ROUND DANCE OF THE MONTH

SHORTCAKE



by: DOT 'N DATE FOSTER, Portland, Oregon

RECORD: "Shortcake" - Grenn #14012

POSITION: Open, facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Opposite

INTRO: 4 meas. WAIT 2 meas. APART, TOUCH, -; TOGETHER, TOUCH, -; Step away from partner on outside foot, touch; step together, touch; End in Open position facing LOD.

PART "A"

1-2 HEEL, IN PLACE, HEEL, IN PLACE; HEELS OUT, IN, OUT, IN;

Place L heel fwd, then back to place, R heel, fwd, then back to place; with heels together, toes slightly out, keeping weight on balls of ft, move heels out (pigeon toe), then heels back together, then out again, and back together. (Bend knees slightly when heeling out and straighten when bringing heels together. Variation of the "Cat Walk" in Salty Dog Rag).

3-4 WALK, -, 2, -; 3, -, 4, -;

Walk fwd in LOD four slow steps, using a "toe-heel" on each step for styling.

5-8 REPEAT MEAS. 1 - 4

End in BUTTERFLY position M facing wall.

9-10 SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, TOUCH; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, TOUCH;

Step to side on M's L in LOD, close R to L, step to side on L, touch R to L; Step to side on M's R in RLOD, close L to R, step to side on R, touch L to R;

11-12 TWIRL, -, 2, -; 3, -, 4, -;

As M walks fwd 4 slow steps L-R-L-R, W twirls 2 complete R-face twirls under her R & M's L arms, ending in BUTTERFLY position. M's back to COH.

13-14 SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, TOUCH; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, TOUCH;

Repeat action of measures 9-10

15-16 TWIRL, -, 2, -; 3, -, 4, -;

Repeat action of meas 11-12 Except W twirls just ONCE, ending facing LOD in OPEN pos, ready to repeat all of PART "A"

PART "B"

1-2 TWO STEP FWD; TWO STEP FWD;

In open position 2 two-steps fwd in LOD, end facing partner.

3-4 SIDE, -, TOUCH BACK, -; SIDE, -, TOUCH BACK, -;

Release inside hands, join M's L & W's R, both step to side in LOD (on M's L & W's R) & turning to face RLOD and swinging joined hands fwd, touch R ft well behind L; Face partner again, changing hands to M's R & W's L, as both step to side in RLOD (on M's R & W's L) and turning to face LOD, touch L behind R. These are slow steps, end in OPEN POSITION.

5-6 TWO STEP FWD; TWO STEP FWD;

Repeat action of meas 1-2 of PART "B"

7-8 SIDE, -, TOUCH BACK, -; SIDE, -, TOUCH, -;

Same as Meas. 3-4, except do not touch back, but finish facing partner, in CLOSED position touch L to R M's back to COH.

9-12 (BOX) SIDE, CLOSE, FWD, -; SIDE, close, back, -; side, -, DRAW, -; SIDE, -, DRAW, -;

M steps to side on L, close R to L, step fwd on L, hold; Step to side on R, close L to R, step back on R, hold; In closed dance pos. both step in LOD (M on L-W on R) draw R to L (No weight); Step to side in RLOD on R, draw L to R. (These are slow steps).

13-16 SIDE, CLOSE, FWD, -; SIDE, CLOSE, BACK, -; SIDE, -, DRAW, -; SIDE, DRAW, -;

Repeat action of meas 9-12 end in OPEN position ready to REPEAT PART "B"

SEQUENCE OF DANCE AA BB AA ENDING

ENDING: Do meas. 1 & 2 of PART "A" (Shortcake step) then walk fwd 2 slow steps, turn to face partner on 3rd step, and bow.

