Born on July 13, 1919; died peacefully in his sleep, of heart failure on December 17, 1992. He was 73 years old. He was cremated on Christmas Eve and his remains were taken to Golden Gate Memorial Cemetery in San Francisco on December 31, where the family had a short military-flag service. LeRoy came to CA. from Kansas (where he was a farmer & a sheriff) about 15 years ago because his daughters were out in CA. All 3 of his daughters still reside in CA. (in La Jolla, Pittsburg & San Jose). He served in WWII in the medical corps and then worked for Cartan's for almost 20 years. He has been semi-retired and working as a handyman all over the Valley area. LeRoy lived on the outskirts of Blackhawk in a trailer home that he shared with Gloria Tomanelli. She was his steady square dancing partner and 4 year companion and friend. Leroy was a former member of **DIABLO SINGLES**, and **SQUARE CIRCLE SINGLES** and currently danced with the **PLEASANTON SINGLES**. He has been the NCSDA delegate and the Barn Coordinator for the **PLEASANTON SINGLES**. He was known as "King of the Road " at club because of his rendition of that song on one of our amateur caller nights. LeRoy will always be remembered fondly by those who knew him as not only a square dancer, but as a full participator. He was always there to help whenever needed, and he will be missed by all his friends and fellow dancers.....

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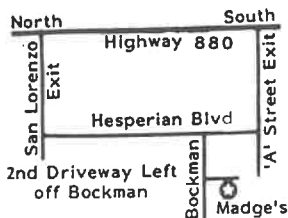
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DISTRICT I
