Traditionally no meeting is held during the holiday season, but committee work continues apace. President Don Shotwell has appointed a Nominations Committee and it is in the process of creating a slate of candidates for the coming year. The basic groundwork is being done for the Annual Institute which will be held next fall, and, somehow or another Ed Ferrario manages to get this magazine published and mailed.

It might do us well to review the accomplishments of the past year as a guide to the future.

1) With the cooperation of the Dancer's Association, a joint group was formed to select an old basic and a new basic to be featured by area callers each month . . .

2) A caller-training program was inaugurated and sponsored which produced a goodly number of new callers . . .

3) A carefully defined set of requirements for membership was Incorporated in the By-laws which will go far to insure quality among our callers . . . and,

4) Procedures were put in motion for greater cooperation among the several callers associations in California—as witnessed by the most successful Joint Hoedown with the Fresno callers.

On behalf of the Caller's Association and callers everywhere, the Publicity Chairman would like to express a word or two regarding the recent exchange between Larry Butzer and Vic Tolley and their propositions concerning caller competence and caller leadership which have appeared in the pages of this fine journal. While the Association takes no official stand, this writer would like to present an idea or two.

Just about any caller who invests his time in a group of dancers, or would-be dancers, has already invested his hard-earned cash in some course of training and a set of electronic equipment. While at first it is a great deal of fun, it begins to become a chore when the caller knows he must come to call sick or well - and - when he must meet monthly equipment payments whether income warrants or not. At best, expressions of leadership can be no more than expressions of knowledge based upon prior experience with square dancers. When this is discounted by some dancers, the caller can only hope to hold his group together by stepping back and giving his leadership up to his dancers or club officers. At times this results in no leadership at all and the caller quits; quits not only the group but the square dance movement itself! While there may be a few 90-day wonder callers around, most callers have years of experience behind them. This writer believes that callers ask only one thing of their dancers: Respect my experience and trust in my endeavors for the total good of square dancing.
