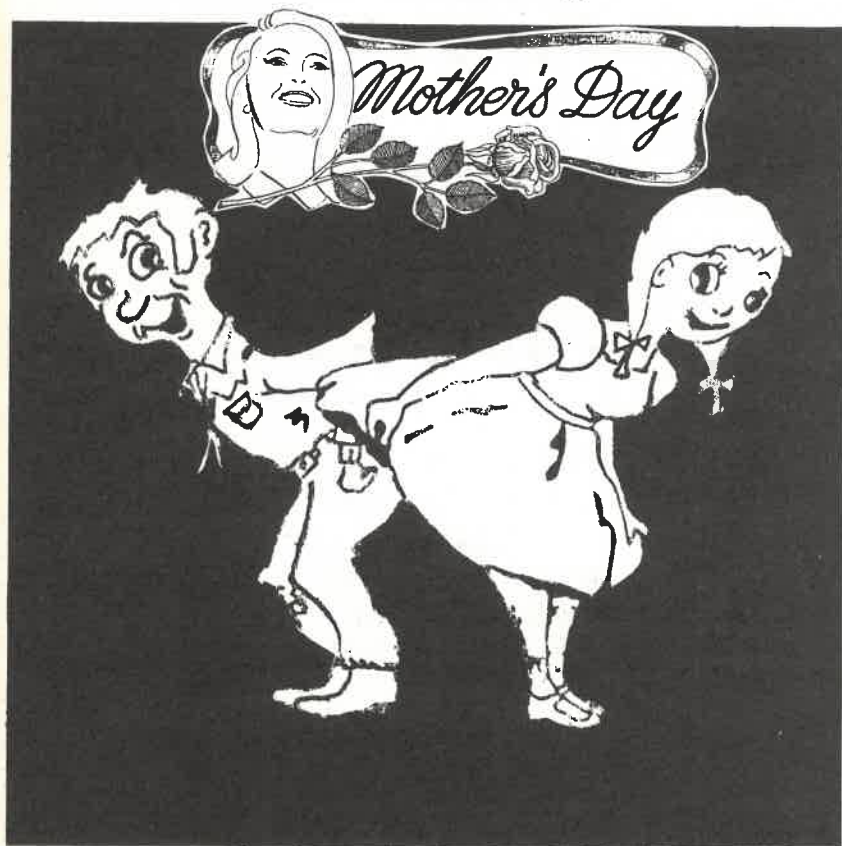

## PRESS RELEASE For Release The Week of April 27, 1987

Mac McCall, Chairman of the Plus Quarterly Selection Committee, is pleased to announce that the call COMPRESS TO A COLUMN has been selected as the Plus Quarterly Selection for the period beginning May 1, 1987. Please note that this call is not to be used as the Plus Quarterly Selection until the week of April 27, 1987.

### Compress to a Column

Starting formation - parallel two faced-lines.

The centers facing in Extend (the Tag) to meet each other in the very center and Trade; the centers facing out step ahead and Fold toward the other center; and the ends slide together and Trade. Now all Extend (the Tag) to form a column.

Comments: This is an easy teach and feels similar to a Triple Scoot to some dancers. Half sashayed and left handed arrangements seem to offer little difficulty after a walkthru.

Timing - 6 Steps

Dancing Example: Heads Square Thru, Swing Thru, Boys Run, COMPRESS TO A COLUMN, All Eight Circulate, Coordinate, COMPRESS TO A COLUMN, Boys Run, Star Thru, Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal, Dixie Grand, Left Allemande.

Singling Call Figure: Side Ladies Chain, Heads Pass the Ocean, Extend the Tag, Swing Thru, Boys Run, COMPRESS TO A COLUMN, Boys Run, Allemande Left, Swing, Promenade.

Mac also reported that a large majority of those voting felt that "Scoot & Relocate" should be on the Plus QS if it is dropped by the MSQS Committee.

The current Plus Quarterly Selections are:

Compress To A Column  
Relay, Cycle & Wheel (R.C.W.)  
Spin Chain & Exchange the Gears

A method of returning to dancing once a square has broken down was adopted at the 1986 Callerlab Convention for a one-year trial for class programs through all approved Callerlab dance programs.

### THE DANCERS' RESPONSIBILITY

1. Return to home position as soon as possible.
2. When home, the #1 man gives the command *line right*. Upon receiving the command...
3. The head ladies take their corners' hands and head couples back out to form lines at the sides of the square.
4. On the caller's command, *everybody go forward and back*, they enter into the dance pattern.

### THE CALLER'S RESPONSIBILITY

1. Recognize that a number of sets have broken down and have formed lines at the sides of the hall.
2. Place the dancing squares into lines that are in a normal boy/girl arrangement.
3. Give the command *everybody go forward and back* in a bold voice. This is the command for the broken squares to enter into the dance pattern.

### OPEN UP THE COLUMN

OPEN UP THE COLUMN from right or left hand columns. The number one dancer in the column Cross Clovers, the number two dancer Clovers. The number three and four dancers Circulate ahead, Cast Off 3/4 and Extend the Tag (as in Transfer the Column). This call ends in waves.

Dance examples: From zero lines - Touch 1/4 - OPEN UP THE COLUMN, Acey Deucey, Swing Thru, Right and Left Grand.

Singing call - Heads Star Thru and Spread, Touch 1/4, OPEN UP THE COLUMN, boys Run, Slide Thru, Square Thru 3/4, Swing and Promenade.

### COVER UP

From right or left waves - COVER UP - all eight Circulate once and a half. The center wave dancers Recycle while the outsides Step Thru and 1/4 in. Ends in beginning Double Pass Thru (zero tag).

Dance examples: Static square, heads Right and Left Thru, Pass the Ocean, Extend the Tag, COVER UP, centers Pass Thru, Swing Thru, Right and Left Grand.

Singing call - heads Square Thru and Do Sa Do to a wave, COVER UP, Swing Thru, Turn Thru, Swing and Promenade.
