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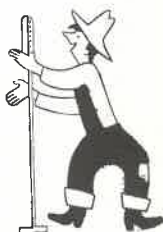

It's obvious that the writer couldn't have meant every figure, since that would be impossible. What he meant, was the figures beyond what he thought were standard. Obviously, some dancers know more than others, so we must have some acceptable "lists" so that anyone can understand what is included on those lists. This is where **CALLERLAB** enters the picture.

**CALLERLAB** was formed by interested and recognized expert Callers from all over the world, not only to clarify the instruction of old and new figures, but mostly to establish lists of figures by "levels" that would be universally accepted and recognized. At one time, we would see Beginner Hoedowns advertised as "Ten-Week Level," which overlooked the fact that 10 weeks of 3-hour lessons would take the dancers much further than would 10 weeks of 2-hour lessons. We would see clubs listing themselves as "Advanced," when all it meant was that they were the highest level club in the area. Hoedowns were rarely labeled with any designation of "level". One could go to a dance called by **JOE HOTSHOT**, expecting a high level. If he dropped his level to that of a freshly arrived "Mystery Trip" group of new dancers, there would be bitter resentment by the local people who came for a higher level - and even more resentment if he did not, and thereby offend the visiting

club who were told by everyone that JOE would be fun to dance to!

These were the sorts of problems that CALLERLAB faced up to, and it was quickly agreed that the first chore it faced was to settle on "Levels" and lists to match. The idea was not to stratify dancing, as some seem to fear, but only to make the existing realities more meaningful to all square dancers. Club designations, and ads for hoe-downs and festivals would easily match up to the desires of dancers at all levels of experience. What are these CALLERLAB levels?

MAINSTREAM: (a) BASICS, basics families 1-38 (b) EXTENDED BASICS, basics families 1-54 (c) MAINSTREAM, basics families 1-69.

Upon completion of this in a suitable Beginner Class, one might claim to be a "Square Dancer". "Experience Square Dancer" is another matter!

QUARTERLY SELECTIONS. Every three months, CALLERLAB picks a newer figure for general trial. It is one that has already achieved considerable acceptance somewhere. This figure is then publicized by local dancer and caller newsletters and magazines. In the San Francisco Bay Area, these are: The Square Dance Callers' Association of Northern California, and their magazine SQUARE DANCE-WHERE?; The Northern California Square Dancers' Association (NCSDA) and their "PINK SHEET"; and The Peninsula Square Dancers' Association and their magazine, DANCERS' DIGGIN'S.

These QUARTERLY figures are reviewed at intervals, and are dropped if they have not achieved real success, or are put into other categories if they have. For example, RECYCLE (from-waves-only type) is now in the MAINSTREAM list as #69. Others may be placed in PLUS II, or even in ADVANCED lists. The current QUARTERLY is CYCLE & WHEEL. Have you learned it? If not, better ask your caller to drill you on it, since it may properly be used at a Saturday hoedown that isn't restricted to the BASICS 1-69!

PLUS I ... The figures in this list are twelve that have achieved a sort of "Classics" stature, and have been around long enough that experienced dancers know them. NCSDA used to list them as "Tradi-

tional," and a typical one is TEACUP CHAIN. Everyone is expected to know that old favorite. This list is the least likely to be changed.

PLUS II... There are presently twelve in this list, but they are subject to revision, too. Dancers who get out more than once a week are most likely to have used all of these. Included are such fundamental movements as SWAP AROUND, and such compound calls as RELAY THE DEUCEY, which can be broken down into its component fundamentals by a caller who can "directionalize".

ADVANCED... This is a precise list of figures presently numbering 44. The term implies that the dancers are expected to know all the prior lists, and especially how to do the earlier figures from unusual positions, and from every position in a starting line-up as well. This list includes both fundamentals such as LOCK IT and ROUND OFF, and such compound figures as CAST A SHADOW, which can be directionalized while the dancers are on the move. Accuracy of execution becomes more and more essential, since it is not easy to do a second complicated figure, if one has not completed the previous complicated figure correctly. Moreover, there aren't so many LEFT ALLEMANDES and CIRCLES and PROMENADES to give you those extra seconds you might be used to, for recovery purposes. Once learned, ADVANCED can be just as much genuine "fun" as your first Beginner Hoedown!

CHALLENGE... This too is a precise list of figures, and of something different called "Concepts," which are merely new approaches to doing the basics in new and interesting ways. Challenge dancing is not just something you haven't done before, and want to try - specific figures have to be learned. Challenge is not "hot hash," nor is it "rat-racing," as one or two callers seem to think. It is an exact level, with 4 divisions, graded according to difficulty of execution. Since so few dancers can handle this level, it won't be described more fully until a later article, when it is hoped that information about that fascinating subject can be put together with the help of those who know much more about it than this author.

## WHEN YOU ADVERTISE

To indicate a level that any graduate dancer can handle, use the listing Mainstream 1-69. (If you say just Mainstream it could imply that the QUARTERLY SELECTIONS will be used also.) For Beginner Hoedowns, be sure to specify BASICS 1-38, or Extended Basics 1-54, or MAINSTREAM 1-69, or whatever is appropriate, by actual number. Don't set the level too high. The new dancers will have more fun with what they can do.

Hoedowns for second year dancers would probably be advertised as MAINSTREAM 1-69, or MAINSTREAM with selected figures from the QUARTERLY or PLUS 1 lists, taught or walked through during the program. Do not be afraid to advertise that figures above the MAINSTREAM will be taught - dancers love to think they can go away with something new "under their belts."

Above MAINSTREAM, do be specific. MAINSTREAM PLUS doesn't mean much. If you mean PLUS 1, say so, or at least list anything that is planned above the minimal

advertised level. If you wish to exclude the QUARTERLY SELECTIONS be sure to advertise the level as MAINSTREAM 1-69.

If you list a hoedown as ADVANCED, it would be a kindness to inexperienced dancers to include the term APD, because they may not know that ADVANCED means the ADVANCED list plus APD on the BASICS - and that can be tough!

NCSDA and the magazines have published all the lists through ADVANCED, and your delegate can get you a copy.
