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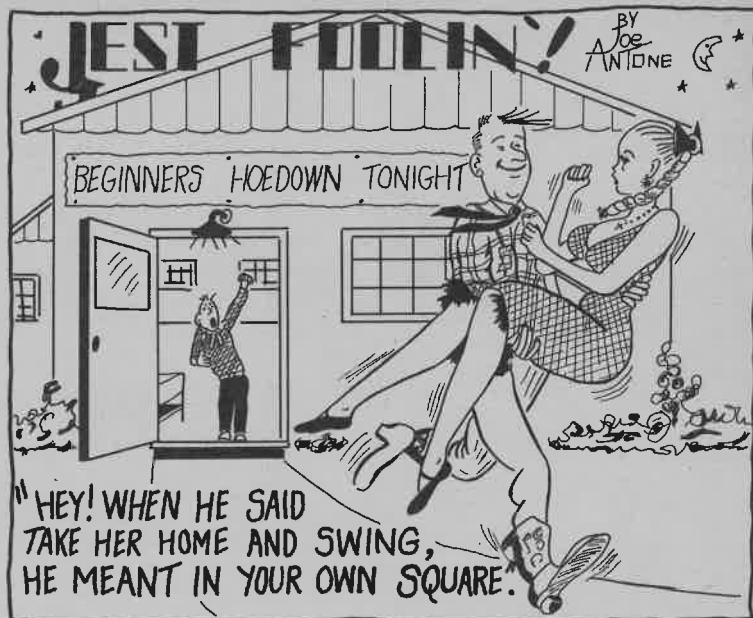

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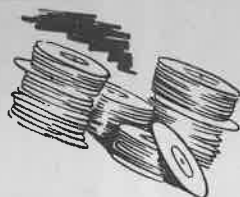

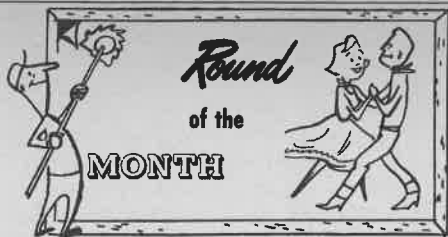

 POSITION: INTRO - Open-facing; DANCE - Semi-CP facing LOD
 FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout - directions for M
 INTRO: WAIT; WAIT; APART, -, POINT, -; TOG, -, TCH, -; (Usual Back to Semi-CP)

MEASURE:

PART A

- 1 - 4 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, IN FRONT; WALK, -, 2, -;
 In Semi-Closed Pos do 2 fwd two-steps LOD starting M's L; Adjusting to LOOSE-CLOSED POS M facing wall step swd on L twd LOD, XIB on R (W XIB also), swd on L, XIF on R (W XIF also); Resuming SEMI-CP walk fwd LOD 2 slow steps L, -, R, - to end in LOOSE-CLOSED POS M's back to COH.
- 5 - 8 VINE (W twirl), 2, 3, TCH; VINE (W Rev Twirl), 2, 3, TCH; TURN TWO-STEP; TURN TWO-STEP;
 M vines LOD swd on L, XIB on R, swd on L, tch R to L as W twirls 1 full RF turn under her R & M's L arm; M vines RLOD R, L, R, tch L to R as W reverse twirls 1 full LF turn under her R & M's L arm; Taking CLOSED POS do 2 RF turning two-steps ending in SEMI-CP facing LOD.
- 9 - 16 REPEAT ACTION OF MEAS. 1 - 8 -- EXCEPT END IN BANJO POS M FACING LOD

- 17 - 20 FWD TWO-STEP BRUSH; TWO-STEP PIVOT 1/2 R; TWO-STEP BRUSH RLOD; TWO-STEP FACE;
 Starting M's L do 1 two-step fwd LOD & brush R fwd; Starting R do 1 two-step fwd pivoting 1/2 RF to SIDECAR POS Mcrossing L ft over R (W R in back of L) to end M facing RLOD; Starting on L do 1 two-step fwd RLOD & brush R fwd; Starting R do 1 two-step fwd RLOD to end in CP M's back to COH, tch L to R.
- 21 - 24 SIDE, CLOSE, FWD, -; SIDE, CLOSE, BACK, -; CHANGE SIDES, 2, 3, BRUSH; WALK, 2, 3, (FACE) TCH;

 Releasing handholds, grapevine diag away from each other moving slightly LOD stepping swd on L, XIB on R (W XIB also), swd on L, swing R across L; Vine together swd on R, XIB on L, swd on R ending in SEMI-CLOSED POS facing LOD to repeat dance.

- 1 - 3 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; TWIRL, 2, 3, BOW;
 In Semi-CP starting M's L do 2 fwd two-steps in LOD; As M walks fwd L, R, L face, point R -- W does 1 full RF twirl under her R & M's L hands R, L, R face, point L changing hands to M's R & W's L on last ct.

SEQUENCE: A, B, A, B, ENDING.

A change of callers for the Peninsula Stampede this time was necessitated by the fact that the signed caller, Buzz Brown, had previously signed to call for various clubs in the area less than thirty days prior to the Stampede. But - all's well that ends well. Ralph Slusarz with the approval of the Board, met with the clubs in his area to choose replacements and the final result is almost like the Anniversary Dance.

The insurance problem has come up again and once more we will attempt to straighten out the mixup. First - the Medical Plan insurance offered by John Campbell is NOT the insurance that is given free to each Association member club. Our insurance is a bodily injury and property damage type of insurance and has NO medical coverage. The insurance carrier is the Zurich Insurance Company of Chicago. The policy is kept by the Insurance Chairman of the Board, Bill Sweigart and if there is any doubt as to what the coverage includes contact Bill and he will be glad to let you browse through it. Also a situation has come up where some clubs must provide evidence of this type of coverage. This has happened in the past and all that the club is required to do is contact Bill and he will see that our broker will forward to the proper parties a Certificate of Insurance. This will verify that the club is covered for bodily injury, property damage and products insur-

ance. Contrary to the belief of some, this is an accepted procedure in all cases where a master policy is held by an organization such as ours. The City of Richmond has a copy of this Certificate for Association coverage at the Richmond Auditorium.

By the time this issue goes to press your delegate will have received a letter requesting the clubs to sign up for work at the Round-Up. Please remember it takes a lot of us to make the Round-Up go and we are sure that you will enjoy the personal satisfaction of taking an active part.

The Board held a joint meeting with the Board of the Santa Clara Valley Association recently to discuss mutual problems and listen to each others answers. It was agreed that the boundary change between the two Associations was working out very well. General discussion was carried on about square dance basics and Santa Clara was quite impressed with the joint effort of our Dancers Association and our Callers Association to straighten out this proverbial thorn.

Everyone won't be happy but a decision has been reached about banners at the Round-Up. They will be hung in reverse order this year. Now the Board will run for cover.

It is with deep regret that we are forced to announce that Burt and Shirl Debeling have found it necessary to resign from the Board. As Directors of District #6 they have done a tremendous job and they will be sorely missed. At this writing no replacement has been named.

Don't forget - The Round-Up is coming! Don't forget to get your reservations in early. Don't forget that the only member of the "I Adore Bob Barthol Club" will MC the Round-Up Breakfast. And - who can do a better job of MCing than - Bob Barthol.
