

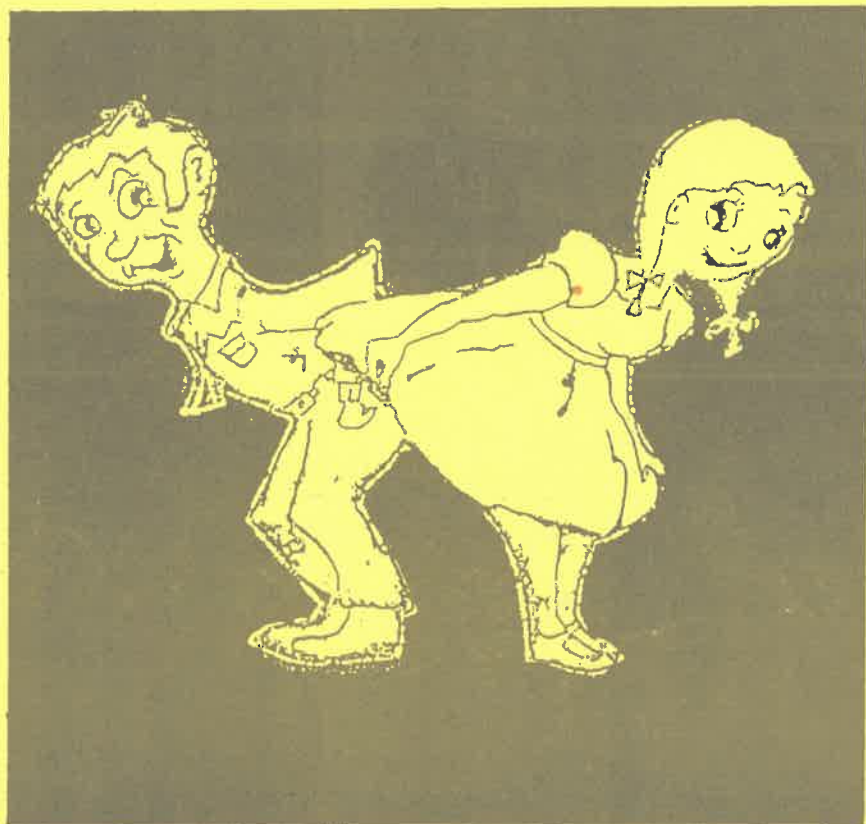
SQUARE DANCE ~ WHERE?
