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The Caller's Association did a survey last year and finally looked at the results and would like to be able to send out a special thanks to the dancers in the NCSDA. Bert Swerer did the following for publication release.....if you can find a place to put it in the next issue.

### Dancers Choice Survey

Do dancers like some calls more than others? The SDCANC (Square Dance Callers Association of Northern California) last fall conducted a survey to find out. Nasser Shukayr and Nate Bliss headed the committee and reported the results.

The survey form alphabetically listed all calls thru Plus. Participants were asked to mark calls that were among their FAVORITES, as well as calls they DISLIKED. 168 forms were returned. Calls were scored by number of "Favorite" votes minus number of "Disliked" votes.

Some of the most favorite calls were: Load the Boat.....Follow Your Neighbor.....Relay the Deucey.....Cut the Diamond.....Spin Chain and Exchange the Gears and Tea Cup Chain.

Looking at the opposite side of the results, some of the least liked calls were: Dive Thru.....Forward and Back.....See Saw and Do Paso.

There are hundreds of other possible ways to analyze the survey results. But what can we actually DO with the information? What GOOD is it?

Square dancing is a product and square dancers are the customers. The SDCANC Dancers Choice Survey may be the first time anyone has ever ASKED square dancers what they like. Any business that wants to grow and prosper MUST listen to their customers. Thanks to all of the dancers who took time to participate in the survey. The information is enlightening and will be utilized in the best possible way.
