AIN'T WE GOT 'FUN'

Asks Madeline Allen

Ever so often someone gets up on a soapbox and tells us all that we ought to Square Dance for FUN. If they mean it the way Katherine Murray does when she says 'To put a little FUN in your life, try dancing!', I am all for it - I can't imagine any other reason for Square Dancing. But they don't. Usually what they are saying is, "Look at us! We have FUN dancing, because we (a) whoop and holler any time we like, (b) kick on the corners, (c) don't worry about styling, (c) dress any old way we want to, (d) don't bother to learn the Rounds, (f) don't have any Club meetings, (x) or any other sort of discipline. (In other words, we are both rough and sloppy.)" Or else they say, "Back in the days when we were Beginners it was FUN to Square Dance, because we did not know very much and did the same things over and over, so let's all go back to that kind of dancing." The assumption always is, "Our way is FUN - you don't have any FUN dancing the way you do." So why do I go on dancing? They can't answer that, of course, -- But my point is that the word FUN, to most of us, has come to have two very different meanings, both artificial. In advertising a dance, it means 'simple and elementary' as in a Fun Level Hoedown. But when it is used by experienced dancers about their own Club, it has come to mean the very kind of rough dancing that most of us try to avoid.

At the National Convention in Denver there was a large group from the Middle West -- maybe not as large as they sounded, but quite in evidence - whose styling kept the rest of us dodging. They kicked on the Allemande, did a double kick with their partners, a twirl between each hand in a Grand Right and Left, and several twirls and a Backlash at Home. I remember getting into a square with three of these couples one time (Dan and I like to Mix at these events) and really having to concentrate on not getting clobbered. Once, when Dan backed away from his Corner, she asked him, 'What's the matter? Don't you like to have FUN?' See what I mean?

Callers who call all over the country tell us that there are some areas where this kind of dancing is what the majority of dancers like, and there is nothing that can be done about it. Even in Southern California you will find much more Backlashing and Twirling than we are used to. Northern California, however, has a growing reputation for smooth and skillful dancing, and I know that the vast majority of our dancers prefer that kind. Even here, however, there are a few Clubs where rough dancing is not only tolerated but is encouraged, and seems to be a source of pride to the members. One result of boasting about your type of dancing is that the rest of us are warned and can keep away from your Club dances, and that is just what we do. If you like it, you can have it -- BUT only in your own Club. Here we go again -- we are having more and more complaints about roughness at our open dances, where small groups of dancers are actually becoming a menace to the rest of the floor.

If I felt that Square Dancing like that -- jerky and out-of-time and physically dangerous to others -- was what the majority of dancers around here wanted, the answer would be simple -- I would just find another hobby. My only excuse for having another try at calming down those who are making open dances unpleasant for others, is my conviction that they are really quite a small group -- they only look like more. Even a few of them, however, have a very upsetting effect on a crowded floor, and there is the added risk that new dancers, seeing such acrobatics for the first time, often jump to the conclusion that these must be very High Level dancers indeed and try to copy them. If high kicks by experienced dancers are bad, think how much worse they are when tried for the first time! Ouch!

I have a theory (which will not be popular with certain Clubs and Callers) that a Caller who is giving his dancers all the interest and excitement they want is not going to be bothered with rough and noisy dancing. I think yelling and stamping, extra twirls, high kicks, and general cutting-up, are the dancers' answer to a Caller who is either boring or incompetent. Maybe he confuses noise with enjoyment himself, and feels more secure when he hears a lot of whoopee from the floor. Maybe he is lazy, and it is easier to let the dancers generate their own enthusiasm than to try to keep them interested with new material and better styl-

ing. At any rate, I have an idea that a Caller whose Club boasts about the FUN they have with their way of dancing, doesn't want to risk losing any of his popularity with his dancers by warning them not to dance that way in public. Actually, over-exuberance becomes a sort of trademark with them, and we have the sorry sight we had at a recent much-overcrowded Hoedown, where one square of dancers from another Club were taking up far more than their share of the limited space just because no one dared dance any nearer to them. Someone ought to tell them, if their Caller won't.

We are coming into the season of Big Dances again-- the California State Convention, the Golden State Round-Up, the Festivals at Reno and Las Vegas - and we will be visiting or playing Host to dancers from all over. Last year the Dancers' Association Board issued a plea to Callers to give their dancers special instructions on how to act on a crowded floor, and the result, as seen on Saturday night at the Round-Up, was really terrific. Visitors said they had never seen a floor as full, moving as smoothly. How about doing the same thing this year, Callers, and aiming at strengthening the reputation the Bay Area already has, of being famous for the best in smooth dancing? Let's carry the thought with us whenever we dance away from home, and make other areas glad to see dancers from Northern California.

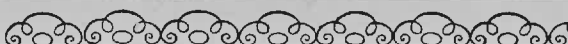
- 1. Caller:** An active callers, calling to one or more classes or groups regularly for more than one year. Voting member. Membership fee \$3.00 per year.
