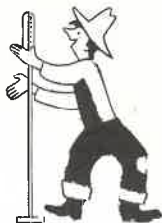

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President Message NCSDA

April is graduation month for most of the beginner classes. To the graduate, welcome to the status of club square dancer. We are looking forward to dancing with you at your club workshop and hoedown... The transition from beginner class and beginner hoedown can be traumatic. So we ask the existing club members to be patient with the new member. Help them, encourage them, absorb them into your club activities and soon they will be as proficient as you. Let us encourage these new club members to attend Saturday night hoedowns. To help them from going to hoedowns that may immediately be over their heads and thus become discouraged, perhaps some of the clubs could sponsor Mainstream hoedowns for the next several months. This would be a bonus for the club and for the new club dancer... Here is another bonus for the new club member that entered the club through a beginner class. If the members of your club subscribe to the medical insurance plan, you the new club member is eligible to be covered for medical insurance without any cost to you. To be covered, your club secretary must submit your name to the NCSDA insurance chairmen. The NCSDA completes the paper work, and voila you are automatically covered through September 30, 1980. The NCSDA insurance chairmen are HERB & BETSY WORSTER, 240 Lake Drive, Kensington, CA 94208--415-525-2406... While we are on the subject of insurance, the NCSDA clubs will be interested in the following. The lines of liability for Comprehensive General Liability and for Comprehensive Automobile Liability was recently increased to one million dollars. The insurance company will defend the NCSDA, a member club, or an individual member of a NCSDA club in a court suit seeking payment for bodily injury or property damage, and will pay any judgment there may be against the above..... Host liquor liability coverage is also part of our insurance. It applies only to guests. There is no coverage if the liquor is sold,

unless a special endorsement has been obtained... Concerning automobiles, if a person driving on NCSDA or club business has an accident and is at fault for the damage caused, and the NCSDA or club is held liable, the NCSDA or club is protected by the insurance... The medical and liability insurance are merely two of the many reasons why square dance clubs should endeavor to become members of the NCSDA.
