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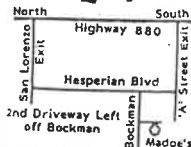
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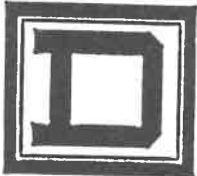
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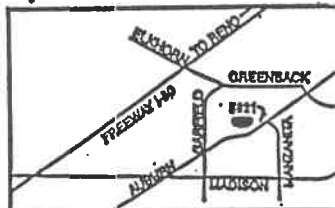
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DISTRICT I

4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
