

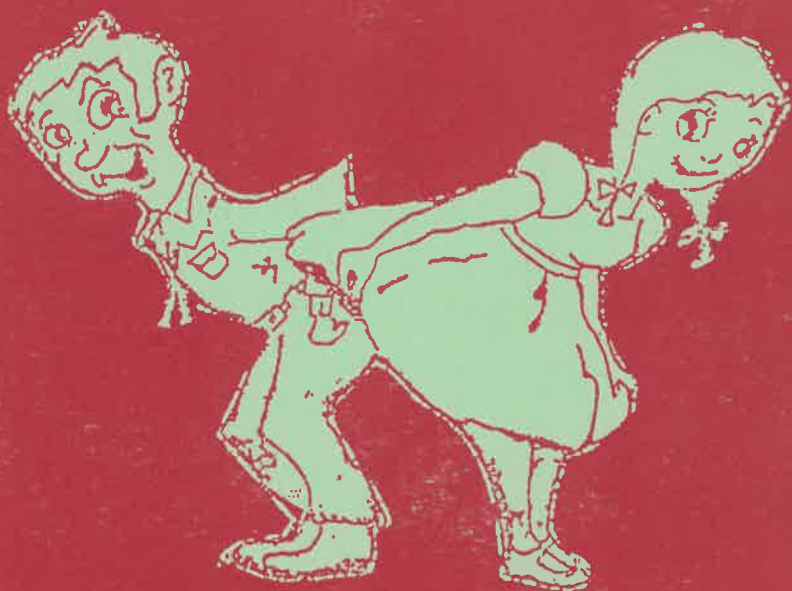

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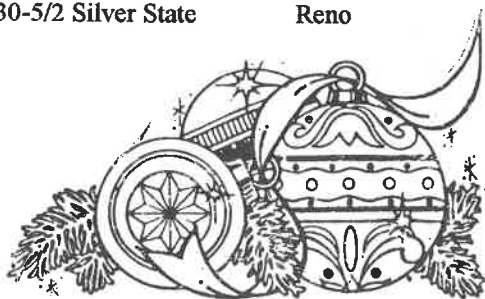

The Department of Recreation agreed to sponsor the group and they met the first 2 Tuesdays of January in 1979 at Mills Elementary School with 6 experienced dancers and 2 beginner couples. **DOROTHY** continued as the caller with *Norm Stand* becoming the president in 1979-1980. Her husband **BUCK** designed the new badges used from old capital to **OLD CAPITOL**. We held our first hoedown in April '79 at Benicia High School. The ax then fell on the club during the summer. *Norm* then found a place for the club to dance with the help of the city once again which was the Clock Tower Fortress where they danced till the September 29, 1998 when the lights turned off for the final time at 9pm by then president *Linda Blagg*. We were very involved in the City of Benicia dancing in the park for the 4th of July, at the opening of the Farmer's Market each year and donating money to the City. The 1st hoedown of the new group was held January 1980. In February of that year

we became members of the NCSDA. Through the '80's we were a very active club attending Silver State in Reno, Golden State in Oakland and lots of mystery trips to other clubs and many club parties. We were known for the food at our hoedowns.
