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IN MEMORY

Charles P. Wolff died of cancer Saturday, June 8, 1991, at his home. He was 66.

Born in Rochester, N.Y., he moved to Castro Valley about 20 years ago and lived in Hayward for the past four years. He worked as an electronics technician at Physics International in San Leandro for the past 20 years.

Mr. Wolff was a member of the Sports Car Club of America. He was a caller for the Belles & Beaus Square Dancing Club in San Leandro, and joined the Northern California and Santa Clara Valley square dance callers associations. He attended Bancroft Avenue Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Dorothy H. Wolff of Hayward; three sons, Wallace Wolff

of Fremont, Wendell Wolff of Richmond and Charles A. Wolff of Phoenix, Ariz.; one brother, John Wolff of Lake Havasu City, Ariz.; three grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

A memorial service is scheduled for 4 p.m. Saturday, June 22, at Bancroft Avenue Baptist Church, 1395 Bancroft Ave., San Leandro. Arrangements are being handled by Jess C. Spencer Mortuary in Castro Valley.

Donations to Kaiser Hospice, 27400 Hesperian Blvd., Hayward, 94544, or the Bancroft Avenue Baptist Church's CHIP (Church Home Improvement Program) Fund for physical improvements, are preferred.

Charlie originally called for a youth group in Livermore, and for the past 5 years called for the Belles & Beaus of San Leandro. He was a member of the Square Dance Callers Association of Northern Calif. He will be greatly missed.
