

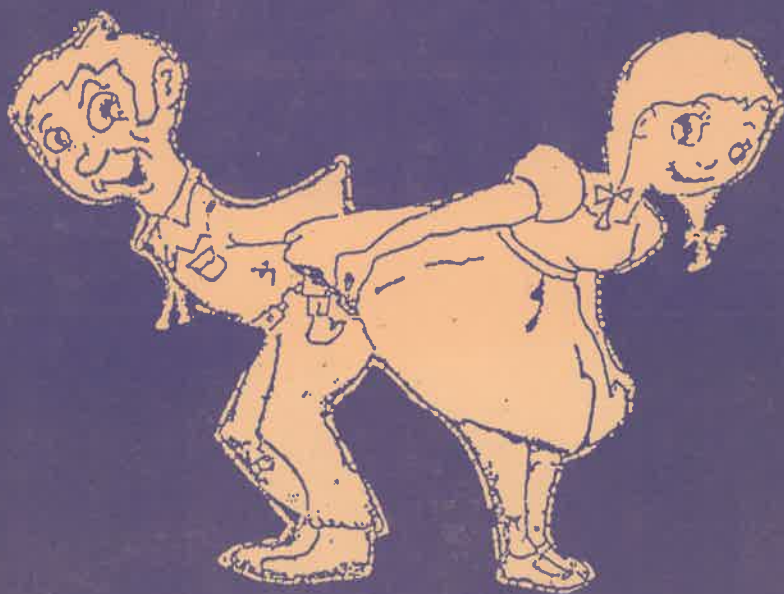

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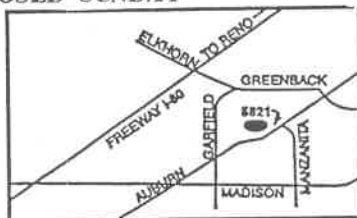

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MEMORIAL
DICK HOULTON
Passed away April 12, 1998

Editors note: this memorial was sent to me by Dick's sister Darlene Houlton. I would like to quote from her attached letter. "I hope you understand that this was very difficult to write and I hope I didn't leave out too many memories that Dick and I enjoyed. I will miss him, as he was my best friend, my buddy and my brother and I loved him very much. We went through a lot of good times as well as bad times, but I have wonderful memories. Dick had a brain aneurysm causing a stroke on 12/20/94, 4 days before Christmas, the same year we lost our Mother. He went into the hospital for a checkup and found that his heart was enlarged and that the three main arteries all had aneurysms creating a problem as they could not do the balloon on him to clear the arteries, this caused him to have a heart attack on 4/12/98 Easter morning."

Dick has called & taught dancers square & round dancing for 49 years. He has recorded 18 records with the first being "Fire Ball Mail". Dick & his sister, Darlene at one time were the only brother & sister team in California. He was the caller & director of the Squarenaders Exhibition Group. He belonged to several Caller & Dancers Associations over the years, including the Santa Clara Valley Assoc. & the Northern California Square Dance Association. He was the caller & instructor for the Callers Choice Clubs & had Chapters in Stockton, Modesto, Los Angeles, San Diego, Sacramento, Redwood City, Walnut Creek & Salt Lake City, Utah. He enjoyed traveling & his favorite place was Hawaii.

When Dick first started calling his first club was the Jackson Claim Jumpers & his mother had to drive him as he was too young to drive, then the other clubs he worked for were the Lodi Promenaders, Ceres Twisters, Tracy Twirlers & the Grasshoppers. He held a thanksgiving Weekend in Reno, Nevada for 25 years & the Konocti Weekend in Clear Lake for 23 years. He called for festivals & Conventions & Weekends throughout the United States, including Asilomar, the Oakland Round-Up, the Knothead Jubilee in Yellowstone National Park, the Cherry Blossom Festival, the Cup of Gold & too many others to list & he really enjoyed. He taught several Callers Workshops. He started at the age of 12 years old in square dancing & folk dancing. His idol when he started calling was Bruce Johnson &

Bill Castner. Many dancers will remember the "Pink Pants" as his trademark & he will be remembered for his rhythm & smooth dancing. His family would like to thank each & everyone for their thoughtfulness & prayers. They also want to thank those who came to the Memorial Service in Stockton & those who gave donations & flowers & sent cards.

John Kanbergs, born April 5, 1949 in Fulda, Germany went home to be with his Lord on April 13, 1998 after a tragic mountain bike accident in the Oakland Hills.

Resident of Alameda for more than 25 years; VW shop owner, active member of First Covenant Church, Oakland. John was a child at heart with many passions.

He had a soft spot for newer dancers and liked helping them out with an extra night of dancing in someone's garage. With experienced dancers, he would improvise just a bit and occasionally referred to the calls from the stage as mere suggestions. First and third Fridays were set aside for the A-2 dances at the Newark Pavilion.

He was my partner in life and on the floor. Square dancing was an intricate part of our life for the last 7 ½ years. It was a wonderful marriage builder, giving us time together as we drove to club on Thursdays and went off to weekend festivals.

So many people have asked what they can do. I am overwhelmed (in a good way) by their offers. We are on hold for a while. Our 3 older children are a blessed support and the 2 boys, Michael 14 and Matthew 11 and myself are attempting to set some new norms for our family life. We carefully choose 3 places where his memory would be honored. Each represents a significant part of John's life.

We thank everyone for their well wishes and prayers. John's loves, passions and spontaneity will be truly missed by us, his family.
