welcome to *Joe & Virginia Cornyn* our new Presidents and incoming officers. Put a smile on your face and keep dancing.

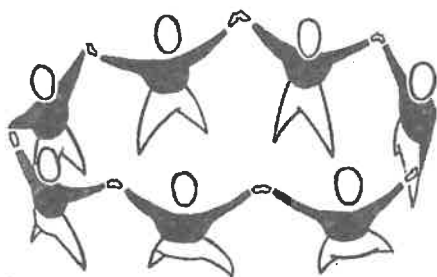

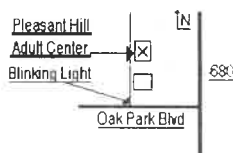

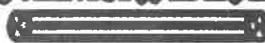
