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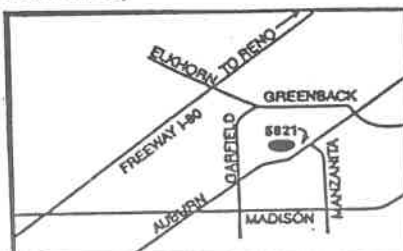


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DISTRICT I

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SCOTLAND - IRELAND - WALES - ENGLAND DAILY ITINERARY SEPT. 29 - OCT 14, 1999

Some changes may be necessary without prior notice

DAY 1.... Sept. 29

Depart for overnight flight from SFO to London

DAY 2, 3 and 4 ... Sept. 30TH - Oct 2 BLD

Arrive in London Heathrow where a coach and driver will be waiting for transport to Bath. After visiting the town of Bath we travel on to Cardiff for dinner and overnight. Next day is a full day of sightseeing in Cardiff with an evening visit with a local dance club. Return to hotel for a good night's sleep. After breakfast a short tour of Cardiff and through southern Wales to the Port of Fishguard. A Ferry ride from here to Rosslare in Southern Ireland and transfer to Waterford, home of the famous Glass Factory to Cork where we spend the night.

DAY 5 ... Oct. 3rd BLD

From Cork to Blarney Castle to kiss the Blarney Stone on the way to Killarney, home to Muckross House for a short visit. On via Galway to the West Coast of county Mayo, stopping at Newport. Dinner and overnight in Newport with an Irish reception by a local dance group.

DAY 6 and 7 Oct. 4 th- 5th BLD

Leave Newport driving through central Ireland to Dublin for two nights stay. Here we will have a local step-on guide join us for a sightseeing tour including visits to St. Patrick's and the Book of Kells. Free time in Dublin for shopping.

DAY 8 Oct. 6th BLD

Drive to Northern Ireland, pick up a Ferry at Stranraer, near Belfast to Larne on the West Coast of Scotland. Dinner and overnight in Ayr. From Ayr we see Robbie Burns Country. William Wallace grew up near here at Irvine.

DAY 9 thru 11Oct. 7th - 9th BLD

Via Robbie Burns country to Glasgow, and through some Trossachs' country side to Stirling, whose castle sits at the Gateway to the Trossachs defending its strategic position. We see Stirling Bridge, where William Wallace (Braveheart) defeated the English Army in 1297. We also visit the Wallace Monument which commemorates William Wallace. We will see two Audio-Visual displays, the Wallace Sword and Woodland Walks ending with dinner and overnight in Edinburgh. Free time the next day and early dinner before joining an evening of dancing in Cupar provided by their local club with surrounding clubs and one in Aberdeen. We return to Edinburgh to our hotel for a good nights rest.

The next day is a morning tour visiting Edinburgh Castle and Holyrood House. Afternoon free to shop, dinner and free time.

DAY 12 Oct 10th BLD

We leave Edinburgh and drive south via Jedburgh, skirting Newcastle and to York, with its Roman remains and fabulous Cathedral the "Minster". Time for sight seeing or shopping and an evening visit to dance with another local group waiting to meet us. Overnight in York.

DAY 13, 14 and 15 Oct. 11th - 13th CB

We travel from York through the University City of Cambridge to London, our final destination for three nights. After a good rest & a continental breakfast we are treated to a step-on London registered guide for a full day tour of London, seeing the highlights and visiting Westminster Abbey. Dinner on your own and next day free for your own pursuits.

DAY 16.... Oct. 14th Ready for departure and transfer to Heathrow for flight back to SFO
