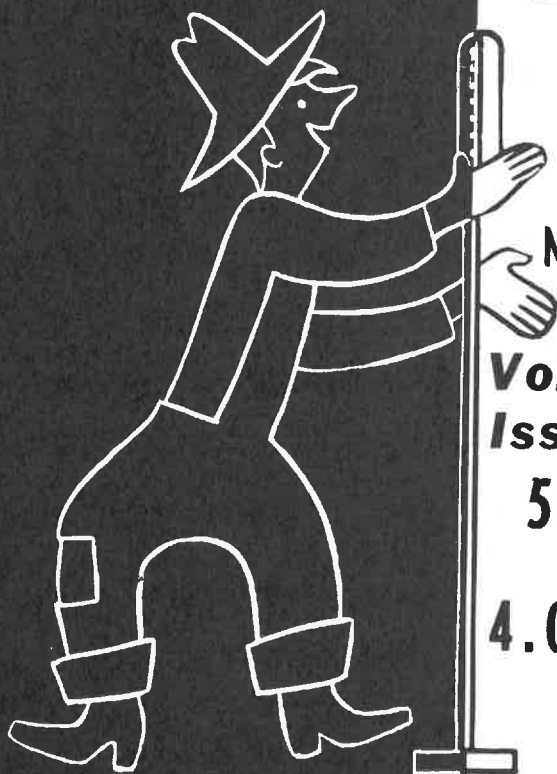

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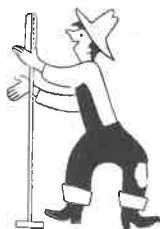
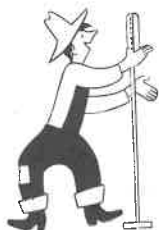

FOOTWORK: Opposite. Directions for M except where noted

MEASURES INTRODUCTION

- 1-4 (Open-Facing pos) WAIT; WAIT; APART,-,POINT,-; TOG(SCP-LOD),-,TCH,-;  
 1-4..In Open-Facing pos(M fcg ptr & wall) wait 2 meas;; then do a standard Intro  
 blending to SCP both fcg LOD;;

### PART A

- 1-4 (SCP) FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; (Hitch 4) FWD,CLOSE,BACK,CLOSE;  
STROLL,-,TWO(to OP-LOD),-;  
 1-2..In SCP do 2 fwd two-steps LOD L,R,L,-; R,L,R,-;  
 3...Hitch fwd LOD on L,close R,bwd on L,close R;  
 4...Stroll fwd LOD 2 slow steps(with slight swagger)L,-,R blending to OP,-;  
 5-8 (Apart) SIDE,BEHIND,SIDE,(turn)POINT; (Tog)SIDE,BEHIND,SIDE,POINT;  
(Circle Away)STRUT,-,TWO,-; (On Around)STRUT,-,FOUR(to SCP-LOD),-;  
 5...Limp away from ptr(M twd COH & W twd wall)swd L,cross R in back,swd on L,

## LEGACY-1977

LEGACY - SANDUSKY, OHIO

With delegates coming from 36 of the United States, from two provinces of Canada and from Stuttgart, Germany, the 1977 meeting of LEGACY trustees was held in the Hyatt Regency Hotel, in Memphis, Tennessee, May 5-8, 1977. The 200 trustees present represented square dancers, square dancer associations, caller associations, CALLERLAB, round dance teacher associations, National Square Dance Convention Executive Committee, square dance publications, square dance records companies, square dance suppliers and the various foundations and special interest groups that make up the LEGACY involvement program.

LEGACY, which two years ago spawned the now active association of square and round dance suppliers, this year witnessed the formation of The International Association of Round Dance Teachers.

Considerable time during the four-day meeting period was spent by the trustees in solution-oriented discussions and projecting plans for smaller LEGACY or mini-LEGACY sessions, such as this one recently held in Memphis, are constructed largely to receive the input from square dance veterans with ten years or more experience in the field. The main purpose of a mini-LEGACY is to bring leadership awareness training and communications into various square dance population centers.

A complete set of working plans for LEGACY was drafted and approved. Ethical guidelines for leaders were formulated. All component groups of the activity, from business to service to professional aspects were knit into a closer fraternity through this meeting.

"Corky" and Paulette Pell were honored by Bob Osgood and the SIOASDS with the Silver Spur Award. Unfortunately "Corky" was hospitalized after coming to Memphis and couldn't accept the award in person.

Mini-spiels (short talks) were given on informative subjects ranging from tax problems to wheelchair dancing. The "Wide World of Square Dancing" featured more glimpses into areas of activity hither and yon.

Other discussion sessions covered such subjects as the National Convention, miscellaneous organizations and round dancing.

Plans were made for the 1979 LEGACY meeting, which will be held in the City of Louisville, Kentucky, May 10-13, 1979.

The age-old problem of competition in square dancing was met head on at the recent LEGACY biannual meeting in Memphis, Tennessee. As a result of much serious consideration the following resolution was passed:

"Be it resolved that LEGACY go on record as being opposed to contests that pit dancer against dancer or caller against caller. LEGACY endorses the concept that square dancing is a cooperative and not competitive activity."

Among other noteworthy accomplishments at the recent meeting was a resolution to encourage support of all youth groups who wished to engage in square dance activities. LEGACY went on record as recognizing the good work of Central Registry of World Dancers (CROWD) organization and encouraged public support of this group by square dancers everywhere.

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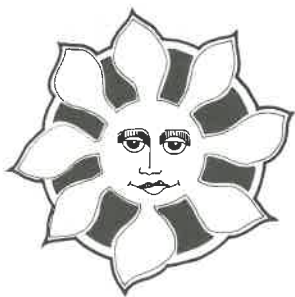

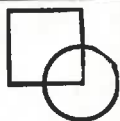

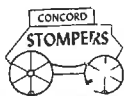
