"LETS GO BACK FOR THE FUTURE"

This is a follow-up to the article written by Kip Garvey in the July 1998 issue of "Square Dance - Where?

As Chairman of the "Classic Dance Committee", I hope many of your questions and concerns in respect to the position of the members of the Square Dance Callers Association of Northern California (SDCANC) were answered in Kip's article. If not, I would like to take this opportunity to pass on some specific thoughts about "Classic Dancing".

All areas that have Plus for an entry program are in the same sad shape as we are. The Plus clubs are dying on the vine in those areas too. Bold steps must be taken to stop this depressing trend. Recruiting and mainstreaming is the only salvation the activity has.

The "Classic Dance Program" has nothing to do with taking dancers away from the Plus Program. It can really do nothing except feed the Plus Program just as the Plus Program feeds the advanced Program. It will however, take over some dreaded duties from the Plus community (training new dancers every year). This does not take away all the work, as recruiting is everyone's responsibility.

The recommended **CALLERLAB** programs have not been used, as suggested, for far too many years. By allowing the new dancers a choice to dance a shorter entry program, Plus dancing can only improve. Plus clubs do not have to except "Everyone" who attends the lessons (regardless of their skills) simply because there is no other place for them to dance. The Plus community will only need to train dancers into the Plus Program after they have acquired the proper Mainstream skills.

The "Classic Dance Program" should and will most likely be a stand alone program. In the beginning it would be nice to have a few dedicated dancers/clubs to ensure that the program has a chance to make it through the debut stage.

Each club must evaluate it's own priorities to ensure the health of the club and all of "square dancing". We need the "Classic Program" and we need your help to implement it. The callers are working with each other to ensure the health of our activity, perhaps it's time the clubs do the same and join us.

If current dancers/clubs don't make the effort to rebuild square dancing, the callers will/are.

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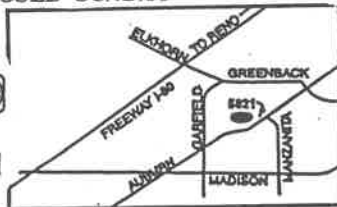
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DISTRICT I

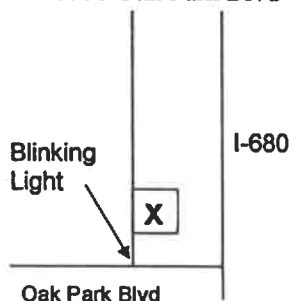
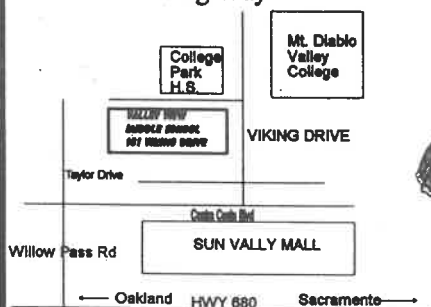

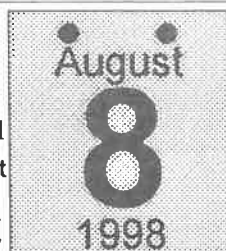

SQUARE DANCE CODE OF ETHICS

1. **COURTESY**—As a square dancer I respect other dancers and callers and treat everyone with courtesy.
2. **FRIENDLINESS**—I go beyond the matter of form because those who participate in this activity with me are all my friends.
3. **LOYALTY**—I support my own club in all activities because it means that the continuance of square dancing depends on my personal loyalty.
4. **CLEANLINESS**—I do not wish to offend anyone. I am very particular of my personal habits, breath and cleanliness.
5. **ABSTINENCE**—Many Square Dances are held in public facilities where liquor is forbidden and their continued availability is dependent upon a favorable public image of square dancers. The co-ordination required for following the calls is impaired by drinking and close contact in a square with one who has consumed alcoholic beverages may be offensive. Therefore, I recognize the validity of the efforts to maintain a separation of square dancing from drinking, and will refrain from its use before and during the dances which I attend.
