotels, where you were made to feel that you must be the Elite or you would not be there, but where there were so many Elite that you might as well have gone around the corner with your own small group and had a hamburger -- you never got near the Guest of Honor anyhow. I have been to the World's Worst After Party, which shall be nameless, where 1200 tickets were sold at a stiff price, no food or drink was even planned to be served for an hour, there were not enough tables or chairs so that people stood in rows around the walls, and when, after an hour and a half, waiters finally began filling out tables loaded with elegant food, no lines were formed, the standees mobbed the tables, and we left. (I never did find out what the 'Entertainment' advertised consisted of -- so far, it had been more and faster dancing, on too small a floor.) In contrast, I would like to make a bow to Tucson, where we attended what we consider the best 'Open' After Party we have ever seen, where the minute you walked in the door you were handed a covered plate containing a cold lunch and were directed to several coffee stands dotted around the room -- large gym with plenty of chairs for everyone and plenty of floor space for dancing whenever you felt like it. We learned later that one Club had missed half the dance that night to prepare for us, as their contribution to the Festival, and I would like to assure them that it was appreciated.

There are a few general rules for After Parties that I think should be better understood. Actually, they are the same rules that hold for any party anyone gives. The first and broadest rule is, don't bite off more than you can chew. Don't invite more people than you can accommodate, even if you have to leave a few people out. Don't make people wait for food -- they have been dancing all evening, and what they want is a breather and a cup of coffee, so they can enjoy dancing again, or even talking to each other. Don't try to be too elaborate -- anyone who has ever been to a Potluck dinner should know how it slows down the line -- have too many things to choose from. And above all, think first about the purpose of the party -- don't just assume that you have to have an After Party after every dance because you always have had one. Maybe you are knocking yourself out to no purpose.

I can think of several good reasons for planning an After Party, instead of just going out to eat. One is, to honor a Guest Caller, and give him a chance to talk to people he knows, or might like to meet. For this purpose, the party ought to be small enough so that he really can talk to everybody, and the people invited should be picked with that in mind -- not just the members of your own Club. Otherwise, you may get the situation of the group of people who know each other too well, and who spend the evening yakking about their own interests while the poor Guest of Honor is ignored. If you feel you can't have a party at all without inviting the whole Club, better take your guest out somewhere with one or two congenial couples and have a real visit.

Another good reason for an After Party, or maybe several of them, is to entertain dancers who have come a long way to attend a big weekend event. Parties of this kind almost have to be large, and someone has to do a lot of work to make them successful. But if you

think of these big regional Festivals and Roundups as social affairs with the local Association as Host, it should not be too much more effort to include plans for After Parties especially for guests. It is only when you try to include all the local dancers as well that things get out of hand. Here again it is hard to draw the line, although attempts are being made - usually by requiring reservations, or a First Come First Served basis, on the theory that the farther you come the longer in advance your plans will be made. This system will work only until the local dancers catch on -- then they will reserve early too, and the guests may find themselves out in the cold again.

Another method often used for providing an After Party for visitors only is the Invitational Party. Here you start with a Club or Committee, or all the Club Presidents, or some such local group, and add to it the Guests of Honor, both local and out-of-town, and then try to contact and invite all the dancers who came to the event from a distance. Here you have to watch out for two things -- not to miss any visitors, and not to crowd the party with too many local dancers. Here is a chance to give recognition to those unobtrusive workers behind the scenes who contribute so much to any big Square Dance event. Goodness knows they get little enough of it.

What about the other extreme -- the most informal party of all, completely unplanned? If it follows the general rule -- don't invite more people than you can take care of -- it can be the nicest of all. Some people are never caught without a cake in the freezer or ham in the icebox, and can make coffee while you are washing your hands. One of our pleasant Square Dance memories is of a party like that, when we were a long way from home, and were standing in one of those too-long lines waiting for refreshments at one of those too-big After Parties. The couple in front of us, whom we had met for the first time in the last square, turned around and said, 'At this rate we'll be here all night. How about coming home with us for a snack instead?' That was the beginning of a long friendship, and we left there the next day with a very warm feeling about that city, just because of two nice people.

I still don't know the answer to the question of After Parties. I still send for tickets or accept invitations with a little thrill of anticipation, but I don't know exactly what I expect or really want. I guess if the dance has been a success, I want the pleasure to go on a little longer, and to be able to talk it over with people who were there too. If the floor was too crowded for good dancing, or the level too low, I'd like to get in a few really swingin' squares before we quit. If the dancing was so good that my feet are dead, I'd like a chance to sit comfortably and replace some of the energy we danced off. Most of the Travelling Callers are good friends of ours, and I always look forward to talking and/or arguing with them. Sometimes I feel that I have found what I wanted, and sometimes I wish I'd gone straight home to bed. Do other people necessarily feel the same way about the same party? Maybe trying to please everybody is just a gamble anyhow -- who knows? I don't.
