## 'President's Message'

### Don & Bette Bowlby

This message will be short because I hope that you will read it, give it a great deal of thought and then work towards the suggested end.

Our clubs need new blood and the only way to get it is with beginner classes. These classes should last at least 26 weeks. That is the only way that these new people will be competent dancers.

We want them in the clubs, but don't take them in until they complete the class. Don't ask the caller to graduate the class early as you put him in a spot. At the same time don't let the caller graduate the class early. In both cases the dancer (intermediate and new) suffer because of this. The intermediate dancer because the dancing level goes down and the newer dancer suffers even more as they become discouraged and quit. Also your intermediate dancers don't take a beginner to an intermediate hoedown, remember the other people in the square with you and the newer dancer does not know the calls and will become discouraged, and may even quit, we don't want that.

By all of the clubs and callers working together with at least a 26 week beginner class and using the Sets in Order 75 Basic Blue Ribbon suggestions we will have the finest bunch of graduates that are possible and the best in the U.S.A.

We hope that you have a good time at the stampedes this month.

Hope to see anyone who is interested in attending your association meeting on the 3rd Sunday of this month at 1:30 p.m. at Washington School, Santa Clara Avenue, in Alameda.
