

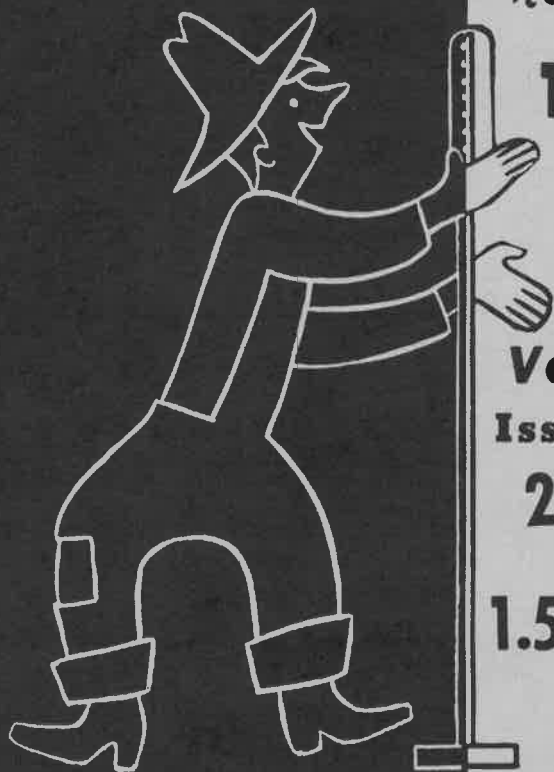

ROUND DANCE OF THE MONTH



"DRIFTING AND DREAMING"

DANCE: Jack & Na Stapleton - Grasse Pointe, Michigan
RECORD: Windsor #4654 - 45 RPM
POSITION: Partners facing, M's R & W's L hands joined, M facing diag to R of LOD
FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout, steps described are for the M
INTRO: Walt 2 meas; then usual acknowledgement taking BUTTERFLY pos, M facing LOD.

MEASURES:

- 1-4 TWINKLE OUT; TWINKLE IN; FORWARD, BACK, CLOSE; MANEUVER, 2, 3;
 In butterfly pos step on L ft diag fwd & XIF of R, W - XIB, step on R ft near L, close L to R; step on R ft diag fwd & XIF of L, W - XIB, step on L ft near R, close R to L; retaining joined hands, partners "float" away to arms length with 1 waltz step, M making a short step diag fwd twd wall on L, stepping bwd diag twd COH on R & closing L to R, while W takes 2 short steps diag bwd twd wall, R-L, & closes R to L; M takes 3 steps, R-L-R, almost in place but turning about 1/2 R to face RLOD while he gives W a strong lead to start her into a solo 1/2 L turn in 3 steps, L-R-L, W progressing slightly RLOD on outside of circle, to end in closed pos, M's back twd LOD;
- 5-8 WALTZ (RF); WALTZ; WALTZ; TWIRL (TO BUTTERFLY);
 Start bwd in LOD on L ft & do 3 R turning waltz steps, progressing down LOD & making 1 1/2 turns to end with M facing LOD; W makes a full R-face twirl under her R & M's L arm with 3 steps, L-R-L, while progressing down LOD in front of M, as M follows with 3 steps, R-L-R, to end in BUTTERFLY pos, M facing LOD;
- 9-12 TWINKLE OUT; TWINKLE IN; FORWARD, BACK, CLOSE; MANEUVER, 2, 3;
 Repeat action of meas 1-4.
- 13-16 WALTZ (RF); WALTZ; WALTZ; WALTZ; (TO SEMI-CLOSED);
 Start bwd in LOD on L ft & do 4 R turning waltz steps, progressing down LOD & making 1 1/2 turns to end in semi-closed pos, both facing LOD; (no twirl)
- 17-20 WALTZ FWD; STEP, SWING, -; WALTZ BWD; FWD, TOUCH (face), -;
 In semi-closed pos, start L ft & take 1 waltz step fwd in LOD; step fwd on R ft, swing L ft fwd, hold 1 ct; start L ft & take 1 waltz step bwd in RLOD; step fwd in LOD on R ft, touch L toe beside R ft while turning 1/4 R to face partner with M's back twd COH & taking closed pos, hold 1 ct;
- 21-24 BAL BWD; PIVOT THREE-QUARTERS; TWIRL (to semi-closed); FWD, TOUCH -;
 Bal bwd twd COH on L ft, hold 2 cts; with 3 steps, M's R-L-R, do a couple pivot making a 3/4 spot turn, to end with M facing LOD; W makes a 1 1/2 R-face twirl with 3 steps, R-L-R, progressing down LOD as M takes 3 steps alongside, L-R-L, to end in semi-closed pos facing LOD; step fwd on R ft, touch L toe beside R ft, hold 1 ct;
- 25-28 WALTZ FWD; STEP, SWING, -; WALTZ BWD; FWD, TOUCH (face), -;
 Repeat action of meas 17-20
- 29-32 BAL BWD; PIVOT THREE-QUARTERS; TWIRL (to butterfly); FWD, TOUCH, -;
 Repeat action of meas 21-24 except to end twirl done in meas 31 in BUTTERFLY POS, M facing LOD; step fwd in LOD on R ft, touch L toe beside R, hold 1 ct;

PERFORM ENTIRE DANCE A TOTAL OF THREE TIMES

ENDING: During meas 31 & 32 of the third sequence of the dance, W twirls down LOD with 4 slow steps, R-L-R-L, while M steps alongside L-R-L-R, to end with partners facing and fairly close together; with M's R & W's L hands joined, partners bal away from each other, M stepping bwd twd COH on L & W stepping bwd twd wall on R, to leisurely acknowledge as the music ends.

