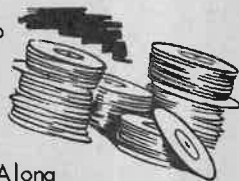

## SAM'S SONG

By Scotty and Doris Garrett, Hayward, California

RECORD: "Sam's Song" - MacGregor 8945-A  
 POSITION: Intro: OPEN-FACING; Dance: CLOSED POS., M facing LOD  
 FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout. Directions given for M  
 INTRO: WAIT 2 COUNTS; APART, POINT, TOGETHER, TOUCH: TWIRL, 2, 3, 4 (to CLOSED);

In OPEN-FACING POS M's bk to COH, M's R & W's L hands joined, quickly acknowledge; On ct 3 stepping bk into COH on L, point R toe twd ptr, on ct 4 step fwd on R, tch L beside R assuming momentary BUTTERFLY POS; Release M's R & W's L hands, M walks 4 steps LRLR, prog LOD as W does 2 RF twirls in 4 steps under joined M's L & W's R hands prog LOD to end in CLOSED POS M facing LOD.

### MEASURES

#### PART A

- 1 - 4 WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS (TO SIDECAR), -, WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS (to BANJO), -;

Start M's L & walk fwd 2 steps L, -, R, - in LOD; Step L swd twd COH, close R to L, step L XIF of R (W XIB) turning slightly to face diag twd wall & LOD ending in SIDECAR POS; Prog LOD diag twd wall walk fwd 2 steps R, -, L, -; Step R swd twd wall, close L to R, step R XIF of L (W XIB) to end in BANJO POS facing diag twd LOD & COH.

- 5 - 8 WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS (to SIDECAR), -, WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS (to BANJO), -;

In BANJO POS moving diag fwd LOD twd COH repeat action of Meas 1-2; In SIDECAR POS repeat action of Meas 3-4 to end in BANJO POS, adjusting so M faces LOD.

- 9 - 12 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP (to SIDECAR); FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP (to SEMI-CLOSED);

Start M's L & dance 2 "swooping" two-steps prog LOD turning 1/2 RF on last step of Meas 10 to end in SIDECAR POS facing RLOD; Prog RLOD dance 2 "swooping" two-steps, M turns 1/2 LF on last step of Meas 12 to assume SEMI-CLOSED POS both facing LOD.

- 13 - 16 LIMP, 2, 3, 4; STEP, BRUSH, BRUSH, BRUSH (Soft Shoe); LIMP, 2, 3, 4; STEP, BRUSH, BRUSH, BRUSH;

Release ptr step L swd twd COH, step R XIB of L & flex L knee to effect "limp" action, step L swd twd COH, step R XIB of L (limp); Step L swd twd COH, brush R fwd in LOD, brush R back across in front of L, brush R fwd across in front of L (soft shoe); Repeat action of Meas 13 & 14 starting R moving twd ptr & assuming OPEN POS facing LOD with M's R & W's L hands joined.

#### PART B

- 17 - 20 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -, ABOUT-FACE, ABOUT-FACE;

Dance 2 two-steps prog LOD; Step L swd twd COH, close R to L, step L XIF of R (W XIF) & remain facing LOD Keep wt on both feet, rise on balls of feet & pivot-turn 1/2 in twd ptr (RF for M & LF for W) to face RLOD bringing joined hands thru & releasing them to join M's L & W's R hands; With wt still on both feet, repeat "about-face", turning in twd ptr (M LF, W RF) to face LOD bringing joined hands thru & releasing them to join M's R & W's L hands in OPEN POS.

- 21-24 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -, ABOUT-FACE, ABOUT-FACE;

Starting M's L & W's R repeat action of Meas 17-20 ending in OPEN POS facing LOD.

- 25 - 28 QUICK, STEP, STEP, BRUSH; QUICK, STEP, STEP (to CLOSED), -, BOX TWO STEP; TWO-STEP;

Dance 3 "quick" steps LRL, prog LOD, brush R fwd in LOD; Dance 3 more "quick" steps RLR, prog LOD turning 1/4 RF on last step (W 1/4 LF) to assume CLOSED POS M's bk to COH; On meas 27 & 28, dance a "Box Two-Step" - step L swd along LOD, close R to L, step L fwd twd wall, hold R beside L; Step R swd along RLOD, close L to R, step R back into COH, hold L beside R.

- 29-32 TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP; TWIRL, -, 2, -; 3, -, 4, -;

Prog LOD starting M's L dance 2 turning two-steps completing 1 turn; M walks 4 steps LRLR in LOD as W does 2 RF twirls under joined M's L & W's R hands to end in CLOSED POS M facing LOD.

DANCE ROUTINE A TOTAL OF THREE TIMES

ENDING: On Meas 32, W does a quick twirl to end M's bk to COH for Bow & Curtsy.

# MY STYLING IS SHOWING AGAIN !!

and to continue. Last month I wrote on the subject of the wide variations instyling that cause confusion among even the most experienced dancers, and promised to go into detail about some of the differences this month. So first, go and re-read last month's article. (Re-read? The readers of this article are all new. No one who has ever read one article ever reads another. Ed.Note.) Please forgive the lack of technical terminology, but I neither write calls nor call calls. (You don't dance most calls, either. Ed.Note.)

