Both of the Wylies are accomplished musicians and have played with dance bands.

The Wylies were married just after the beginning of World War II and Wayne spent four and a half years pushing fighter planes thru the air for Uncle Sam while Norma held her breath and worried. The end of the war and the end of their professional dance careers came at the same time as they started their family of two lovely daughters who share their parent's enthusiasm for both music and dancing.

Lured into Square Dancing in 1952, the Wylies almost immediately became interested in Round Dancing and it was inevitable that they should meet Nita and Manning Smith who encouraged them to start teaching Round Dancing in 1958. Since then the Wylies have been instructors at over 100 regional festivals and have conducted Dance Clinics for the National Conventions in 1965-66-67 and 1968. They have been staff members at numerous institutes, among them, Bangor Lodge in Canada, Fun Valley in Colorado, Chula Vista Resort at Wisconsin Dells and Manning and Nita Smith's institute at Indiana Beach. Among their many choreographic accomplishments are ROSE ROOM, REMEMBER TODAY, and SOMEWHERE MY LOVE.

The Wylies have served in many Square and Round Dance organizations from local to national level. They were President of the Greater St. Louis Federation at the time the National Convention was held in St. Louis. Norma was Secretary of the National and Wayne was National Treasurer.

"As Square and Round Dancers we have enjoyed many years, and made many friends, in the best possible pastime, in company with the greatest people on earth. As teachers we have expanded this pleasure through the continuous addition of friends all over the country and abroad. We have always tried to add something to the movement, in return we have received a great deal of personal pleasure and satisfaction.
