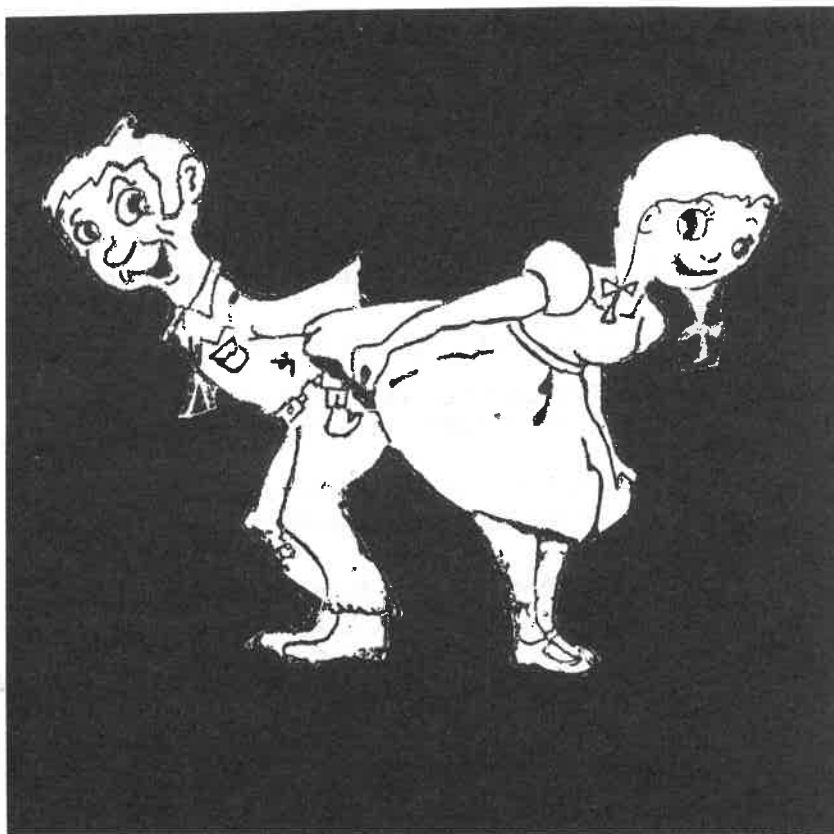

The Commanding Officer at Camp Parks, Lt. Colonel Dolas Bain has ordered us to:
Vacate the Camp Parks Dance Pavilion effective January 31, 1995.

Lt. Col. Bain has already taken over the small Dance Hall on January 1, 1995 because he says he..."needs it." **BUT WE NEED IT MORE FOR DANCING.**

Rather than take away the building upon which the Square Dancers spent over a quarter million dollars (out of their own pockets) and donated thousands of hours of their time in labor, we need your help to convince the Army Reserves to remodel one of the other buildings on the base.

The CPPA, Inc. formed a committee to draft letters and obtain signatures to Senators Feinstein and Boxer as well as Congressman Baker. (A copy of that letter was Faxed to Governor Pete Wilson.). The committee has also contacted other public agencies in Alameda and Contra Costa counties to enlist their support.

If you haven't sent a letter to your respective Senators or Congressional Representatives, then please contact us for copies of our letter for your signature and the addresses to whom they should be mailed.

Even if you don't use the Camp Parks Pavilion for dance classes, you will lose a fantastic hall for Hoe-Downs. Remember, Square Dancing has been proclaimed The National Dance and is enjoyed from Youth groups through Senior groups and the Handicapped.

Again, we need your help...ideas(?)...write more letters(!) contact influential people who are able to use their influence or pressure on the Army Reserves to recognize that this building was designated a..."**Community Building**" by the Regular Army in 1991

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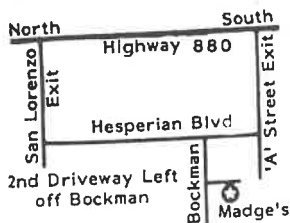
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DISTRICT I
