## SQUARE TALK

In the past, teenage square dance clubs have had problems with attendance at their hoedowns. Usually they get support from other teen groups only. Very few adults attend hoedowns sponsored by a teen group. Is this because adults don't wish to dance with teens or because the caller is not a top name caller or some other reason?

I believe it's a combination of reasons. One, we as adults would sometimes feel out of place dancing with the "kids". Had we stopped to think maybe they feel out of

place dancing with us? Two, the caller might not be a top name caller usually because a teenage group can't count on a large enough attendance to be able to pay a caller his normal fee without going in the hole. As I mentioned in a previous column, the teens can barely afford to pay their own club caller so they must rely on attendance at their hoedown to pay for rental of the hall, refreshments and a caller. After these expenses there usually is very little left if anything at all. So they must rely on their club caller to call their hoedown on a split the profit basis after expenses. This can sometimes be embarrassing to both the club and the caller.

My point is, we as adults should support the teenage clubs in our area. It has been mentioned at NCSDA that member clubs should support the Anniversary dance of clubs in their district. I agree, this means teen clubs also.

How many teens did you have at your last club hoedown? One, two couples? One square? None? The last few hoedowns I've been to I've counted at least three couples of teens. They support our dances, we ought to support theirs.

So next time you see an ad for a hoedown sponsored by a teenage group, don't flip by without at least considering the dance. They try to attend, who knows, it might be fun remembering when we were young!

## BACKROADS of square dance memories

Twenty-four years is a long time to have been SQUARE DANCING...When I dig into the "backroads of my mind", happy thoughts start to happen. Thinking back to the "early days"...In January of 1950 there wasn't any square dancing on the Peninsula...Dave and I were first introduced to "American Squares", as they were presented by Margery and Murray Marshall in their FOLK DANCE CLASS of Monterey Peninsula College. That was in February of 1950...Jim and Verla Reid, Floyd and Dorothea Carter, Bob and Helen Spencer, Paul and Valeta Rice, and Dave and Francie Gove, to mention just a few of the capacity 125 registered! That was COUPLES, and the class closed on the second night...After a few nights of folk dances, we were shown an American Square...That DID it...We wanted more. So, in the Fall we heard about this Johnny Savage, a private stationed at Fort Ord, fresh from Southern Ca. and a protege of the famous Fenton "Jonesy" Jones...From then on, we danced each SUNDAY night at the Masonic Temple in Carmel...and we were lucky to have two squares most of the time...This Sunday night group soon formed into the original Hot Timers, the first square dance club in the area, with Friday night as their club night, and Carmel High cafeteria - the place. Then, came the need for a beginner's class, which in those days - we graduated in 10-12 WEEKS...Squares were here to stay! We put on exhibitions, benefits, hoedowns, and this called for "club outfits" and badges...I still have my original Hot Timer and Taw Twirler badge, having "designed" them both, and also our dresses. And THAT was something, as we wore pantaloons (had to make them, as they could not be bought) and red and white candy-stripe dresses, nearly down to the ankle...Gals, we've come a long-g-g way!

Just as things were rolling well, Johnny Savage received orders to Korea! Result: Paul Rice to the rescue...Shortly after that, my Dave was learning to call, the "hard way"...That was in the Fall of 1954.

By this time, the Taw Twirlers were

launched officially out of one of Paul's first beginner classes, and since they did not care to join the Hot Timers, they proceeded to form their own club - dance night was Mondays, and the place for a short time was the Del Rey Woods School... Now the Peninsula had two full-fledged square dance clubs...

At one time, Paul Rice was not only the caller for the Taw Twirlers, but also for the Rodeo Swingers in Salinas, and the Gussy 'N Dolls of Watsonville... By this time, there was a need for more callers and more classes... so, Blue Swingers came into being... A workshop group with three teachers, Valeta Rice, Ronny White and Dave Gove... About this same time, Dave and I were busy each Tuesday night with the "Service Swingers" at Fort Ord... Each week we would pick up all the "available gals" and tote them out to the #1 Service Club... This always included Rosalie Butler, and one or two of her cute daughters... (this was while Ernie was overseas). This was always like a one-night-stand, with new faces each week, but it was a happy challenge, and making the boys happy was what counted!