SCRAPPER

Well, here we are home again, and what do I find? My new Alternate Columnist (don't think you are going to get off with one measly effort, Bob!) has chickened out. He was going to start a big Feud, he said - at least, that was my understanding. He even said, in his first column, that he did not always agree with everything I have been saying. This is fine, I thought, and wondered which one of my five years of columns he was going to rip apart. But what does he do? He picks on a poor little defenseless Transistor Radio, something I have never even mentioned. Well, Bob, it won't work. If you won't argue with me, I'll argue with you, on your own subject. Even a Transistor Radio can't be all bad.

Actually, I agree with almost all Bob said. But what does he mean 'mostly males', speaking of radio-carriers? Did he ever see even one female using a radio at a dance? Even ladies who are enthusiastic Giant fans, or who really love to go to Football games, seem to be perfectly willing to wait until next morning to find out how the game came out. But some men just can't seem to get their minds off of the fact that their favorite team is out there right now, and it just boils down to this - ladies, would you rather have your loving partner leave you in spirit between each dance and commune with his team, or have him rebel completely and stay home to listen to the whole game in peace? If the situation is that bad, then I say compromise.

Of course, I am assuming that the only reason most wives want their husbands to be present at a dance is for the actual dancing. Women usually talk to other women between the tips anyhow, while the men are out smoking. On the other hand, if you are the kind who goes to Square Dances mostly to talk, or to make calling dates or other connections, I can see where it would really frustrate you to have no one listen. And I can see a problem, too, in the plight of the man who really does wear a Hearing Aid, and who must think by now that a new form of greeting has become popular -- instead of saying 'How's tricks?' or 'What's cooking?', everyone seems to be opening the conversation with 'What's the score?'.

Here's a subject we might kick around a little - 'Is the Travelling Caller on the Way Out?' I certainly hope not - some of my best friends are Travelling Callers. But sometimes I wonder. It used to be that all you had to do was to pass the word, in a whisper, that Herb Greggerson or Ralph Maxheimer or Jonesy was coming to town, and you had people fighting for tickets, even though it took nearly all the Square Dancers in the Bay area to fill one hall. Now, you bring in a nationally-known caller on a once-a-year schedule, and when you ask the average dancer if he wants a ticket you get everything from 'Who's he?' to the really insulting question, 'Is he any good?' What do they think we went to all that trouble for, anyhow? Someday I am going to shock someone by answering 'No, he's lousy, but we wanted to make a little money and he was willing to come cheap.' Those of us who have been lucky enough to be able to travel and hear callers from other areas have always thought we were doing the local dancers a favor by giving them a chance to hear them too. But maybe times have changed too much. Maybe the Travelling Caller of today is not enough better than our own callers any more. And if he is just 'different', that may actually be a disadvantage, as far as the average dancer is concerned. Some people's reaction to anything new reminds me of the standard reaction of most children to a new food - 'What is it? I don't like it.' The question is, should some of us go on trying to broaden the taste of the dancers, or should we relax and let them have what they think they want? Any ideas?

We might also get a little discussion started on Contrás. Here you get the same sort of answer - either 'What's a Contra?' or 'I tried one once and I don't like them.' Contrás have got off to a number of bad starts around here, mostly because they were introduced at a Square Dance as something new that we should all love, and then taught the hard way, with a completely new vocabulary. Actually, Contrás come somewhere in between Square and Round dancing - like Squares, they are called instead of memorized, but like Rounds, they are danced to the music. Some are fun and some are boring, just like everything else. I noticed that Bob Osgood, writing up the National Convention, made the comment that the hall where

the Contras were taught became progressively more crowded as dancing in the main hall became faster and rougher and more competitive. He thought this might indicate that a lot of people were dissatisfied with the type of dancing featured at the Convention, and were willing to try anything that promised to be smooth and comfortable. So far, we in this area have avoided the worst features of dancing in the Middle West, at least in most of our Clubs, but it might be that, even here, Contras are about due to be introduced again. Some of the newer ones can actually be called with no walk-thru, using straight Square Dance terms, instead of using a whole new language. Should we try out a few? Maybe someone will be a pioneer and give Contras another chance.

Any other ideas? I'll argue on any subject.
