In Memoriam

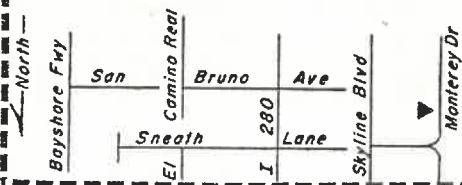
Betty Ferrario December 10, 1981



IT IS WITH GREAT SORROW THAT WE REPORT THE DEATH OF BETTY FERRARIO, LOVING WIFE OF ED FOR 44 YEARS. ED AND BETTY WERE THE EDITORS OF SQUARE DANCE WHERE FOR OVER 25 YEARS - WORKING TO BUILD UP THE MAGAZINE FROM 10 SUBSCRIPTIONS TO OVER 2000. THEY RETIRED FROM EDITING THE MAGAZINE DUE TO BETTYS ILL HEALTH BUT STILL TOOK AN ACTIVE INTEREST AND BETTY WAS ALWAYS AVAILABLE TO HELP SOLVE PROBLEMS AND ANSWER QUESTIONS. BETTY AND ED WERE ONE OF THE ORIGINAL COUPLES TO DANCE WITH THE "SQUARENADERS" EXHIBITION GROUP IN 1950. THEY HAD NO CHILDREN BUT WORKED WITH THE TEEN-AGE SQUARE DANCERS AND FORMED AN EXHIBITION GROUP THE "STARDETTES" IN 1964. FOR MORE THAN 10 YEARS THEY TRAVELED WITH THEM ALL OVER THE UNITED STATES AND WERE THE FIRST TO TAKE AN EXHIBITION GROUP TO POLAND. BETTY WAS, AS ED STATES, "THE PERFECT CALLERS WIFE". SHE WORKED HARD TO BUILD THE SQUARE DANCE IMAGE. SHE WAS INDISPENSABLE IN THE SQUARE DANCE CALLERS ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA PLANNING THE ANNUAL POT LUCK FOR 12 YEARS AND MAKING RESERVATIONS FOR THE CALLERS FOR OUT OF TOWN SEMINARS AND HOSTING THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AT HER HOME IN ALAMEDA. WHATEVER BETTY WAS ASKED TO DO, SHE DID GLADLY. WE SHALL MISS HER.