Our own square dance club, the Wagon Wheelers, which formed about 1958-1959 was short-lived, though healthy... and Dave used to remark: "If Uncle Sam didn't take 'em away - the stork did!" As I stated, we were not many, but we were mighty. The club had been formed, like the TT's, an outgrowth from a beginner's class. I could write a book about some of our activities... We really had a marvelous association with the group... Ask any former Wagon Wheeler the Griffith's, the Ogletree's, Emil and Evelyn Schmitt, June and Orville Elie, Frank and Bertie Samora, and Darrel Jenison... We were up to everything... Knot-heading, knuckleheads, and we originated the Bubbleheads... Not overlooking the three terrific way-out hoedowns which we sponsored, and had complete advance ticket "sell-outs" for Bruce Johnson, Bob Van Antwerp, and Frank Lane of Colorado... Such courage! Then - how about our combined Taw Twirler-Wagon Wheeler "after-party" at the Lake Merritt Hotel at the 2nd Golden State Round-Up... we reserved a complete suite for this event, and the result was; wall-to-wall people until the early dawn. Then, the caller's and their taws headed downstairs to the Round-Up breakfast.

When Bill Fowler was the Taw Twirler

caller, he was unable to come down for beginner classes - so Dave and I took over for many years... After each graduation the membership of Taw Twirlers grew by leaps and bounds...

It is amazing what one can crowd into a square dance week, especially when it has become "your LIFE", and that's just what it was with Dave and I for over 17 marvelous years... For several years, the TT's danced on every Monday night... first, at the Del Rey Woods School, then... later, and for a couple of years we danced at the Boy Scout Hall at the Presidio... That was really something! A long skinny type of room, and no stage from which to call... and in the winter, the buckets came out to catch the raindrops, and our cars were forever getting stuck in the mud... Still - it was fun... Our hoedowns we held monthly at Fremont Jr. High on a Saturday night... but we packed 'em in... Some of you remember.

We no sooner graduated a class than we turned right around and started another, even when the basics made it necessary to teach for 20 weeks.

Can't find the exact date that TT's switched to Friday nights, and the Grange... All I know is that we were "involved" practically every night... One Sunday a month was spent at Northern California Caller's Association meeting in Alameda, and during the year that Dave was in charge of membership, I was publicity at the same time, and we didn't dare miss! On top of this, Dave served as president of the local Monterey Bay Area Caller's Association several times... We started teaching rounds in the early '60's, I believe... First, a class in basics, and then the Rounds-4-Fun Club... which is still active... Thanks, so very much to Ray Kirby for carrying on!

It is next to impossible to condense twenty-four years of happenings into a few brief paragraphs, and I know I am rambling... Many of our Taw Twirlers remember when Willie Holman first ventured into calling, and his first class was also at the Ford Ord Elementary School in Bayview Park... We started there, too... His class became the Sage Stompers... Then, later... Bill Hintze and his wife, Betty, started to teach... result... the Grove Bouncers... Much time was spent discussing the purpose of the "Pink Sheets" such as what should be included in current basics; how soon after their introduction at a hoedown or their first preview should they be put on Pink Sheets; and how often should "NEW" basics be published. The Basics for May are: Old: Lead to the Right Variations and New: Fan Chain Thru.

A new feature at the off-Round Dance month will be, time permitting, to re-teach old but still alive rounds. Some of us, like myself, will be looking forward to this. (What's a Tamara?)

Check your TV guides. The Stardettes are going to appear on an "ABC" Special. Taping was Friday, May 3, but the airing date is unknown at this time.
