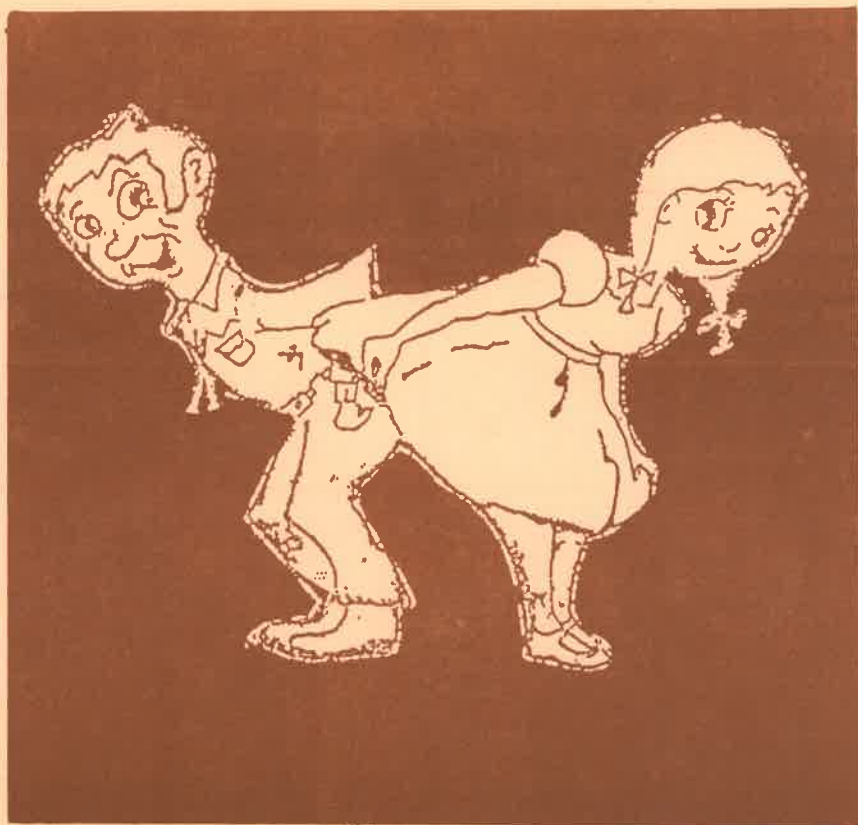

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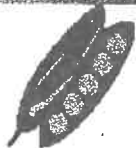
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First plant four rows of peas:

Let's all get to work on our garden!



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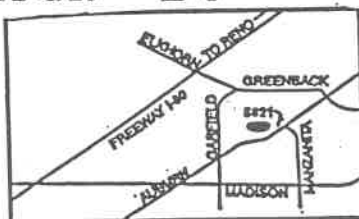
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DISTRICT I

The California Dudes and Dames Dance Organization

The California Dudes and Dames Dance Organization is opening a school to give our children healthy activity and to support Classic 66 (adult basic square dancing).

The Dudes and Dames is a children's social and square dance school in the San Jose / Milpitas area made up of kindergarten through 8th grade students.

The original organization was called the Camar Dudes and Dames Square Dance Organization of Camar, Colorado, directed by Vera and John Spencer. She began teaching kindergarten through college in the Summer of 1949 and taught until she retired in 1981. The organization grew to 300 students annually. They were known to be the first group to introduce clogging at the National Square Dance Convention. The youngsters traveled to more than 20 National Square Dance Conventions doing exhibition dancing.

The California Dudes and Dames Dance Organization is directed by Charolyn Edwards. Mrs. Edwards has a B. A. in Elementary Education and was a student for 16 years of the Camar Dudes and Dames, then, after the Spencers retired, she became director. After moving to California, Mrs. Edwards danced with the Sunnyvale Singles for three years.

Dudes and Dames classes begin with basic square dancing, then adding clogging, waltz, two step, jitterbug, cha cha and more, as the children grow in skill. Mrs. Edwards is hoping to expand her program to kindergarten through college age.
