BENEFITS---MUST WE?

My message this month is a short one, and I'm afraid it may also be an unpopular one -- at least, with some people. That's why I want to get it out now, while it is still general -- later, some people might take it personally.

What all this is leading up to is, I'm against Benefit Square Dances unless the cause to be benefited is something that is of interest primarily and exclusively to Square Dancers. I am all in favor of trying to raise a little money for a fellow Club member who has had a real tragedy and needs the help, or for a Community House where Square Dancing will be a part of the program. Sending Exhibition Groups to Conventions is all right with me, too, or sending your Caller to Asilomar. All these projects are of special interest to us just because we are Square Dancers, and we can ask our dancing friends to help out without feeling apologetic. They are also -- and this is important -- projects to which we have no other opportunity to contribute. The Benefit Square Dance, in these cases, is an announcement by a Club or Association that there is a fund being raised for a given cause, and that this is your one chance to get in on it.

Now contrast this type of Benefit with the type we are constantly being asked to sponsor, or plan, or call for, or sell tickets to. Maybe it is for one of the major National Funds -- March of Dimes, Heart Fund, Muscular Dystrophy -- or for something purely local like your Church or P.T.A. Anyhow, it is sure to be a Worthy Cause, and already well publicized. But someone on the Committee knows that you are connected with Square Dancing and gets the bright idea of asking you to put on a special Square Dance and contribute the Proceeds to them. My advice is, no matter how good the Cause or how much you are willing to back it personally, beware of that tricky word 'Proceeds.'

If there is one thing that we all ought to know about Square Dancing by now, it is that it is a Non-Profit activity. Bob Osgood made the point in 'Sets in Order', a month or so ago, that the best Clubs are always broke -- a fat Treasury seems to make a Club uneasy. Those of us who plan dances and hire Callers and rent halls are concerned only with coming out in the black. -- we always try to set the admission charge as low as we can and still make expenses. Callers are certainly not getting rich -- the vast majority of them are making only enough to help pay for their equipment, so that what is to them an expensive hobby will not be too much to carry. Those who make a profession of Calling charge more, but out of that amount they must live and travel, and the result is about the same. Since all the rest of the work of putting on a Square Dance is done by unpaid enthusiasts, it is a little hard to see where the profits from a 'Benefit' are supposed to come from. Obviously, the 'net profit' from a regular Hoedown wouldn't make much of a splash.

Here is where the usual semi-legal, bullying and coercing gimmicks come in. Club members must be given a quota of tickets to sell, presumably to outsiders as well as dancers. Local merchants must be shaken down for Door Prizes, so that people who do not dance will buy tickets anyhow. Naturally, the Caller will be expected to donate his services, even though he could have had a paying job somewhere else on the same day. Part of the dance time must be taken up with drawings for the prizes, with maybe a few extra raffles thrown in to squeeze people a little more. And dancers who had been planning to attend other scheduled Hoedowns on the same night are pressured into coming to the 'Benefit' instead, because it is for such a good Cause. They are urged to 'Get behind this Benefit, and show the world what Square Dancing can do!'

So what? If you do make a few hundred dollars, by using all the angles and buying a lot of the tickets yourselves, all that happens is that when the next big Drive comes along you are asked to do it again. If you sponsor a dance for Polio, why not for the Red Cross or the Guide Dogs? There really is no answer to that one. In the long run, it will work out a lot better for us all if we just keep on insisting that Square Dancing is essentially a non-profit operation and should not be used as an excuse to put the bee on people as Square Dancers for the same things they have already contributed to as individuals. Then when a real Square Dance Cause comes along, we'll find that we have a full reservoir of enthusiasm and good will to put into it.
