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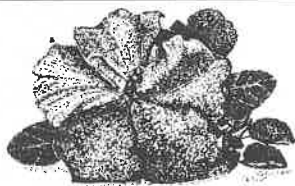

Record : Decca # 31659 "Pearly Shells" - Burl Ives
Position : Intro-Open facing LOD, Dance Semi-Closed
Footwork : Opposite (Take small steps to create Hawaiian movements)

Meas. INTRODUCTION

- 1-4 3 pick-up notes : WAIT; WAIT; TWO-STEP FWD ; TWO-STEP FWD ;
In OPEN position (inside hands joined) Wait 3 pick-up notes and 2 meas. Starting M's L
do 2 fwd two-steps LOD turning to face partner on last two-step and assume BUTTERFLY
position.
5-8 SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, POINT; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, POINT; APART, -, POINT, -, TOGETHER, -,
TOUCH, -;
5. Step in LOD on L, close R, step L, point R toe toward RLOD,
6. Step RLOD on R, close L, step R, point L toe toward LOD,
7. Balance apart (M toward COH) L, hold 1 count, point R toward partner, hold 1 count ;
8. Step together into Semi-Closed position on R, hold 1 count, touch L to R, hold 1 count ;

- 1-4 FWD TWO-STEP; FWD TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP AWAY; TWO-STEP TO FACE;
1-2. In Semi-Closed position facing LOD do 2 fwd two-steps ; ;
3. Releasing hold do a small circle two-step turning away M to L (W to R) ;
4. Continue turn with a two-step to face ending in LEFT OPEN position facing partner ;
5-8 (Tamara) TWO-STEP FWD; TWO-STEP AROUND; TWO-STEP FWD; TWO-STEP AROUND;
(Tamara position - (W places L hand behind back at waist so palm is out & near R hip)
Partners two-step fwd to BANJO position & M places his R hand in W's L hand keeping M's
L & W's R hands held high :
Release M's L & W's R hands keeping joined hands low & do a two-step M turning R-face
(W L-face) to face partner; REPEAT TAMARA; M now places his L hand behind his back at
waist with palm out and near R hip as partners two-step fwd to BANJO position and W

Remaining in CLOSED position step side L, close R to L, L XIF of R (W XIB) hold one
count; Side R, close L to R, R XIF of L (W XIB) hold one count ; Blending into CLOSED
position do 2 R-face turning two-steps ending in CLOSED position M's back to COH ;

In CLOSED position starting L foot and moving to L side in LOD, do a quick 8 step
GRAPEVINE ; Assuming SEMI-CLOSED position starting M's L take 4 slow walking steps
(R foot directly ahead of L ; L directly ahead of R ; R directly ahead of L foot;) Both turn-
ing in to face partner assume CLOSED position M's back to COH ;
5-8 REPEAT ACTION of measures 1-4 of PART "B"
Ending in SEMI-CLOSED position facing LOD to REPEAT PART "A"

BRIDGE :

- 1-4 SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, POINT; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, POINT; CHASE TWO-STEP; CHASE TWO-
STEP;
In BUTTERFLY position REPEAT Action of measures 5-6 of INTRO ;; Releasing hands both
turn 1/4 L-face & do 2 two-steps toward COH with the W chasing the M, turning 1/2 L-face
on the completion of the 2nd two-step to REVERSE the chase position ;
5-8 CHASE TWO-STEP; CHASE TWO-STEP; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, POINT; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE,
TOUCH ;
M now chases the W out toward the wall in 2 two-steps; (W turn 1/2 L-face on the 2nd two-step
to end in BUTTERFLY position). REPEAT MEASURES 5-6 of INTRO except to end with a
