Anyone for a Passport Photo ?

I wonder what ever happened to Square Dancing! I remember, some years ago, I used to dance regularly, and enjoyed it hugely. I was particularly pleased with it, because I got the feeling that I was almost graceful, something no one had ever accused me of being before. I still go with the same people, to the same places, and even the same callers are up there, but I guess I'll never really enjoy working out with the drill team as much as I liked dancing. Remember what it was like? We actually danced as the caller told us what the next pattern was to be, and when he was particularly good, we floated around the square, effortless and graceful, in easy patterns that seemed to flow, one into the other, a perfect release from tensions and troubles, as dancing was designed and meant to be.

I rarely get that feeling any more. The patterns no longer flow - they start and stop, change direction abruptly, sometimes wrenchingly, and often require excellently adjusted brakes and fast acceleration to execute to the beat of the music. The circular and curving patterns are in the minority, replaced by the angular, square-cornered maneuvers I well remember from my drill team days of twenty-odd years ago.

Give a good hard look at some of the junk that is being perpetrated on us now as "dancing". One example is the fold pattern: Fold the girl, boy, end, center - better we should fold our tents and steal quietly away into the night. These and other "modern" basics destroy the flow of the dance, are virtually impossible to do gracefully and on the beat of the music, and require extremely close attention and concentration in order to decide who folds and who doesn't. This is dancing?

Even the singing calls, which were the smoothest and swiftest of all, are now infected with the same disease. Some of the old-time favorites, that used to last for a long time until the headlong race for something new came in, have been revived - at least the tunes are revived - but the dances bear little resemblance to the ones we remember with nostalgia. They've put new patterns to them - and this time around most of them last about as long as a soap bubble. They don't last because they lack the ingredients that made them so popular

in the first place. When they were revived, the patterns were changed, simply for the sake of being different. What is so magical about being different - when the changes are not as good as the original article? We can't stand still, but too many people - dancers and callers alike - confuse the terms "change" and "progress" means to advance, to proceed from one stage to a higher stage, whereas "change" merely means to make different. We've had a lot of changes that are certainly not progress, but an actual lowering of the standards instead.

I believe that this unheeding, unthinking rush to be different goes deeper than the fact that I personally don't like it. Is there any dancer who can seriously argue that we have the same overall rhythm, timing, flow, smoothness, cleverness of patterns, and ease of dancing now that we used to have? I think that we're sowing the seeds of our own destruction by taking this path. There are many very disquieting signs around for those who care to look. But without even looking, we can check back into the history of dancing and learn a lesson. Think of the numerous dancing fads that have come along and taken the country by storm. Where are they now? They're all gone and forgotten. They were a lot of fun, different, energetic for the most part, but lacked the essential ingredients of grace and ease - and shortly lost their novelty and disappeared. I don't want square dancing to disappear. We need novelty, and gimmicks - but they should be occasional and merely a change of pace. Square dancing should remain basically just that - DANCING! We're in trouble if we ever forget that. If square dancing died out, where could I find a magazine that would print my photograph?