HALF SQUARE BLUES

Back in September, when I took a crack at unnecessary New Basics, I mentioned the fact that a very few of them seemed potentially useful. By that I meant that the dancers could probably learn to do them automatically, as they do a Right and Left Thru, so that Callers could mix them in with their regular Hash calls in order to provide more variety.

One of the Newer Basics I had in mind was the Square Thru family. I am happy to report that, after only two years of practice, most Square Dancers seem to be able to do a 'Full Square Thru' without any trouble. They can also do a 'Half Square Thru' when it is followed by a 'Right and Left Thru with the Outside Two', because that has become one of the standard beginnings for a patter call. But there are several offshoots of these simple forms of 'Square Thrus' that are still floor-stoppers, and it seems to me that they need a fuller explanation than the Callers seem to be giving them, and a lot more practice.

For instance, I have heard dancers arguing about a 'Left Square Thru', which some of them seem to think means the kind of a 'Square Thru' where the couples are half-sashayed, so that the man has to make a Left turn each time instead of a Right turn. Now I'm sure you know that that figure is really an Arkie Square Thru, although it is not so called - the man is simply doing the girl's part, and the Left turn is her usual turn. The 'Left Square Thru' is the regular pattern but starting with the Left hand. You still count four hands, which still seems to be the surest way of coming out right, but they are now Left, Right, Left, Right and pull her by. See?

Here is one for the Callers -- fellows, did it ever occur to you that the way most of you say it, there is very little difference between 'Half Square Thru' and 'Left Square Thru'? Most of the time it is obvious to the dancers which one you mean - after all, if you have just used your Right hand the next one ought to be the Left. But sometimes we have no clue like that, and we'd appreciate something more specific, like 'Square Thru Just Half' or, as some Callers say, 'Left hand out, a Left Square Thru' -- unless, of course, you want to make it hard for us.

The most difficult thing for dancers to grasp about the Square Thru, apparently, is the fact that it is Square. The command tells you exactly what to do and where to stop, and there are no extra manoeuvres involved, like Courtesy Turns or California Twirls. No matter how you end up after you have pulled the last person by (which you had better do), you stay there, back to back with that person, until you are rescued by another command.

This 'Squariness' of the Square Thru is what makes it new and different, and it tempts originators to try and think up new angles. (The commands seem so specific - how can anyone make a mistake?) It tempted me, and earlier this year I wrote a thing called the 'Half Square Dogleg.' It had nothing in it but Half Square Thrus, California Twirls, Turn Alones, and a few Those Who Cans. The action followed the shape of a Dogleg Hole on a golf course. The peculiar thing about this square is that top Callers from all over the country have told me again and again how much they liked it - more than anything else I have ever written - and yet no one ever calls it. The reason, they tell me, is that the dancers can't do it. And the reason the dancers can't do it is that, first, they don't do the figures squarely enough, and second, when they end up facing nowhere they get panicky and start looking around for help. Even if they do get thru the first half, with normal Half Square Thrus, they goof it in the second part when their partners are on the wrong side. I guess each of those Callers who were so crazy about it must have had one special group in mind that he wanted to take down a peg or two, and this Square did it.

The reason I bring up the 'Half Square Dogleg' is to point out that, tough as it is, there is no New Basic involved there. The Square Thru has been out almost three years now, and there are still plenty of ways of using it that are completely new to most dancers. To my way of thinking, about the best use of the figure was 'Whirlwind', where you 'Square Thru just like that, the Sides divide and box the gnat.' But, typically, people learned to do that figure by memorizing it as a whole, instead of by following each call. If you don't believe that, watch the floor some time when a Caller who is calling a simple Hash of 'Dive thru, pass thru, Right and Left thru with the Outside two', goes into 'Whirlwind' with warning.

When he says 'Sides divide and box the gnat' -- nothing! Those inactive couples have gone sound asleep, and are waiting their turn to do all the exciting stuff while the Heads stand still. Those same dancers are thrown by a simple gimmick like 'Dive thru, pass thru, there's your corner -- Right and Left Thru!' They hear only what they expect to hear, and apparently the only way to wake them up is to use a term they have never heard before, preferably in a loud voice. 'Dive thru, pass thru, TURN TURTLE,' you cry, and then wait for the double take.

I don't know what I have proved by all this -- I guess it is just a case of Me as an originator complaining about Me as a dancer. I suppose there is a sort of gruesome value in having a brand New Basic once in a while -- if the dancers have never heard the term before, they at least know they don't know what you mean. Just for a moment, they may be willing to stop and listen.
