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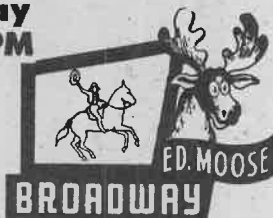
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SQUARE DANCE ~ WHERE?

FOOLISH FANCY

RECORD: "De Serait Dommage" - Jamie 1127 (Jackie Naguez) (slightly faster)

POSITION: Intro - Partners facing, M's r R & W's L hands joined

Dance - Closed, M's back twd COH

FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout

MEASURES

INTRODUCTION

- 1 WAIT
2 QUICKLY BAL APART, TCH, TOGETHER TO CLOSED, TOUCH;
3 - 4 (BOX) SIDE, CLOSE, FWD, -; SIDE, CLOSE, BWD, -; SIDE, CLOSE, FWD, -;
 SIDE, CLOSE, BWD, -;
 In closed pos M facing wall do box fwd stepping L swd in LOD, close R to L, step fwd on L and hold; Side on R, close L, back on R; REPEAT each box.
7 - 8 GRAPEVINE TWIRL, 2, 3, TOUCH; REVERSE TWIRL, 2, 3, TOUCH;
 As M grapevines with small steps LOD (side, behind, side, tch)
 W twirls R-face under lead hands; M grapevines RLOD as W does rev (L) twirl, ending in SEMI-CLOSED POS facing LOD.

THE DANCE

- 1 - 4 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; ROCK FWD, -, BACK, -; BACK, -, FWD, -;
 In semi-closed pos 2 slow fwd two-steps LOD; M steps fwd L in slight dip, holds, steps bwd on R in place and holds; Then bwd on L, hold, fwd in place on R, hold.
5 - 8 SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;
 Coming out of "rock" partners release M's R hold and with his L and her R joined, they face as M steps swd L in LOD, close R and crosses L in front twd RLOD between M and partner (W does opp ftwk but crosses in front also); M steps R RLOD, closes L and crosses R in front again LOD; In CLOSED POS 2 turning two-steps for full turn to SEMI-CLOSED POS facing LOD.
9 - 16 REPEAT ACTION OF MEAS 1-8, ending in BUTTERFLY POS M's back twd COH.
17 - 20 (VINE) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, BRUSH; BANJO ROUND, 2, 3, TOUCH;
 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, BRUSH; BANJO ROUND, 2, 3, TOUCH;
 M steps L swd LOD, behind on R, side L and brushes R fwd smartly (on this vine, partners retain handholds but pull apart to arms' length -- then together on last ct for banjo round); In BUTTERFLY BANJO POS partners circle 1/2 turn with same 1, 2, 3, brush timing ending M's bk to wall; Repeat figure RLOD ending M's bk COH.
21 - 24 REPEAT MEAS 17-20 (Vine & Banjo Round) for a total of twice around) end SEMI-CL POS.
25 - 28 SLOW WALK, -, FACE, -; PIVOT, -, 2, -; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;
 In semi-closed pos slow fwd glide in 2 steps facing partner in CLOSED POS on last part of 2nd step; Full pivot in 2 steps; One full turn in 2 turning two-steps to end in SEMI-CLOSED POS facing LOD.
29 - 32 REPEAT MEAS 25-28 -- ending in CLOSED POS M's back COH.
SEQUENCE: COMPLETE ROUTINE DONE TWICE plus Meas 1-7 and on Meas 8 instead of another two-step on the turn, W twirls R Face twd wall to face M who walks LOD R, L, R, and faces partner to bow on last ct.

Round Dance Workshop ...Why?

When you attend a Round Dance Workshop at a big Convention or Round-Up, what do you expect to get out of it? If you are like most of the dancers around the country, you are not very clear about it yourself. According to various National Round Dance leaders we have talked to, the greatest problem they have to face is the fact that they are asked to come in and teach something about Round Dancing and then when they arrive they find out that what people really want is new Round Dances. That is not the same thing.

Of course, what you want depends on what your interest in Round Dancing is. You may teach special Round Dance classes, or you may be a caller and just teach the Round of the Month in your Square Dance Club. You may belong to a Round Dance Club and learn all the special added Rounds that are presented, or you may be just an average Square Dancer who does the Round of the Month and no more. Or you may even be a non-Round Dancer who has resisted so far but has a vague idea that he would like to start to learn some day. Here you all are, in a big circle on the floor, and the Program says 'Round Dance Workshop'. No wonder the poor visiting teacher is baffled. Even if each one of you knew what you wanted, he could not give it to all of you at once. Even dividing the group into two sections doesn't help too much -- who is an 'Experienced' dancer? How new is 'New'? And are any of you being honest when you say you want to 'improve' your dancing? Don't you really hope to learn at least one brand new Hit Round, to teach or show off with? Ask yourself that.

