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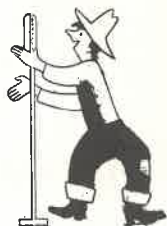

Let's look more at SMOOTH DANCING and what we can individually do to promote that aim. Touching hands at every opportunity was our plea last month. Let's look at "holding".

Proper "holds" can make or break smooth dancing styles. Watch the ladies wince when some rough man hangs onto her hand too long, or too tightly in a turn or swirl movement. Yes, even watch another man when you "tough-neck" him around into the "correct" position. It's not good dancing, and it certainly isn't smooth. Don't take thumb-to-thumb grip if you can avoid it, since it allows the other person to get a "death-grip" that requires you to shake that hand free. That destroys smoothness. The ideal contact is palm-to-palm, with maybe a hint of a thumb contact around the little-finger side of the other hand, for a little security.

Apart from the obvious "hand-shake" of a Right & Left Thru, what else is there to be said about "holding"? What about twirls and arm turns? We haven't all had the benefit of good instruction on hand contact during twirl-type figures. How can we improve on, say, Curlique? One of our better teachers suggests that the lady put the back of her hand towards the man's hand, and let it revolve in his palm in a sort of ball-and-socket way. It works very smoothly! In Star Thru, Box the Gnat, etc., the contact should be with fingers only, so as to avoid jerking. In Stars, the hands in the center should have "box grips", with each hand loosely holding the wrist in front of it - everyone knows that. Try the same box grip with all stars! It looks and feels much smoother than the awkward pointing of men's hands towards the ceiling.

Arm turns are much smoother when done with a light fore-arm grip. But don't use that hold to wrench someone around into position. Use it as the leader uses contact in ball-room dancing - just to give one's partner a hint, so that you transmit confi-

dance to each other. Hand-grips have become standard in Swing Thru, but there are many other similar moves that could benefit
