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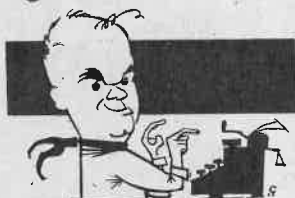

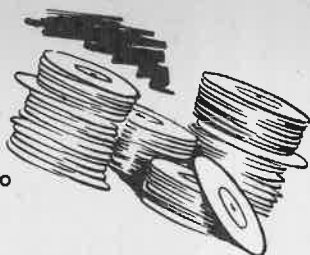

HOORAY FOR BADGES !!

MADLINE ALLEN

"I never forget a face, but I just can't remember names!" That remark must be one of the oldest cliches, and always in that form - you never heard a person say he remembered names but not faces. This is probably because we do look at people when we meet, but we don't always listen to the name when it is spoken - and in these informal days it is not even always spoken. We all have plenty of friends we have never really 'met', properly speaking.

Square Dancing is one of the few social activities that has succeeded in solving that problem - simply by using badges. To me, the almost universal wearing of badges is one of the most satisfactory things about Square Dancing today, and I wish there were some way of extending the custom to include every other activity from Cocktail parties to the daily marketing. I think that knowing, without a doubt, what another person's name is, just about doubles the pleasure of any social occasion.

Badges have improved immensely in the years that we have been dancing. The first ones I remember were home-made ones, mostly an outgrowth of the slips of paper you pinned on guests at parties or Beginners in classes. The assumption was that you knew the names of all the regulars and only needed help with new people. (How about the poor new people, though?) Then Clubs began to be formed, and the idea of a Club badge appeared. I may be wrong, but I think that most of the first Club badges did not even have the name of the person on them - the important thing was to identify yourself as a Member, not as an individual. I remember one of the first Clubs here in the County, the "Marin Hoedowners", and our first badge, which was a large H made of Redwood, from a novelty shop, with "Marin" stamped on it. Of course, you had to know the name of the Club to know what the symbol meant, but we went on the artless assumption that everyone knew the "Marin Hoedowners". In those days it was probably true, too - I think there was only one other Square Dance Club in the County. We were pretty proud of ourselves until we saw the Forty-Niners' new badge, with a real Gold Pan on it - how fancy can you get?

The next stage was the slot badge, the first commercial ones to be offered. Most of the Clubs changed to those, and the little picture on top was supposed to represent the Club name in some way. The member's name was now on the badge, but the printing was usually left to the member, and too many people either typed the name or printed it too small. From a distance - like across the Square - most of these badges looked very much alike, and the names were completely illegible. There are a lot of these badges still in use, although there is now a lot more difference in color and design. I can't say too much, as our own Club still uses them, but I wish everybody would take one more step forward and get a badge you could actually read.

Wonderful badges are available now. You can have a badge that is a different shape or color from any other badge in the world, cut in plastic to your own design, with the Club name in letters large enough to read, and with your own name big enough to be read two Squares away. (That's what I like.) In the May issue of "Sets in Order" there is a double spread of some of the more interesting Club badges, and if you look around at the Golden State Round-up you'll see a lot more. I am all in favor of wearing your own Club badge along with the temporary badge given out by whatever Festival or Convention you are attending, so that you are identified by Club as well as by City and State. Many of our Bay area friends we really got acquainted with for the first time at some place like San Diego, by spotting each others' local Club badges among a lot of strange ones. For the same reason, in Tucson, which is a Winter resort area, many dancers wear the badge of their local Club and also the badge of the Club they dance with when they are at home.

The main difference between the early slot badges and the modern cut plastic ones is that the new ones are made one at a time and therefore do not have to be ordered in large numbers. An obvious result of this change was the possibility of Gag badges, made to order and each One different. Of course a few of them, like "Goofers Permit" and "Low Level Dancer", have been run into the ground by now, but every once in a while I see a new one that seems especially pointed - maybe almost too much so, as in the case of one worn by a well-known

character who enlivens every Convention across the Country - "Live Dangerously! Dance With Me!" I think Gag badges are fun, and I don't mind how many you wear, just so that some-where, in plain sight, you have one simple one that tells me your NAME, preferably in letters half an inch high.

One last request - please use your last name too! I know that some Clubs consider it more friendly just to label their members "Bill" and "Mabel", but that does not really tell me what I want to know - like whether Bill and Mabel belong together. (Maybe that's the idea - don't tell 'em, make 'em guess.) Maybe other people don't do the way I do - but to me, one of the great pleasures in life is collecting friends, and I can't really consider a person a permanent friend until I know his whole name. When I see an item in the Magazine about Bill Jones being elected President of his Club, and remember that I danced with Bill Jones the last time we visited that Club, I feel that I really know him, and that he is a part of my collection. If his badge had said just "Bill", how could I tell which "Bill"?

As to all you Big Shots who don't bother to wear badges because you think everybody knows you - don't kid yourselves. You'd be amazed if you knew how many Square Dancers don't even know the name of the guy up there calling the very tip they are dancing! So wear your badge like all the rest of us, and maybe your name will ring a bell, even if your face doesn't.