The current most noticeable difference in styling we discussed last month; the meeting of the gal in the promenade, where some twirl, some half-turn, and some independently flip around to get into position.

Another time when the variations are even more numerous is at the end of a promenade when it comes time to swing. Since my last article, I have been taking notes on what takes place at that point, and here are some of the variations: the man twirls the girl out, draws her back, and they swing; the same maneuver, but no swing; both balance out at home, maintaining the same hand position they had in the promenade, so they balance out with crossed hands, then come together again, with or without the swing; the backlash, where the girl is twirled out, and then reverse-twirled back, usually with a swing (this is much more prevalent with dancers from Southern California.); both go home and stand there and watch everybody else do something. This last maneuver is often a sign of trouble - either the caller isn't allowing enough time for the swing, or the couple is fighting bitterly about who loused up the last call. (I always lose this one.) And incidentally - did you ever notice that a single swing is the rule nowadays, instead of the two we used to do? Why is this - laziness, lack of time, or are we all getting old and tired?

The newest of the variations is the pat-tycake when two lines come together, which started about two years ago. I first saw this in March, 1960, when Jane and I pawned the family heirlooms, sold the children into

slavery, and took a trip to Hawaii. When I wasn't chasing the Hula girls, we danced, and everytime two lines came together and I was on one end, my opposite girl tried to pat my hands. I had never seen it before, and though it was not only mighty silly, but pretty presumptuous of them to use a styling different from my area, which, of course, is the style-setter. I resisted for a while, but finally went along with the ignorant natives. Imagine my horror when, upon our return, I noticed some people doing it here. This is the result of allowing the poorer classes to travel. Anyway, it gained popularity, and now about half the dancers do it - but half isn't enough. The same indecision comes in here, as to whether I shall or shall not pat her little pinkies, with the same embarrassing results. I try to pat and she doesn't, so I'm left with a silly grin on my face while I paw the air ineffectually. I usually pretend to be waving to a friend in the next square. (An acquaintance, maybe; a friend, no. Ed. Note.) Or, I try and she doesn't so I quickly drop my hand, while she, belatedly awakening, then tries to pat where my hand was - so we both feel silly. Let's all do, or all don't.

How about the Alamo Style? For years we merely joined hands and rocked in and out, without any problem. Now, some of the dancers join hands in an up-raised position, as though in a two-hand star position, and then rock in and out. This probably originated in an exhibition group, as it is much more effective from a spectator standpoint. But if some do and some don't, the circle is really lopsided and the dancer is also confused as he has to make a choice with each hand on each turn. In my opinion, the upraised hand position, while purtier, is not as comfortable, and does not allow the freedom of rocking in and out the older method does.

Then a problem peculiar to the gals - two ladies chain: Do you touch hands, or hold your skirt and pass by. Again, the confusion was originated by exhibition groups for spectator interest. Now, one girl tries

to touch hands, and the other holds her skirt - then each tries to switch to the other's method, with the result that the two gals appear to be doing an impromptu and abandoned cancan.

There are many more, which do not reflect so much the differences in two or more accepted stylings, but rather the lack of any styling at all. For example, the simple basic of the courtesy turn at the end of a ladies chain. About half of the dancers don't use the courtesy turn, but simply a left arm swing to turn the girl, and I believe this is merely because they have never been taught what they are supposed to do. Or the wagon wheel; we used to catch the gal at the end of her turn with an arm hook and then move around in the star. Now some use this method, others put their arm around the gal as in a star promenade, and still others use a method whereby the man extends his right arm in front of the gal, palm up, and she places her hand on his and loops her left arm in the crook of his right. Originally, the gal had her right hand free to hold her skirt, which is esthetically more pleasing. Then, of course we have those movements which are incorrectly done, style or no style, like the box the gnat, where some dancers have never been taught thoroughly, and fail to face their partner at the end, which is responsible for fouling up a lot of squares.

These are just some differences and weaknesses obvious to any dancer, and there are many more. I would like to see the callers put on a real concentrated campaign all over the area for the next few months, workshopping styling and technical points on old standard basics. In the last couple of years, all the emphasis was on the new stuff and its variations, so that we have slipped in our standard of dancing. Maybe a new badge, signifying that the wearer has passed a rigorous test on his knowledge of all standard square dance movements is the answer. We could call it the Barthol Badge, signifying perfection in dancing. Those that fail will have to wear the Ferrario Badge.

### No. Calif. Square Dancers Ass'n George Norton

The Presidents and Officers of 13 of the 15 Square Dance Associations in the State of California were hosted by the N.C.S.D.A. at the Edgewater Inn on Sat. Feb. 3.

So if you haven't made your reservations, be sure and rush them in right away so you won't miss out on this outstanding event.

Planning for the Golden State Round-up is rapidly increasing in tempo and we need your participation forms to assign your club to the committee of its choice. Delegates please check that your club has returned its form so your club will be included in the fun of helping out on a Golden State Round-up.

For the benefit of those who have missed out on our previous announcements, the following program of Top Callers, Top Music, Top Sound and Top facilities will guarantee you Top Dancing at this year's Golden State Round-up on May 26 and 27th.
