The First Twenty And The Next Ten

Have you ever had a beginning dancer ask you 'How many things do I have to learn before I can go to a Square Dance?' Not 'How long do I have to go to Class,' but 'How many new words and phrases do I have to memorize?' Well, if you have hemmed and hawed a few times trying to answer that one, there is good news for you. The answer may be coming up.

For some time now, the flood of 'New Basics' has been worrying a lot of people. We all realized that it was getting harder and harder to teach Square Dancing, and that Beginner Classes were getting longer and longer and Clubs were having a harder and harder time assimilating their new members. The trouble was, everyone's solution was different. Some teachers insisted on taking their dancers through every step of the route they themselves had travelled, and then trying to bring them up to date in additional lessons. Other teachers figured that a lot of the dances they used to do are now obsolete, and tried starting beginners on what they thought would be the things most likely to be called at the first Hoedown the new dancers might attend. In leaving out some of the 'Old Basics', each teacher had to make his own choice, with the result that a Caller faced with the problem of picking material for a Beginners' Hoedown had no idea what the other Callers had already given their dancers. A Caller used to be pretty safe calling 'Dip 'n Dive' to any group, but now he might get nothing but blank stares from half the dancers, whereas those who could do it would be stumped by a 'Square Thru'. What has been needed all along is a set of Ground Rules for the sport of Square Dancing which would include the idea of progress while keeping the activity within bounds. Now I think we are going to have just that.

The opening gun was fired last Spring, at the National Convention in Denver, by Joe Lewis. His speech there was widely discussed and argued Pro and Con, and after he had repeated it, by request, at Asilomar, it was printed in full in 'Sets in Order.' That article (in the September issue) ought to be read in its entirety by anyone interested in trends in Square Dancing, but the part with which I am especially concerned right now was his proposal to set an arbitrary limit of, say, twenty or thirty Basics that should be taught to all Beginners, and then agree that anyone who had mastered those particular terms was now a Square Dancer. He could go to any regular hoedown or Open Dance and know that no other terms would be thrown at him unless they were introduced as new and explained at the time. But these new terms would not then automatically become part of the Square Dance language. Joe's plan for growth was to allow an occasional new term to be accepted but only if an old one was dropped at the same time. This would keep the total number of Basics the same, and would assure dancers that if they dropped out for a year they could come back and find themselves still able to dance. -- Naturally, Joe had an answer for people like ourselves, too -- he calls us 'Hobby Dancers', and encourages us to go ahead as far as we want and dance anything our Callers can think up, just so long as we make it clear that this is only a small and specialized part of the great Square Dance activity, and so long as we label our Club dances for what they are, so that less adventurous dancers can steer clear of us. Joe is speaking for the whole country, of course, and on a nation-wide basis it certainly is true that our kind of Square Dancer is greatly outnumbered by those who dance only once or twice a month, if that. All Joe wants is that they shall be recognized as Square Dancers, and their favorite type of dancing protected, rather than be made to feel that they are simply those who tried to be High Level dancers and didn't make it.

Joe's central idea, of a limited number of Basics, has really started something. Callers and teachers all over are talking about it, and several groups are planning to do something about it. But the biggest push of all is being given by Bob Osgood, who has undertaken to try, with the help of leaders all over the country, to set down in black and white, in 'Sets in Order' during the next few months, a list of all the Basics and Terms used in modern Square Dancing, numbered according to the order in which they are usually taught. These will be divided into the First Twenty, which all Square Dancers should know; the Next Ten, which

come later but which most dancers dancing once a week or more will learn (that means us); the Traditional Dances, which will be taught, if at all, for their historical interest and as a change of pace; and the Experimental Terms, which include most of the new things now being tried out, some of which may eventually be promoted to the Next Ten. If this idea is successful, Bob may try to get out a Revised List every few years, according to the way new terms are absorbed into our language and old ones dropped. There is also a list of those terms most authorities consider to be obsolete right now -- and there are a lot of them.

As one of the people consulted by Bob during the last two months, I have seen the reams of Lists and Corrected Lists and Amended Lists he has sent out, and the comments and arguments and proposed alternatives he has received. We were all relieved to find very little disagreement about the first Twenty -- apparently, when you really think about it you discover that the true basis of Square Dancing is pretty solid. (Naturally, when you start counting, you must first decide whether 'Box the Gnat' and 'Box the Flea' are one Basic or two, but everyone seemed to agree on calling them one Basic, in two variations. This brought up the very interesting question of families of terms, like all the Sashays.) The Next Ten was harder, but even there I think there will be very little complaint about the List as finally passed. I think the great majority of Callers will simply heave a sigh of relief at having the question settled for them, and will accept the Lists as they stand.

Now comes the real question, though -- even if we have the Lists, and approve of them, will we be able to use them to achieve what Joe proposes? Will the Caller be able to resist the temptation to carry over a few Experimental Terms from his Workshop Group to an Open Hoedown, just to make himself look like a Hotshot? The only control we have is the attitude of the dancers themselves, and I think that most of them are beginning to see that something needs to be done. Maybe, between us, we can make it work.

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the NCSDA was held at the Washington School, Alameda, Oct. 18, 1959, followed by the quarterly delegates meeting. Ed Ferrario, Program Chairman for the 1960 Golden State Round-Up, gave a progress report. The four callers will be Earl Johnston, from Vernon, Conn., Bob Johnston, from Phoenix, Arizona, Harold Mainor, from Granite City, Ill. and Harper Smith from Celina, Texas. Jack Barbour and his Rhythm Rustlers will supply the music, and live music will be used during the day and night programs. Frank & Carolyn Hamilton will be the Round Dance instructors, and Johnny White will be Round Dance Chairman. The Association passed out printed caller contract forms for use by the clubs when engaging guest callers. After a poll of the clubs by their delegates, it was decided to have the April, 1960 Stampede at the Richmond Auditorium again.

Refreshments were served.

Johnny Davis of Erlanger, Kentucky called the October 31st Stampede at the Oakland Auditorium, and met with tremendous approval, calling a particularly successful dance. Re-

member, the next Stampede is January 30th at the Oakland Auditorium, Jack Jackson calling. Lyle & Edna Tatman of the Millwheelers are the new directors from District 4, replacing Mike and Gladys Pardee, who resigned.

Sunday evening, November 8th, marked a square dancing milestone, when about 700 NCSDA square dancers appeared on the Roy Rogers Chevy Show seen by about 50 MILLION TV viewers across the country. This showed square dancing as it actually is, and not as a fancy exhibition done by a carefully trained group of one or two squares of fancy dancers. Roy Rogers actually did the calling, to a call written by John Strong and the Association Dancers can be tremendously proud of themselves. The difficulties were great, both in organizing and assembling the dancers, and in the execution of the dance under adverse sound conditions and on tank bark. A midnite rehearsal turned out to be as much fun as a hoedown, and the whole thing a memorable experience for all participants. The association received an unprecedented plug nationwide, when our name was placed on the list of credits for the show orally and on the screen in LARGE print. That peculiar group of Mexicans in the production number with Dale Evans and Roy Rogers who looked like a bunch of 4-F rejects from Pancho Villa's army was the Association Board of Directors. The rumor that Mexico has broken off diplomatic relations with the United States is completely unfounded, and has been traced to a disgruntled group of sub-standard callers headed by Ed Ferrario.
