No. Calif. Square Dancers Ass'n *'President's Message'* **DON & WILMA TINSLEY**

How many times have you picked up the Square Dance-Where?, read the ad of one of the clubs that said, "Intermediate Level," or "Newer Dancer Level," or "Intermediate to Advanced Level," and even "Club Level."

The area of advertising and establishing the level at which we want the caller to call has been a problem since the beginning of time. As dancers we can never be assured that the dance we attend will be at the level as advertised.

One reason for this is that there has never been a system established to accurately govern how a caller is to make up his program. We in the Dancers Association feel that Caller Lab, has come a long way in an attempt to establish a guideline for teaching and for advertising.

The Dancers Association along with the Callers Association have adopted the Callerlab Mainstream Program. We are printing several thousand of the programs for distribution to the clubs, newer dancers, and club callers in an attempt to educate in the areas of what a dancer should know if a dance is advertised MAINSTREAM (1-68). This will not be an over night educational process. It will take time. This program looks real good. A lot of cooperation from the callers and dancers will make it work. The Dancers Association will have information through our basics Committee as the program develops. It is hoped that all the clubs will get into this program and help to standardize our methods of advertising, and to suggest to the guest caller the area he should stay in. Dancers, attend only those dances that you know will be within your knowledge. Make square dancing fun for all.

We sincerely hope that this program catches on and that it will be taken seriously by both dancers and callers.
