Dave has been actively calling and teaching Square Dancing since 1969. He and his wife Sandy started Square Dancing in 1960, and two years later, Dave was trying his hand at calling. From 1964 to 1967 they took a leave of absense from the program to allow time for further education and raising of a family.

He and Sandy have four children, two sons, and two daughters. Oldest son, Ed is a recent graduate from San Diego State. Their oldest daughter, Rhonda was married in June of 1981. Gary and Denise are out of school and working on their careers.

In September 1981, Dave took an early retirement after 25 years with the government to pursue a full time Calling career. In the last twelve years of service his duties and responsibilites included Utilities supervision and management at the Mare Island Naval Shipyard.

Dave calls regularly for weekend Hoedowns, Festivals and Stampedes throughout the Northern California area and has been voted as one of the Top-Ten featured Callers at the Northern California Square Dancers Association Anniversary dance for the past nine years.

He currently calls for five Clubs, within the San Francisco Bay Area covering a full spectrum of the square dance program from Beginner level through Advanced. Dave is well known for his Singing calls; clarity of command, plus ability to create smooth, interesting choreography. One of his specialities is the abliity to perform with Live Music, for which he has done several dances each year for the past ten years.

He is a recording artist on River Boat Records. He is an active member of the Northern California Callers Association; and of Callerlab, an international organization of professional Callers.

In recent years the Hobaugh's have hosted several group travel events including square dance cruises to the Caribbean and New Orleans. Their common hobbies include square dancing, property development, travel and entertaining.
