**IN MEMORIAM
DREW ANDERSON
1930-1997**

Drew Anderson died peacefully Thursday, May 8. He was a Caller in this area for 26 years. He became the Square Wheeler club Caller in 1985 until his retirement last year.

A true teacher who loved square dancing, Drew had the need to share that love. He patiently guided Beginners as they were introduced to the calls and just as patiently, advanced the others to better ability. His legacy is well-trained dancers who enjoy the challenge of dancing from any position in the square. He always enjoyed watching "his" dancers when he attended hoedowns with the club.

Drew felt that a square dance club was a family. With him and Kathy our club shared many weekend square dance festivals. Labor Day weekend at Fort Bragg was the icing on the cake for all of us. Sitting around the RV Park, listening to Drew's tales, talking, enjoying the Saturday night "beer battered" fish fry, dancing on the street Friday night - that was the best "family" time of all.

The retirement party for Drew October 20 was one way to show our appreciation and love. That he was so pleased and surprised by its success was our reward. In our newsletter the editors, Pat & Lynn Stubberfield, wrote, "You taught us all the calls, you taught us style, you taught us good square dance manners, even more you taught us about friendships, caring and sharing in the square dance community. Because of all that you have taught us, we have enjoyed countless hoedowns and week-enders, and just being with other square dancers. You are truly one of the good guys, the kind of Caller/Friend that people like us brag about knowing. We appreciate everything you have done for us and love everything you are".

Drew inspired dancers to become Caller, one of them is our own Darlene Culligan. She wrote, "Drew will be missed, but I can envy him at the same time - since now he will be calling the "perfect" square". Kathy Anderson was at Drew's side at every turn, for better or worse. Our love, sympathy and support are with her. She is a Life Time member of the Square Wheeler Square Dance Club.
