 FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout

MEASURES:

INTRO

- 1 - 8 WAIT; WAIT; WAIT; WAIT; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TURN AWAY, 2, 3, 4;
 Wait four meas., the in open dance pos take two two-steps LOD; then
 in four walking steps, describing a small circle, turn away from part-
 ner and return to assume var pos, girl on M's R side, facing LOD.

PART A

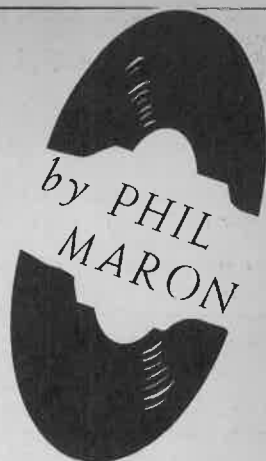
- 1 - 4 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TURN, 2, 3, 4;
 In vars pos take 2 fwd two-step, then, without releasing hands, both
 do individual right face turn in 2 cts to face RLOD. Then in 2 cts do a
 wheelaround, M backing up, W moving fwd, turning as a unit, to end
 facing LOD in Vars Pos with W on M's left side.
- 5 - 8 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TURN, 2, 3, 4;
 Repeat meas 1-4 except making individual LEFT-FACE turn to end in
 Vars Pos with W. on M's R side.
- 9 - 12 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, FRONT;
 Take 2 two-steps in LOD, then, as M turns his back to COH to
 grapevine in LOD, stepping side, behind; side, front; partners release
 left hands & W turn out in 4 cts making a 3/4 R-face turn to face
 partner and assume CP.
- 13 - 16 TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWIRL, 2, 3, 4;
 In OP do 2 turning two-steps, then, as M walks fwd in 4 steps, W
 makes 2 RF twirls under M's left arm. Couples assume BUTTERFLY
 POS, M's back to COH.

- 17 - 20 TWO-STEP FWD; TWO-STEP BACK; CROSS OVER, 2, 3, 4;
 Couples two-step fwd into sidecar pos, then two-step back into but-
 terfly. Releasing M's left hand & W's right, couples cross over in 4
 cts, W making L-face turn under M's R hand to end facing with M
 facing COH, W's back to COH. Join both hands to assume butterfly
 pos.
- 21 - 24 TWO-STEP FWD; TWO-STEP BACK; CROSS OVER, 2, 3, 4;
 Repeat meas 17-20, this time ending in semi-closed pos facing LOD.
- 25 - 28 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; SIDE, BACK; SIDE, FRONT;
 Do 2 fwd two-steps in LOD, M drops R hand from girl's waist leav-
 ing his L & her R hands joined for grapevine. Step side on L in LOD,
 pivoting almost to face RLOD, step behind L on R; step side on L,
 turning to face partner, cross R in front of L to take step in LOD, tak-
 ing partner in CP, M's back to COH (as in first 4 meas "Hot Lips").
- 29 - 32 TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN; TWIRL, 2, 3, 4;
 In CP do 2 turning two-steps. Then, as M walks fwd 4 steps, W makes
 two R-Face twirls under M's L arm.

Pick-Me-Up For Old Square Dancers

Feeling your age? Wondering how long you will be able to keep on Square Dancing, or will want to? Or worse, how long Square Dancing itself will keep going? Here's a simple little thing you can do to revive your faith in your favorite sport, and regain some of your old enthusiasm. Just go to a Beginners' Hoedown.

Now there are several reasons for seasoned dancers to attend a Beginners' Hoedown, or Fun Level Dance, and some are good and some are bad. Naturally, you won't be expecting the same kind of calling you are used to - you realize that new dancers need more time to think and react, and need help rather than 'challenge'. Nor will you expect them to be finished dancers - if they were, they would not be there. So what should you be looking for, to make your evening worth while, if it is neither good calling nor good dancing?

