No dancer is required to know the QS calls to attend a MS open dance. If such calls are used the Caller is to teach them if necessary. Please advertise dance programs as MS NOT MSQS.

PLEASE LIMIT YOUR CALLS TO THE ADVERTISED PROGRAM. DO NOT USE A CALL FROM A LIST OTHER THAN ADVERTISED UNLESS YOU WALK IT OR WORKSHOP IT FIRST.

Do not teach from just a single position/formation and remember to teach styling as well. Calls in *italics* may be deferred until later.

Please do not rush into the next grouping of calls.

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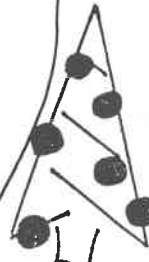


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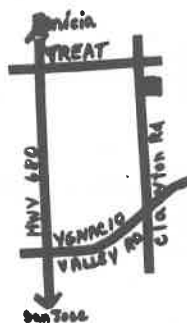
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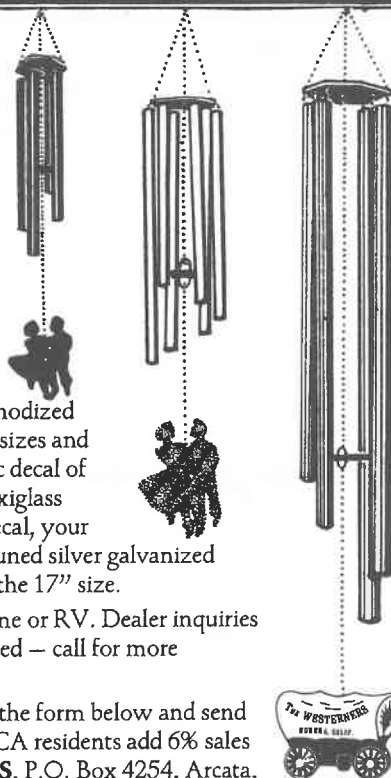
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CLUB NEWS
