sylvia had given many years as a volunteer for Hospice Care. she will be remembered as a very loving and generous lady.



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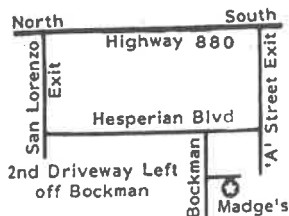
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DISTRICT I