Don't go there looking for promising couples to lasso for your own Club. For one thing, dancing with Beginners for one dance is no way to tell whether or not they will make either good Square Dancers or good Club members (not the same thing). For another thing, just looking people over, no matter how subtle you try to be, does seem to result in a sort of critical attitude that can't help showing and that makes the Beginners self-conscious. That makes everyone unhappy and does you no good. So don't go there to promote your own Club.

Another thing not to try to do is to impress the new dancers with your superior skill. Don't spend your time doing extra twirls and cutting corners and showing off the way you do in your own Club and expect them to admire you. Either they'll simply think you are nuts or don't know the right way to do things, or else they will pick up one or two of your worst tricks and try to copy them, to the inconvenience of everyone else. Don't let them see you doing all the little things they have not learned yet because their teacher is trying to teach them basic dancing first.

Then what is the right attitude to have if you decide to go? Think of it this way -- these people are just starting out, as you did two or three or five or ten years ago. They are having a Ball learning to Square Dance, and you know they must be enjoying their classes or they would not have come out on a Saturday night to get more of the same. Their Caller has invited them to this dance for the purpose of letting them see what they are working toward. He has told them that after they have finished their lessons they can go to dances like this every Saturday night, and dance to all sorts of different Callers, and always have a good party to go to. So here they are, maybe for the first time, and what happens to them at their first few Hoedowns may well decide whether or not they stay in the activity after they finish their first class. Your purpose in going there and dancing with them should be to sell them on the idea of staying with Square Dancing.

Once you get the idea that you are at that particular dance as Hosts, in the sense that this is your native land and these people are newcomers there, the rest is easy. You want them to have such a good time that they will want to stay. You do all the Mixers, so that you can start as many squares as possible with different partners. You dance smoothly, using only the styling that you consider minimum and essential, and you don't even insist on a twirl when you get home if your partner of the moment has not yet mastered that added twist. You do your own part of each movement, and if you can give a lead to your partner without being obvious about it, you do. Sometimes you have the thrill of seeing your whole square come thru successfully where they would have broken down if you had not been there, and you can get your own private satisfaction out of that. You don't want them to know they have been helped, though - the result you want is for the others to say 'That was fun! This isn't too hard.' If the square breaks up anyway, in spite of your efforts, laugh and indicate that this sort of thing happens all the time and no one minds - "That was a tricky one, wasn't it! Where were we!" - and help them get sorted out for the next figure. Naturally, you make a point of showing that you are enjoying yourself, as you always enjoy yourself at any Square Dance, and when the Beginners tell you how marvellous their Caller is, you always agree no matter what your real opinion is. (After all, we all know that the Caller we started with was the best in the world, at least until we had heard a few others.) Above all, remember to make yourself a real part of the dance, not a condescending visitor from above, and that means to dance, not

sit on the sidelines and talk.

Aside from being a host and ambassador, both of which can help to keep you interested, there is one other thing you can do if the calling and dancing seem awfully slow to you. You can practice your timing. The idea of Square Dancing is to execute the movements smoothly while taking one step on each beat of music, and a Beginner dance is especially planned to make this easy to do (unlike some of our newer figures, which seem to require three steps on some beats and no steps at all on others.) If you take the full count for a 'Forward and Back', and consciously slow down to stay with the music, you will find that you will lose that sense of impatience with the Caller that you started out with. If you really are a good dancer you don't have to dance the same way, or at the same speed, all the time. You are, or should be, adaptable.

Now do you see how much you can contribute to a Beginners' Hoedown by going there in the right spirit? But don't forget that you can also get something out of it for yourself -- you can get a renewed faith in the Future of Square Dancing. If all these people are just now starting in, and are having such a wonderful time with it, and have so much to learn and so far to go, what makes you think Square Dancing will ever go into a decline? Individual Square Dancers may stop dancing, Clubs may fold, Callers may retire, but our activity as a whole just keeps rolling along, thanks to all our wonderful Beginners.