Square Dance Workshops used to have the same trouble, in the old days, before all the new stuff was published everywhere. You went hoping to learn a new figure or square you could take home and call, to astonish your dancers. Now you know that anything the visiting expert knows you can know too, if you read the same Notes and magazines, and what you hope to get is his special way of presenting things, what we call 'styling' -- the thing that makes him worth inviting to your Festival. It's not what he calls but how he calls it that makes him worth listening to.

The same thing ought to be true of Round Dance instructors, especially here in the Bay Area, where we have one of the best systems anywhere in the country for agreeing on what Rounds to teach so that we can all dance together. If you go to a Festival or Institute and learn a new Round, you come home to find that either (a) it has been chosen Round of the Month and you could have learned it in your own Club anyhow, or (b) it is not chosen and therefore is not on the program at Hoedowns and you don't get a chance to dance it. So what good did it do you to go to that Workshop?

Here's the point. Learning a new dance is not important. Learning something about Round Dancing is what counts. Suppose you are that average dancer we were talking about, and you have always managed to learn the new dances fairly well, but have never been quite sure about the difference between a Right Face Turning Waltz and a Left Face one. Maybe your caller isn't too sure himself -- most callers have no special training in teaching Rounds. But here, at the Workshop, is someone who does have special training, and who has been teaching so long, and so successfully, that he is famous for it. You are not the only one who is hazy on that very point, and he knows it. So, when he teaches a dance with those turns in it, he will not simply tell you what to do -- he will explain the two turns so clearly and simply that you just can't get confused ever again. You may never have an opportunity to dance the particular dance you were learning at the time -- it may be something we didn't happen to choose here -- but if you have been paying attention and looking for the right results from your afternoon spent at the Workshop, you will never forget that one thing that you learned, and it will help you whenever you learn another dance that features waltz turns. That's what the average dancer should get out of a Workshop.

Of course, if you are an expert Round Dancer and go regularly to a class or Club taught by a top Round Dance teacher, you probably feel that you don't need this sort of thing. You may be flattering yourself, or you may even be right, but the same thing is true here -- you don't need to learn new dances either. Your teacher will give you all the dances you can handle, and it will be his responsibility to look over the crop and pick out the best. What

you should look for is styling -- what is there about this instructor, or this couple, that makes them tops in their field? Maybe they are actually no better teachers than your own leaders, but at least they are different. They emphasize different points, their way of presenting things is their own, and you can make a hobby of collecting Round Dance leaders -- learning all you can about them, so that you can discuss them with other Round Dancers. You will all have your favorites and those you don't approve of, and the more you know personally the better your standing is. Maybe, even though you know you don't need it, you might actually learn something from them.

At the opposite end of the scale is the non-Round Dancer. If you have honestly never tried it, a Workshop is probably not the place for you to start. You could go and watch awhile, and see how the teacher presents each part of the dance, and notice what a lot of people seem to take an interest in the subject. But the only real way to start, especially if you are a little hesitant about it, is to join a Round Dance class and learn from the bottom up, just as you learned Square Dancing. Then by next year you'll be able to attend a Workshop and really enjoy it.

Perhaps the person who gets the most, or should, out of a Round Dance Workshop, is the caller who has to teach the Rounds in his own Club and does not know much about it. Every good teacher teaches a little differently, and the methods that work for one do not work for another. His aim should be to watch carefully how each thing is presented, and exactly what the instructor says, and what he does, and how he breaks down a dance, thinking all the time how he can adapt these methods to his own problem. He can hardly fail to hear something he never knew before, some answer to a question that has been bothering him, and to add to his store of little teaching aids and tricks. He can forget about the particular dances he learns -- here again, if they are chosen to be danced here he will have another chance to learn them before he has to teach them. What he should watch is how to teach them.

I can't speak for the local Round Dance teachers themselves. I think, however, that their position is rather like that of the President entertaining visiting Royalty. They are Hosts and Sponsors, and their interest is in seeing that the net result of the visit is in the best interests of local Round Dancing. They expect to enjoy the company of a congenial couple, to show off with pride the interest they have helped to create in Round Dancing in their area, and to do anything they can to make the event a success. The only thing they might do further is to prepare their dancers to go to the Workshop with the right attitude, so that the visiting leaders can teach what ought to be taught, and the dancers won't feel cheated if they haven't learned half a dozen New Dances.
