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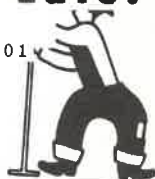

No. Calif. Square Dancers Ass'n President's Message Bob & Betty Coates

This month we would like to tell you what the District Director does and how he become a District Director. To be eligible for election to the position of District Director a person must dance and be a club delegate in the area he intends to run for office. He is elected by the delegates of the clubs in your area. After his election he is your representative on the NCSDA Executive Board. An assistant is also elected to assist him in visiting clubs and to take his place at a meeting if he is ill or has to be away for a while. A District Director is obliged to visit each of the clubs in his district at least once each year and to hold two 4-D meetings with the delegates each year, one of which should be held prior to the Annual May Meeting, of the General Committee. The Executive Board meets the third Sunday of every month so if you have something to bring up have your delegate contact your District Director and let him know what you want the board to discuss.

The voting members of the Executive Board are the ten District Directors and the four elected officers, President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary. There are many more people attending and working for us but they do not have a vote on the board.

Some of the non-voting members are the Recording Secretary, Historian, Basics Chairman and the Advisor. Each of these people are willing to do the job for us without a vote but very often they are serving in two capacities one as a Director and the other with the additional job of being chairman of these committees. We have one caller attend our meeting also as a Liaison Officer and one of our Board Members attends the Callers' Meetings, this way we keep an open line of communication between us. Has anyone ever asked you what 4-D stands for? The explanation that was given when

we first started to attend these meetings and were a delegate was that it meant Dancer Delegate - District Director.
